Follows pattern of type 24 thick walled variety. Irregular hexagonal shape means five out of the six sides are of the same length and are each pierced by an

embrasure set centrally. The sixth wall (the longest) is the rear wall. On this side is found the entrance to the full height of the wall. Protecting the entrance and covering the rear (towards the road) is an embrasure each side. These are stepped in from the sides but not top or bottom. The roof is constructed of a large slab of concrete about 12-18 inches thick. The edge on all but the rear wall is angled downwards. Internally, the anti-ricochet wall is intact. The forward facing embrasures are constructed with a flat concrete shelf some 6-8 inches below the opening. There are some hinge strips and hinges still existing as well as a wooden shelf edging.

In the rearward facing wall, there is a small square hole, just below the roofing slab; this vent is dog-legged. The two leading corners have been angled; the same applies to the roof except for the rear.

The interior has been altered over the years and it is now used to house machinery.
