An Inventory of all the bookes, vestimentes & other thinges belongyng to the Chyrche & Paryshe of Thame, made by John Manytorn & Thomas Buns & others, coproctours the xxv. day of Februarie MCCCCXLVII.

In Primis One Antiphone* of ye gyfte of ye goode & worthey man William Kynnewlmerssh tresorer to oure lorde ye Kyng and some tyme Prebend of the prebendal chyrche of Thame, ye seconde folio begynnyng in black "*Marie semper virginis.*"

Itm. of the gyfte of ye same worthey man ij Graduals, the first begynnyng on ye seconde folio in red "*per totum*" and ye seconde on ye seconde folio "*Tuas domine.*"

It. of ye gyfte of ye same goode man ij processional†. In ye seconde folio one begyns "*A Deo,*" and the other on the seconde folio begyns "*luminis dei.*"

Itm. Another processional, ye second folio begynnyng "*Virtute sp's s'ti.*"

* Antiphone—the book containing the parts sung in the choir with the music except the hymns in the Communion service.

† Processional—a book containing those services which are said and sung in processions.

- Itm. A Portiform the gyfte of Agnes Clerke seconde folio begynnyng "*De femore.*"
- Itm. A'Legendum* seconde folio begynnyng "*Pullus Asine.*"
- Itm. a newe Manual† seconde folio begynnyng "*fensa per dominum.*"
- Itm. A Psalter seconde folio begynnyng "*Adversus.*"
- Itm. Another Psalter begynnyng on seconde folio "*Miserere mei domine*" with service of the Apostles, Martires, &c., in the ende.
- Itm. ij Missals of Lincoln use the firste begynnyng on the seconde folio "*Karie' patientes*" and the seconde begynnyng on the seconde folio "*so orbi.*"
- Itm. Another old Missale second folio begynnyng "*Suscipiamus.*"
- Itm. ij gradualls the firste begynnyng on the seconde folio "*lutar tuum*" the other begynnyng on the seconde folio "*Populus Syon.*"
- Itm. iij Antiphones the first begynnyng on the seconde folio "*Rex Creator*" the ij^{de} in the seconde folio begynnyng "*Si tu es ipse*" the iij^{de} in seconde folio Pra pr'.
- Itm. Legends of Seint Marie through the yere wt service for Corpus Christi and Seint Thomas the seconde folio begynnyng "*est regnum.*"
- Itm. Collects second folio begynnyng "*Ecce virgo co'.*"

§ Missal—Mass book containing the services used at the altar.

* Legendum—a book containing the Lives of the Saints and the suffering of the Martyrs.

† Manual—Book containing the services for use of the priest in Weddings, Baptisms, Funerals, &c.
