The gun holdfast circle survives in the centre of the main chamber. The SW wall is still painted with khaki and green camouflage patterns. The walls of the building are 0.3m thick. There are passages leading from the W and S corners. The S passage leads SW and is entered via 7 steps. It is 4m long and 0.6m wide and leads to a room 2.4m x 2.4m with two ventilation shafts. They are probably accommodation and ammunition storage areas. This is a well preserved site used as a stable. The ventilation shafts to the underground chambers have been damaged.
