HANNEY.—Through the exertions of Mr. Large, the old village Cross has been restored. For many years only a vestige remained in situ, while many of the fragments were built into walls and bridges in the village. These have been recovered, and with the assistance of Mr. Ravenscroft, F.S.A., of Reading, the Cross has been re-erected, as many as possible of the old stones being worked in. On Tuesday, 31st March, the Cross was dedicated by the Bishop of Oxford.—W. H. HALLAM.
