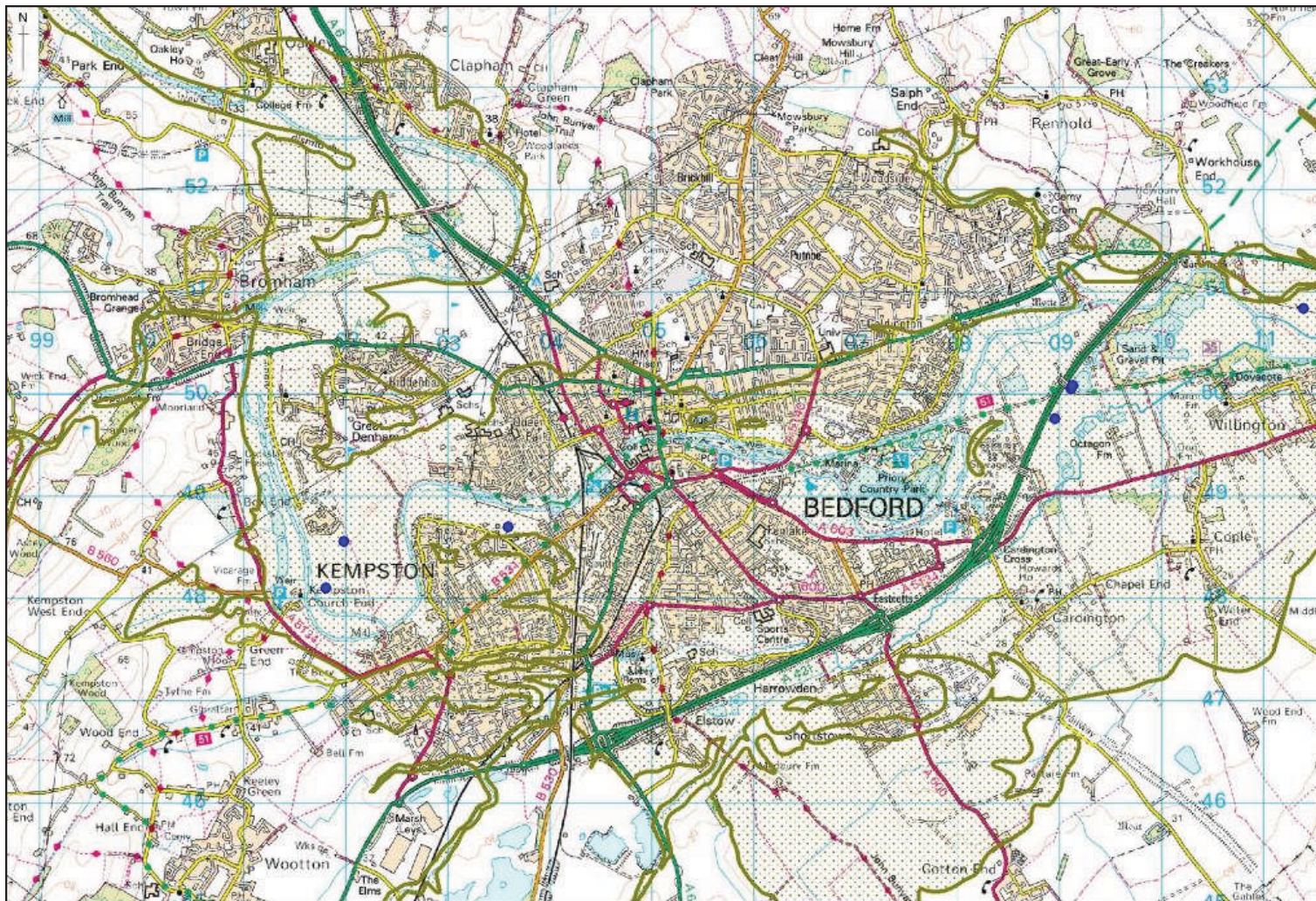
Map 1. River Great Ouse AS-A Palaeolithic HER Assets – Eastern Area



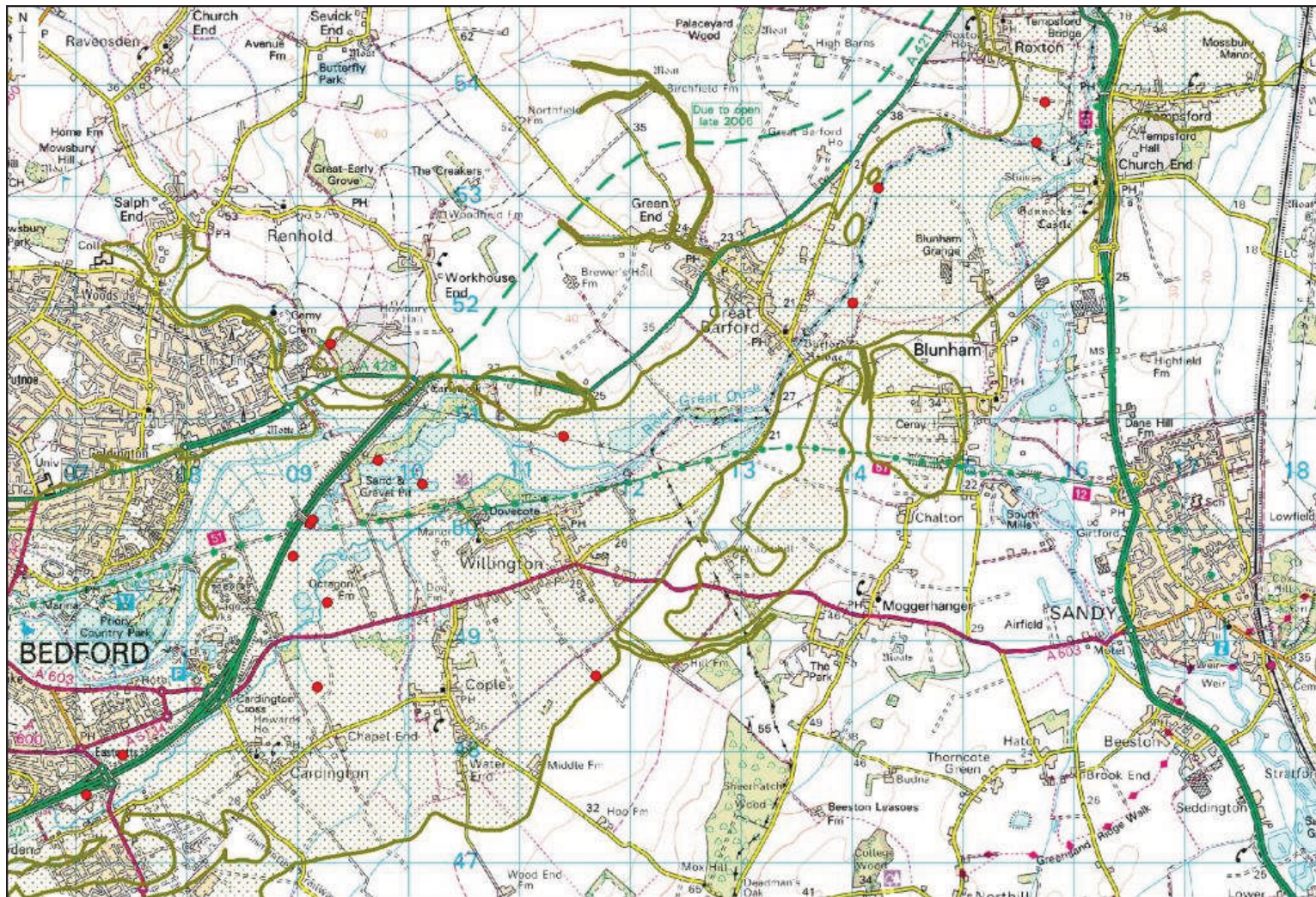
Map 2. River Great Ouse AS-A Palaeolithic HER Assets – Central Area



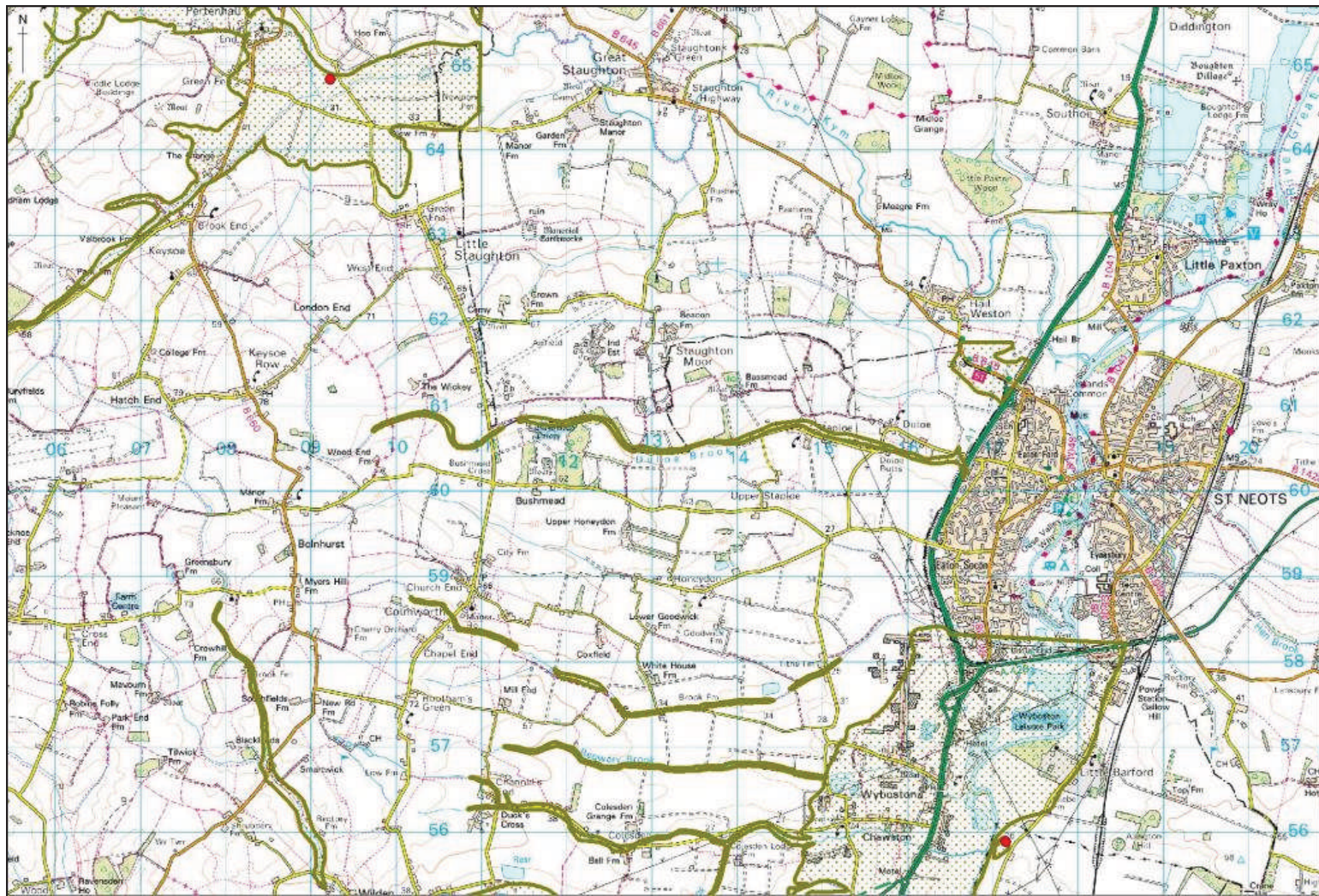
Map 3. River Great Ouse Mesolithic HER Assets – Eastern Area



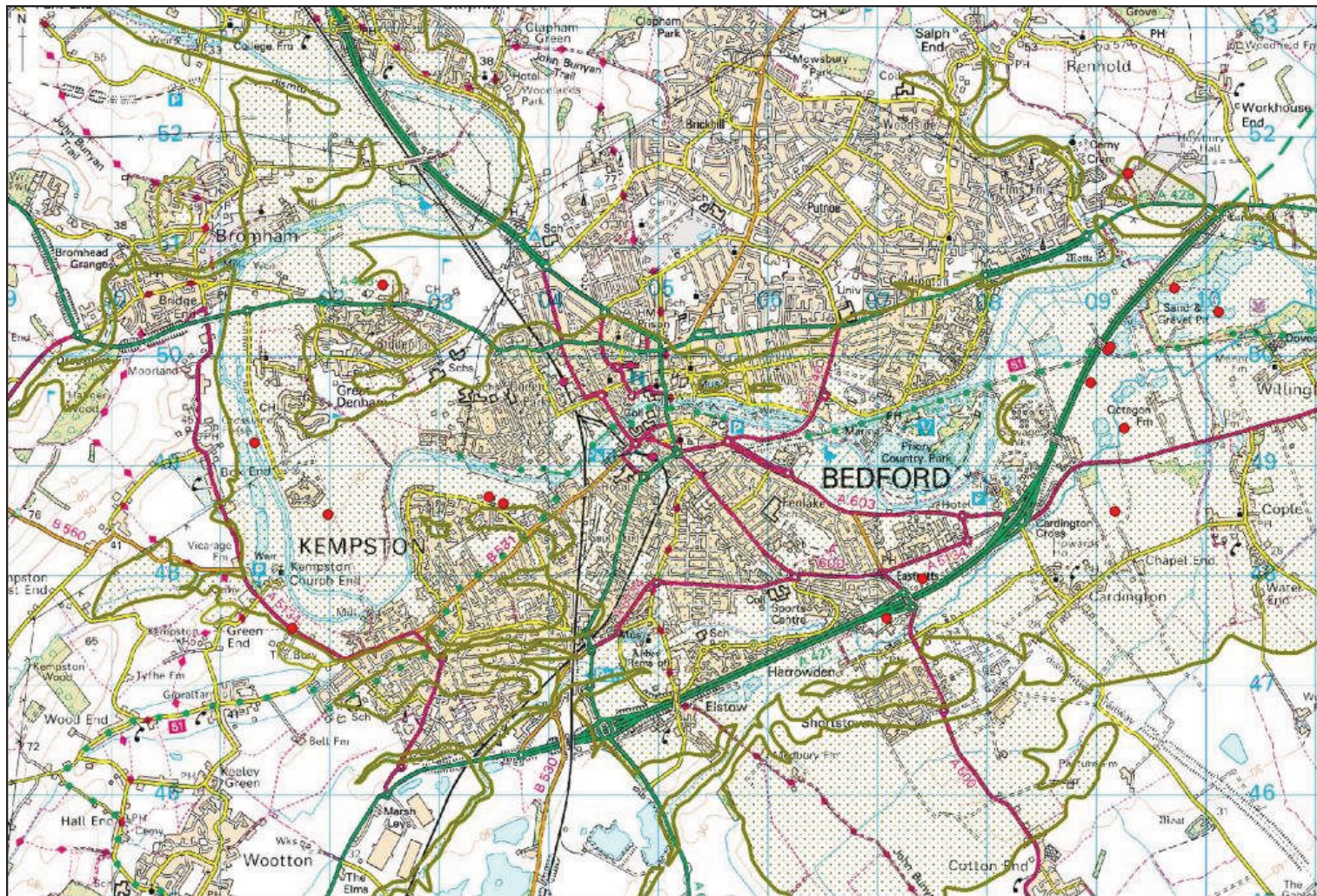
Map 4. River Great Ouse Mesolithic HER Assets – Central Area



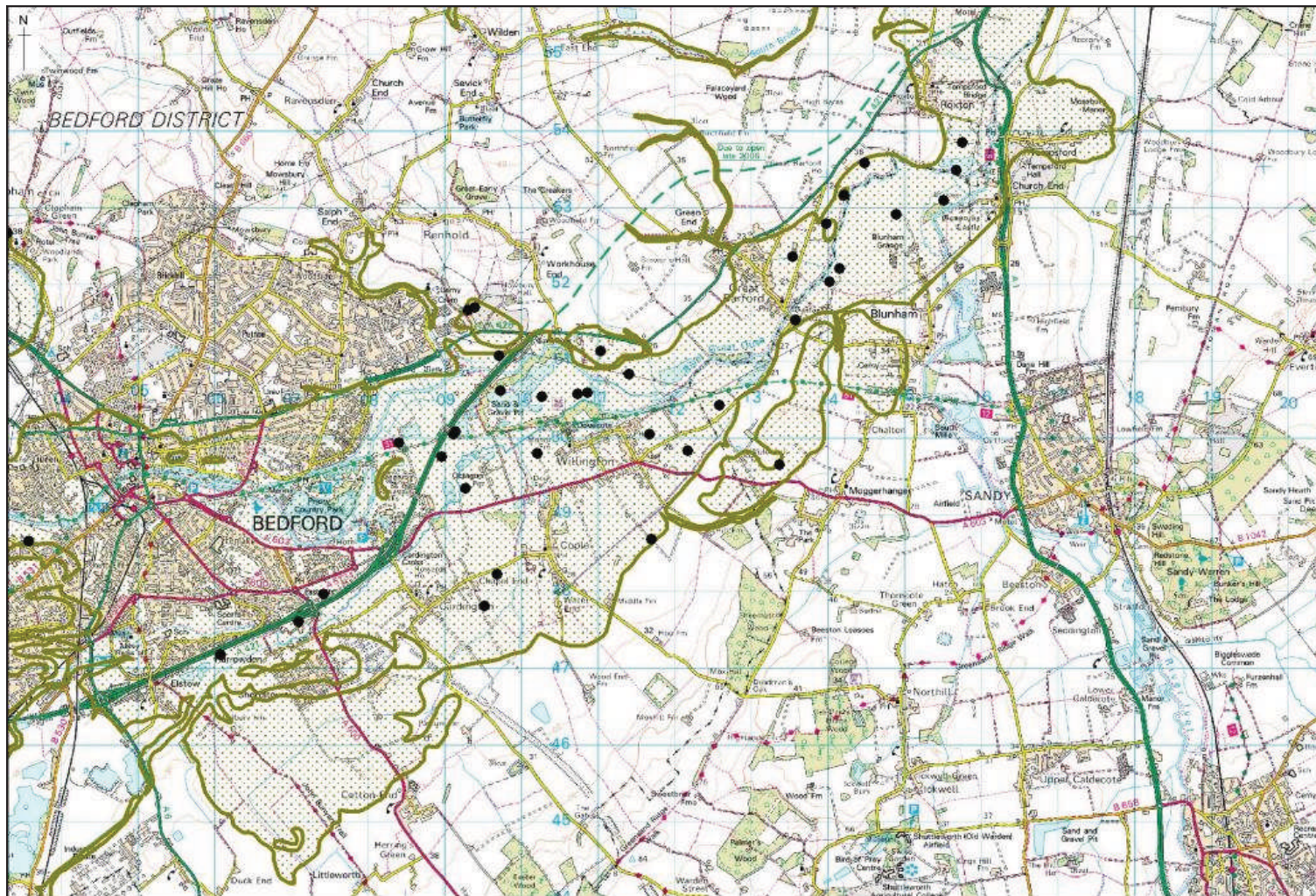
Map 5 River Great Ouse Neolithic HER Assets – Eastern Area



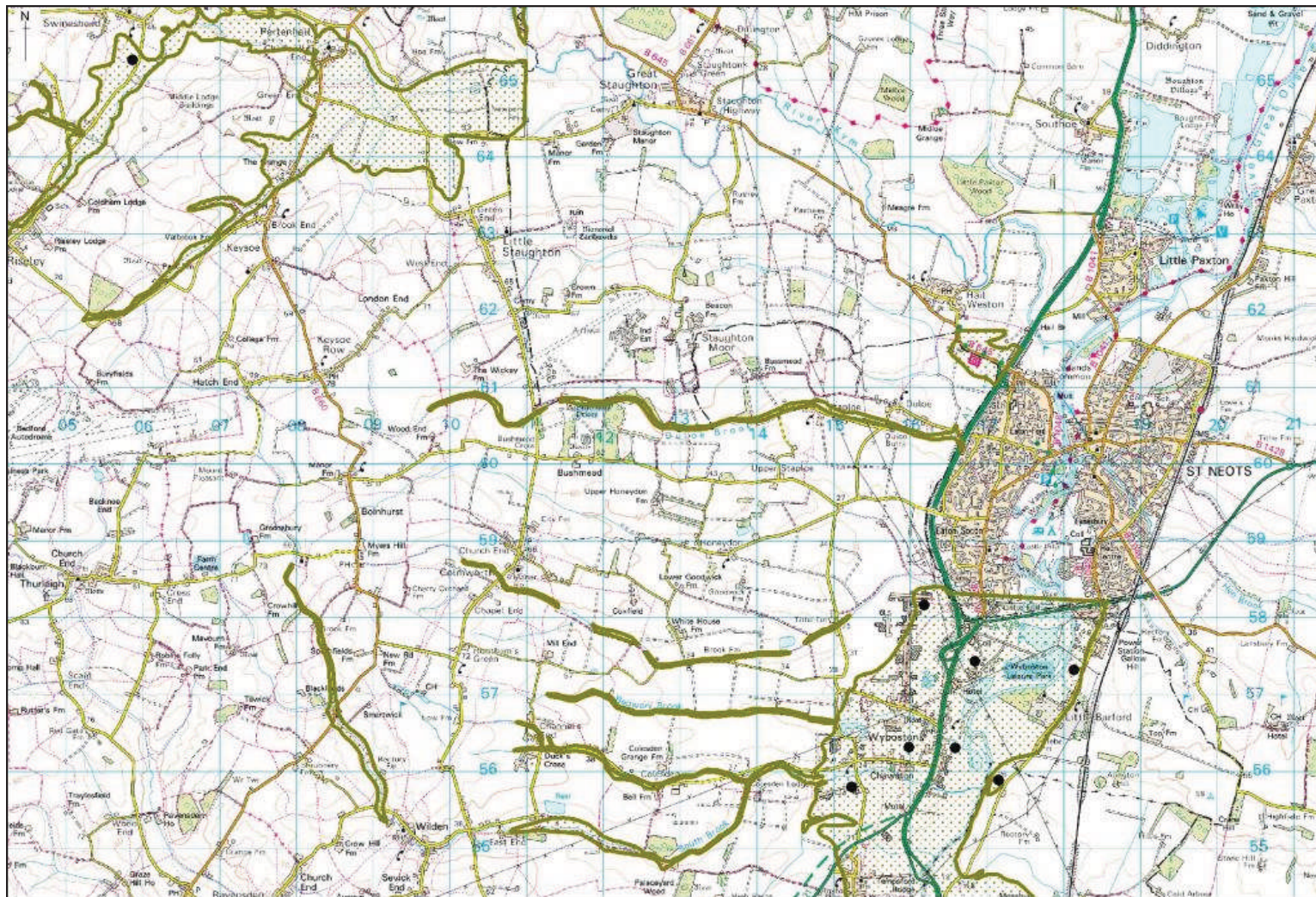
Map 6 River Great Ouse Neolithic HER Assets – North-Eastern Area



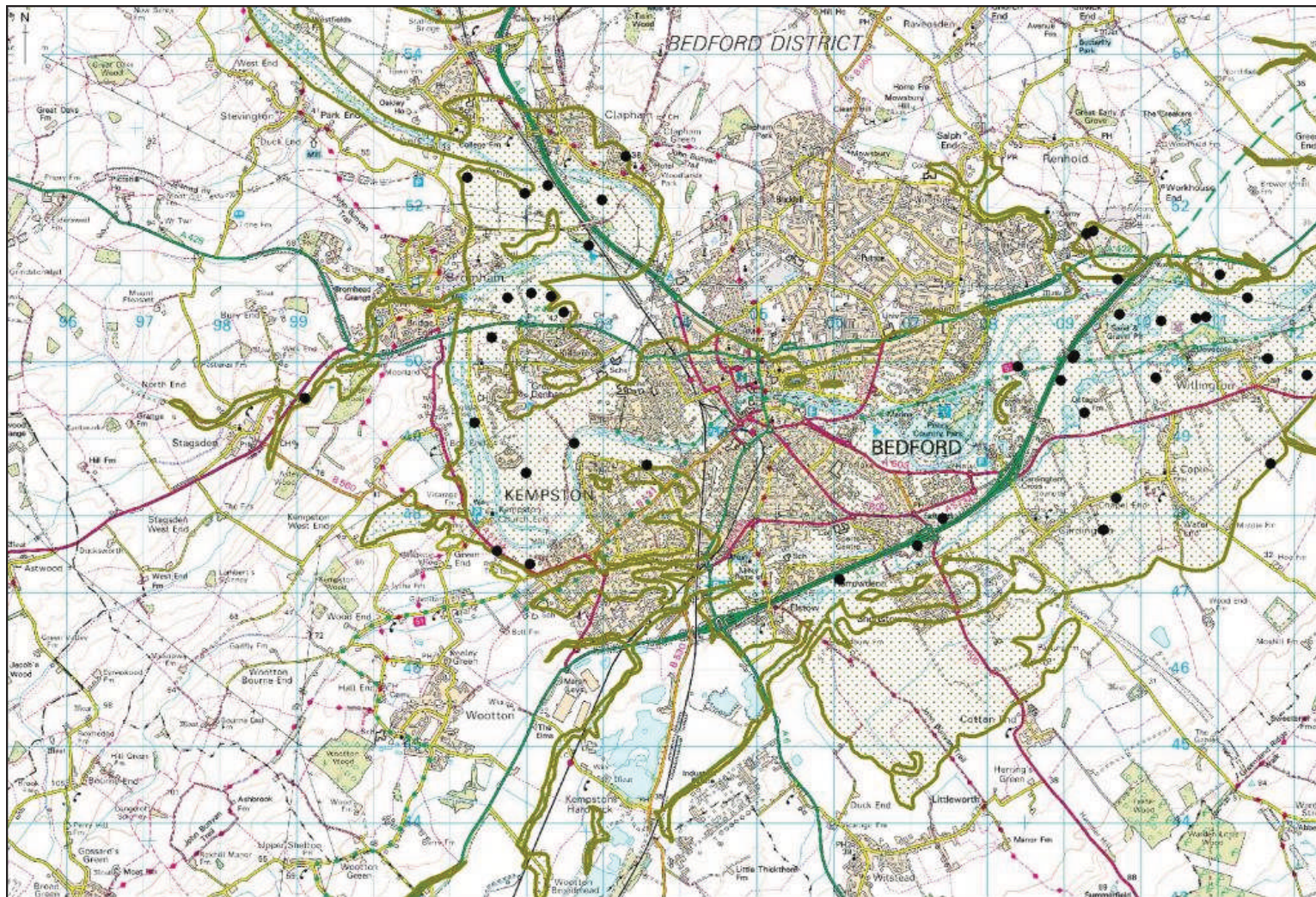
Map 7 River Great Ouse Neolithic HER Assets – Central Area



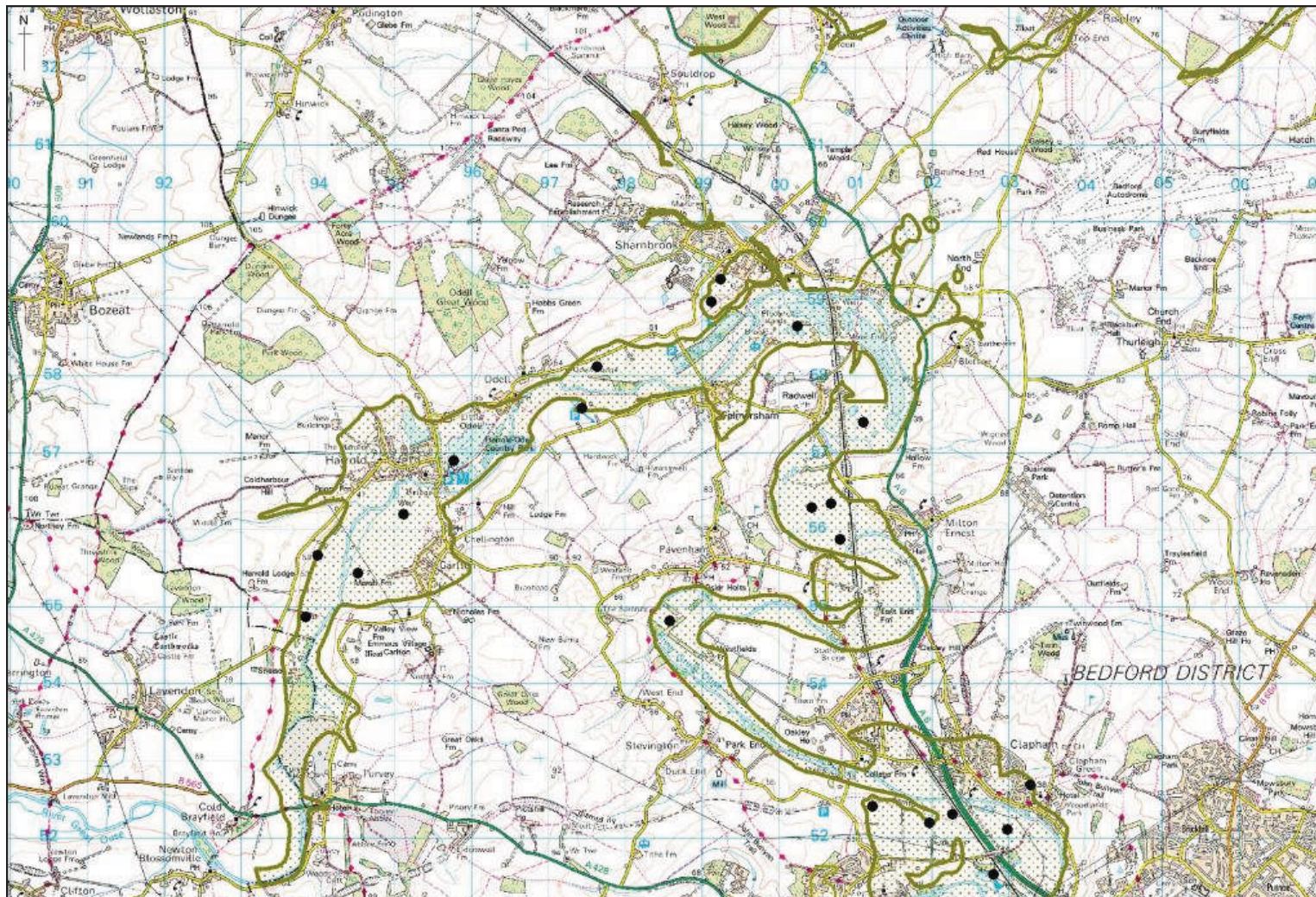
Map 8. River Great Ouse Bronze Age HER Assets – Eastern Area



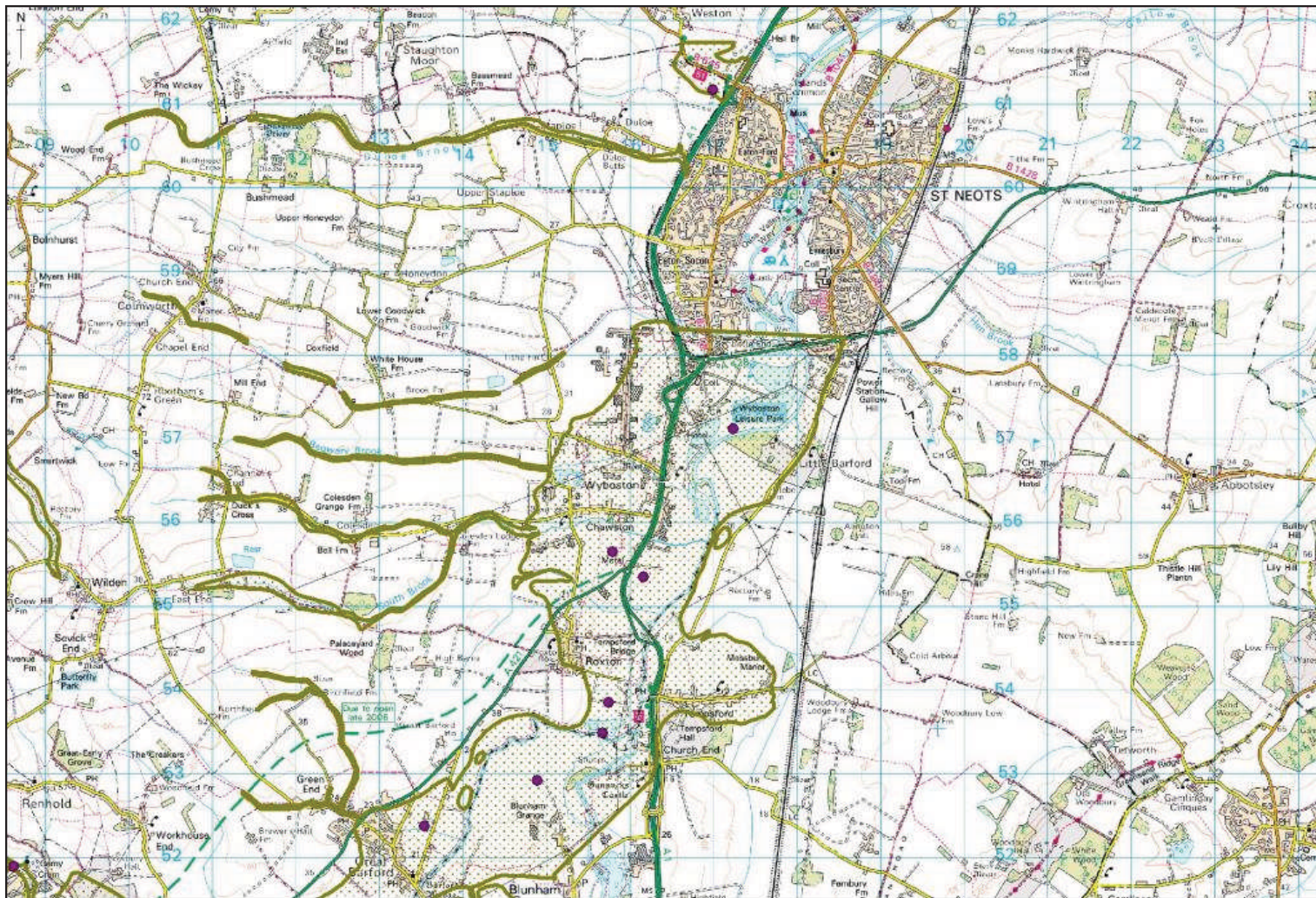
Map 9. River Great Ouse Bronze Age HER Assets – North-Eastern Area



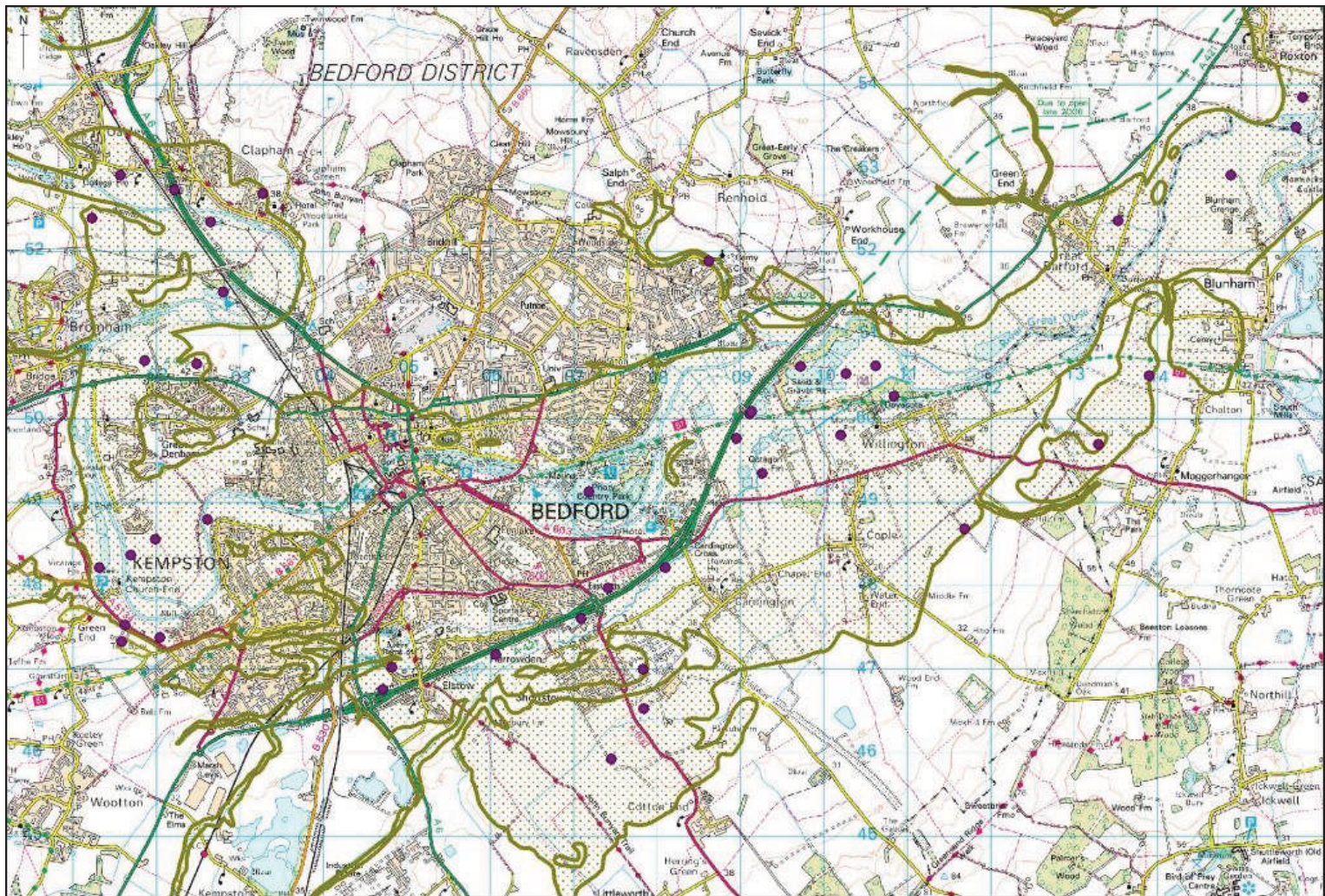
Map 10. River Great Ouse Bronze Age HER Assets – Central Area



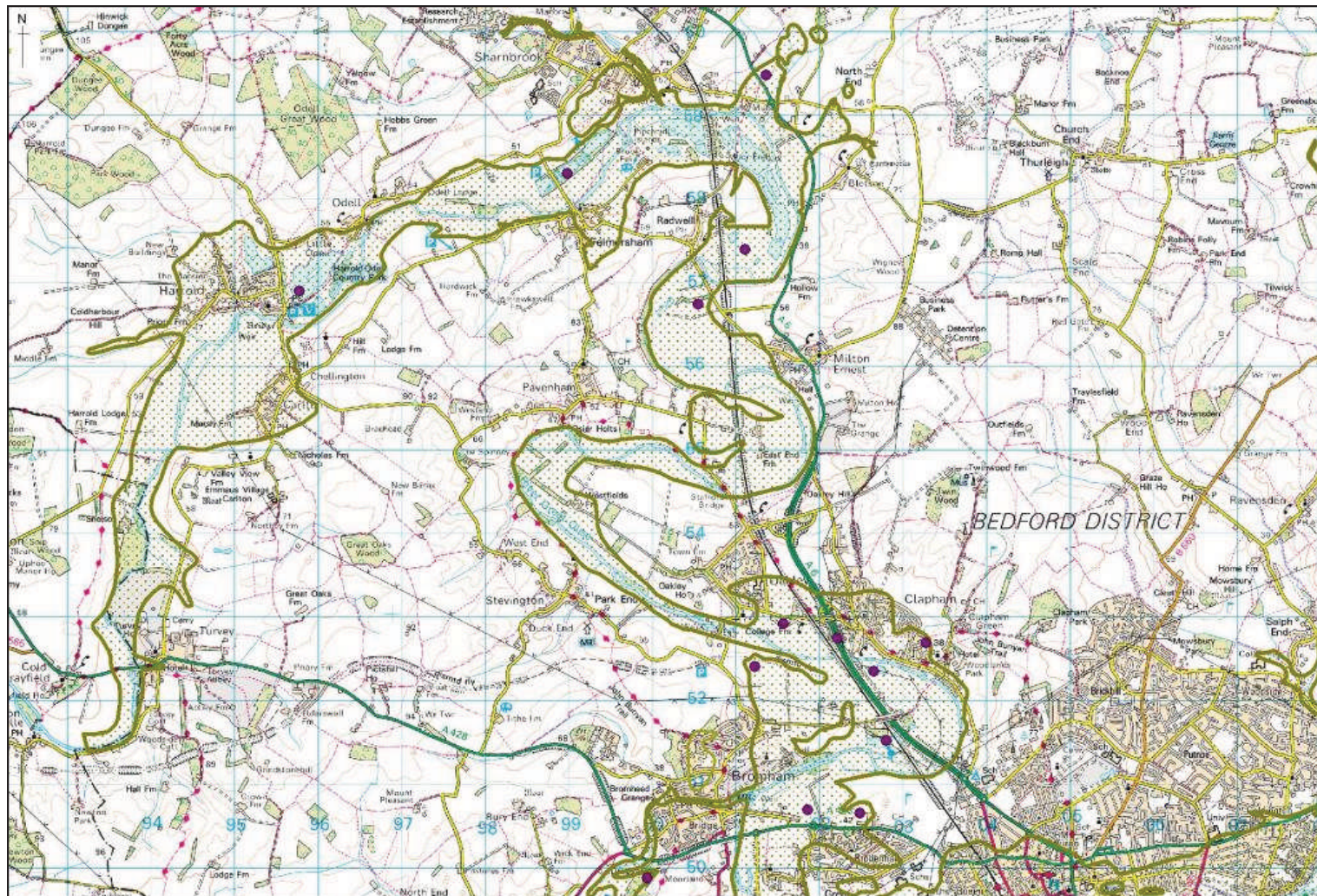
Map 11. River Great Ouse Bronze Age HER Assets – North-Western Area



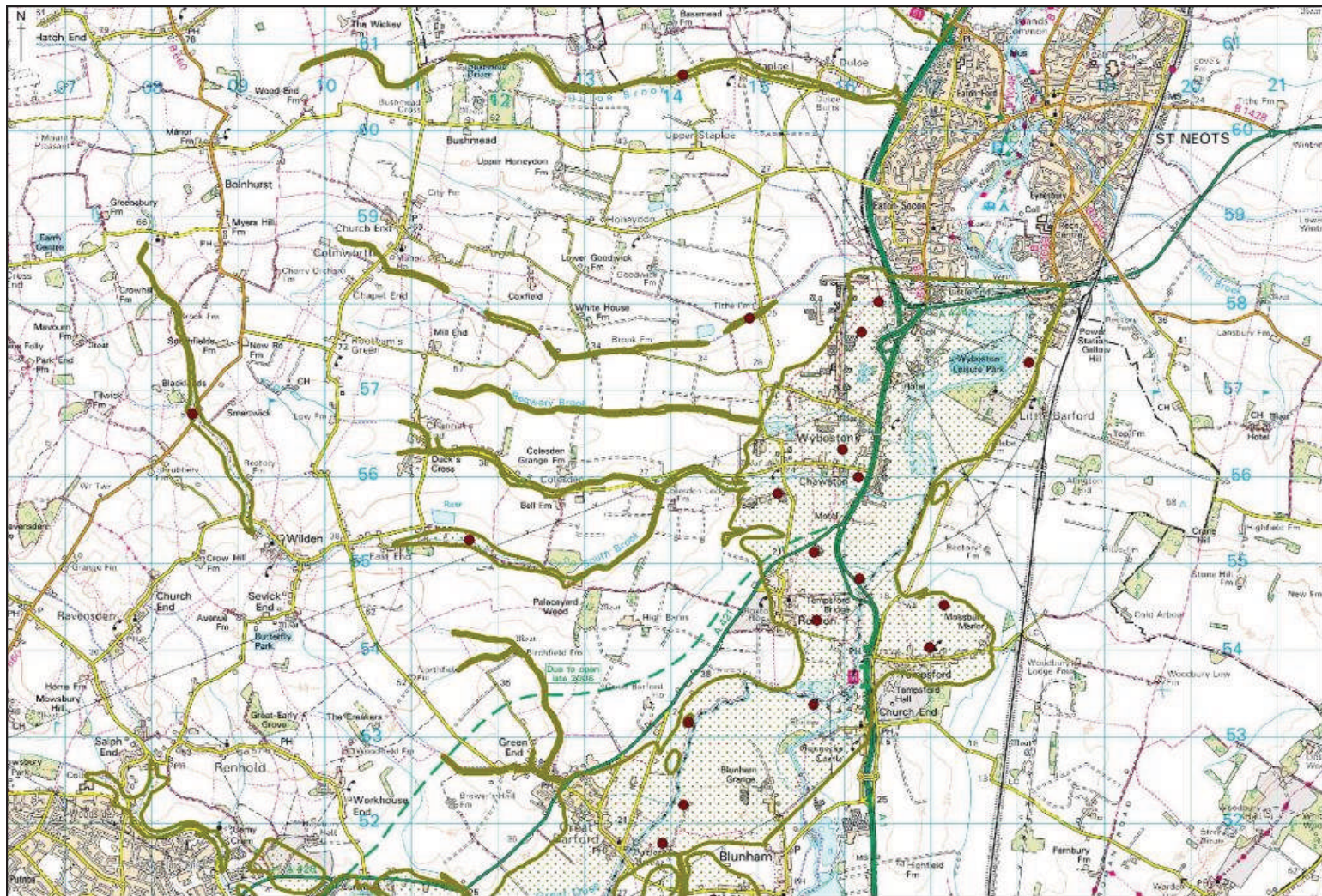
Map 12. River Great Ouse Iron Age HER Assets – Eastern Area



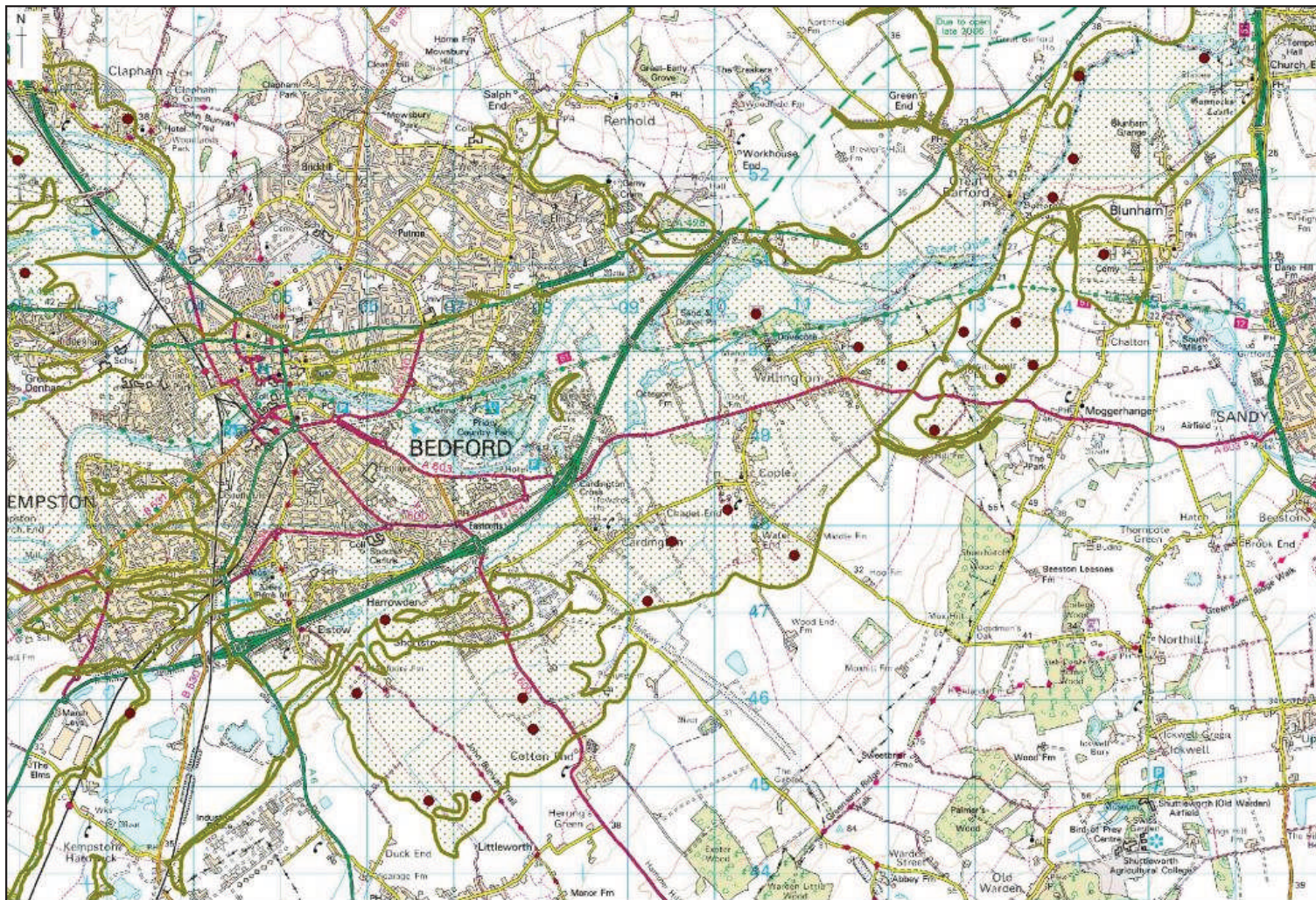
Map 13. River Great Ouse Iron Age HER Assets – Central Area



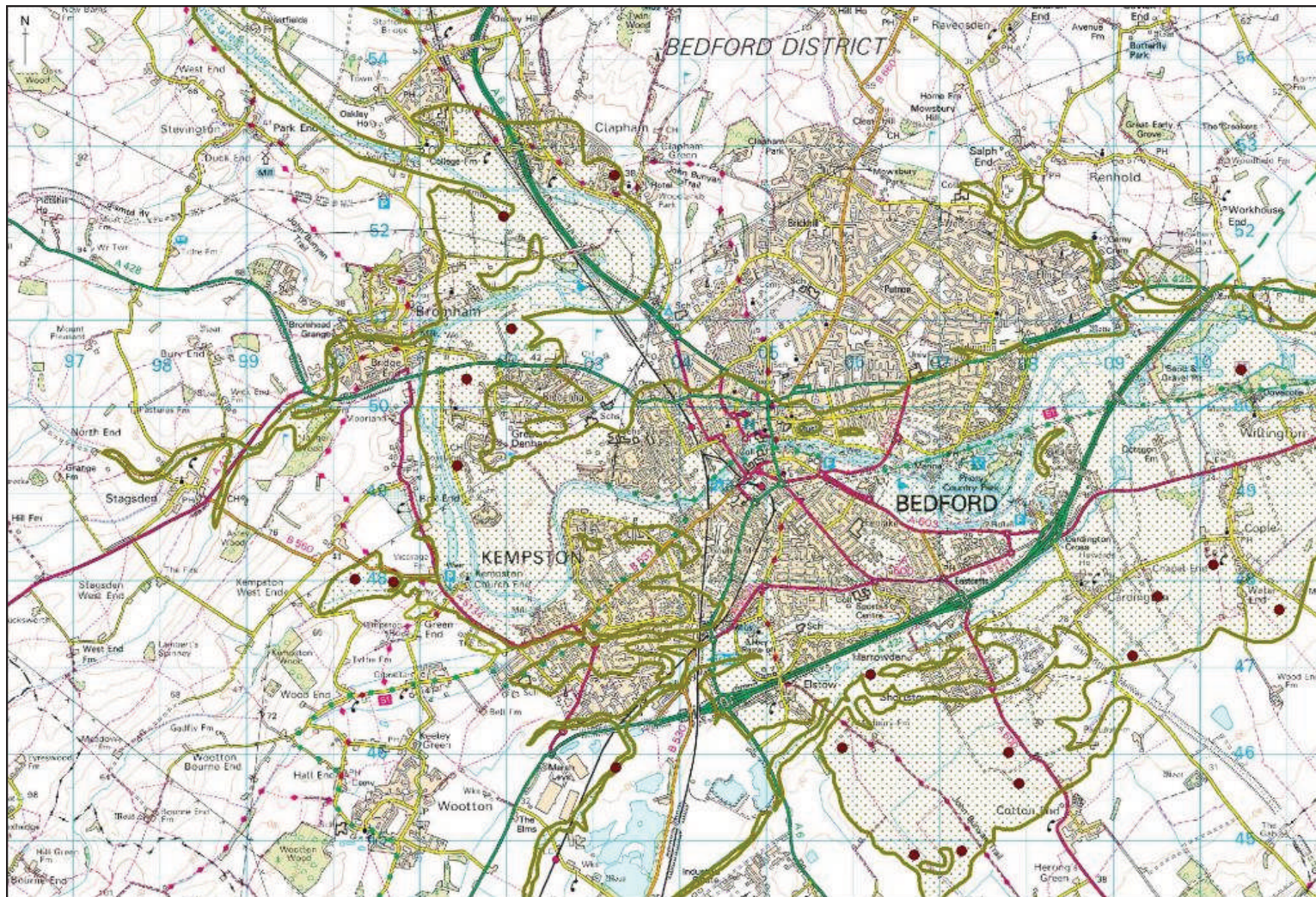
Map 14. River Great Ouse Iron Age HER Assets – North-Western Area



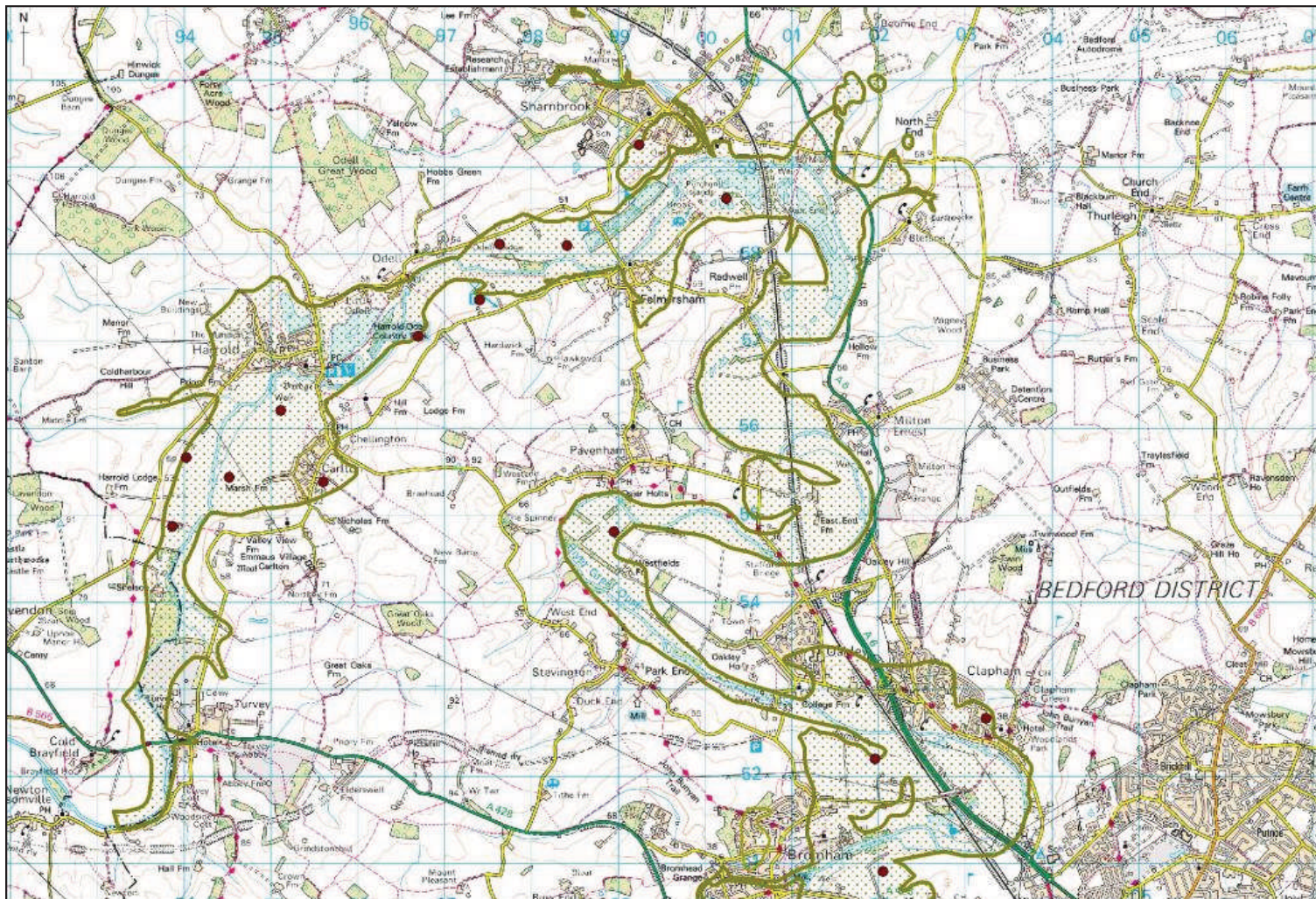
Map 15. River Great Ouse Late Prehistoric HER Assets – Eastern Area

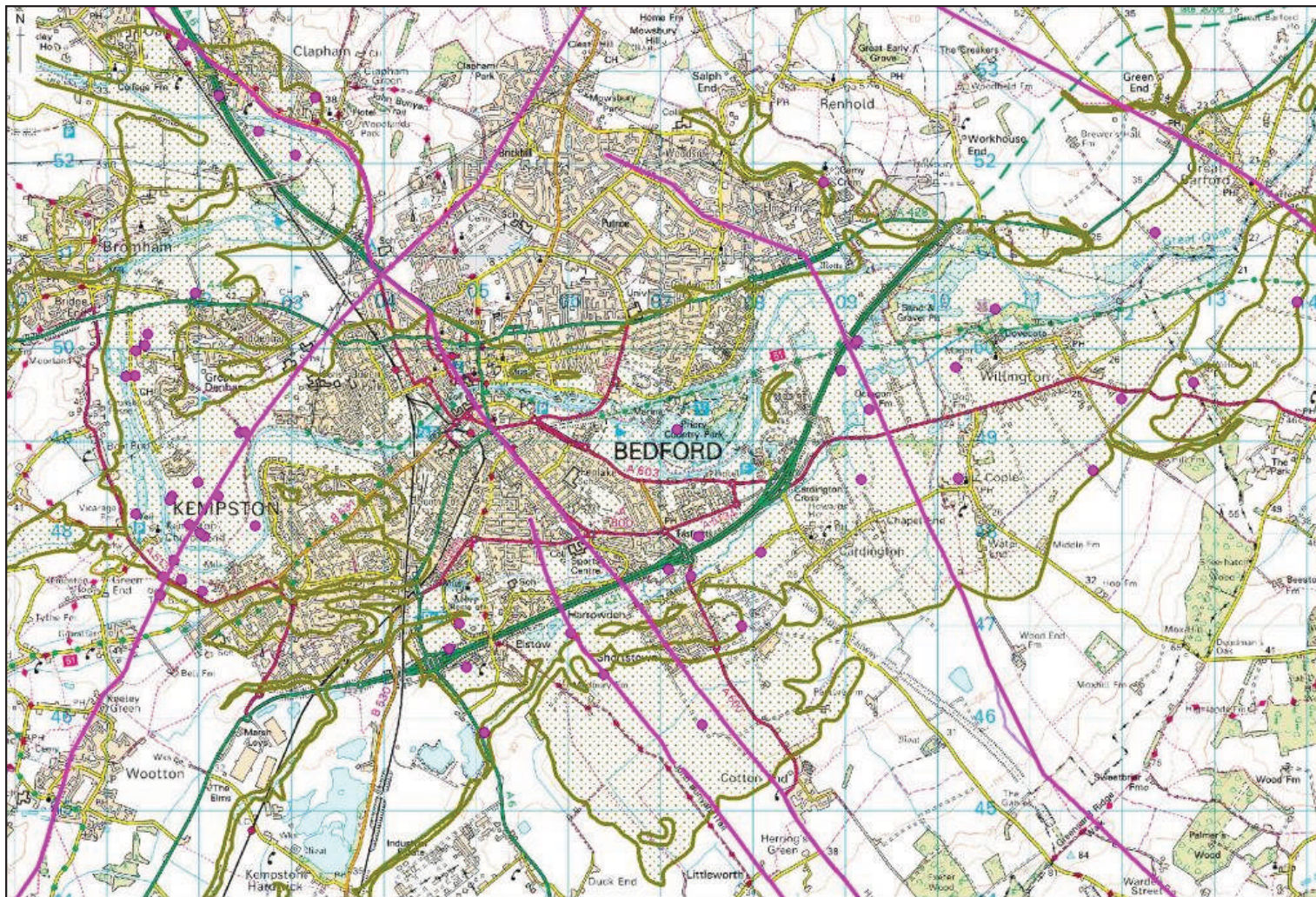
Map 18. River Great Ouse Late Prehistoric HER Assets – North-Western Area



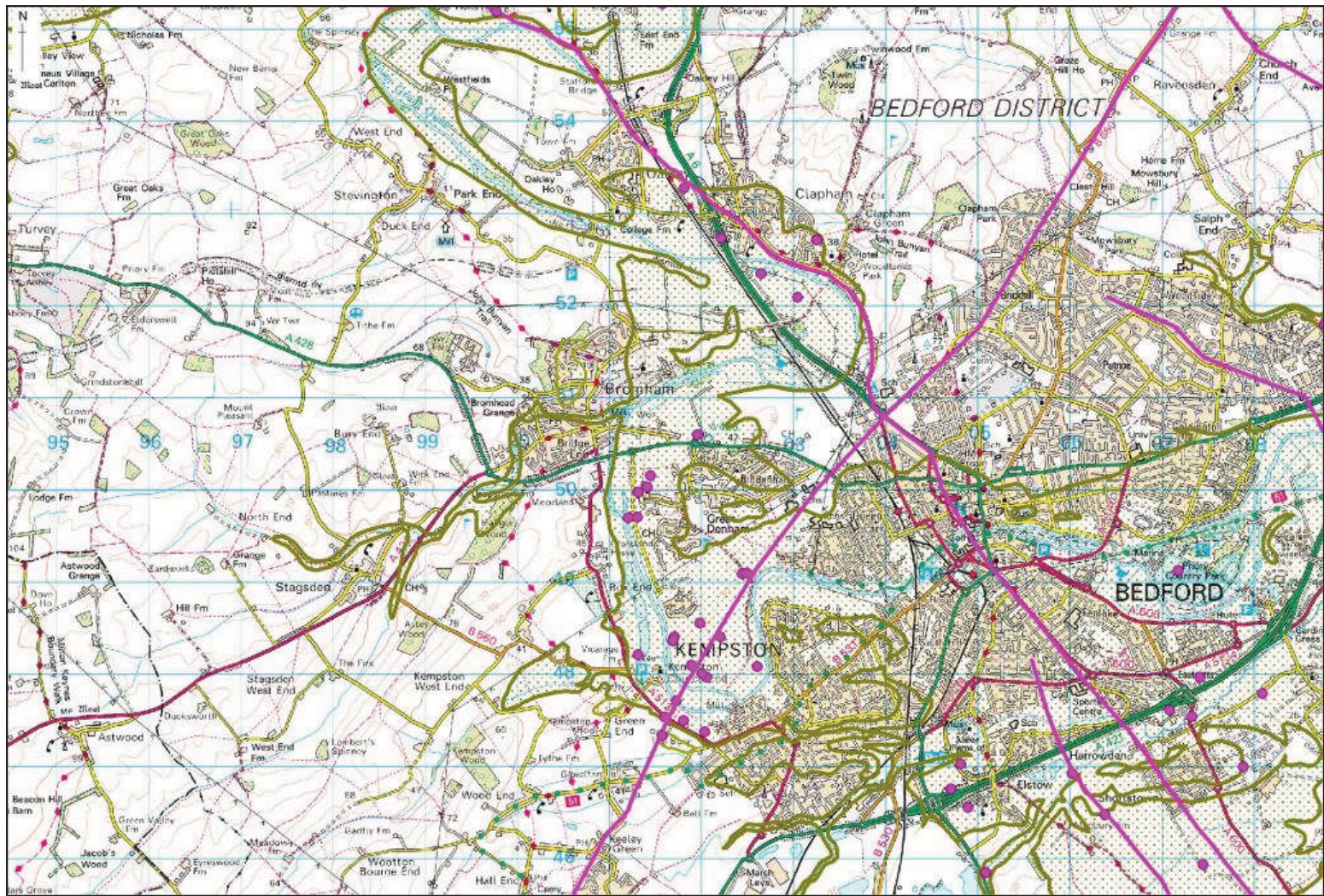
Map 19. River Great Ouse Late Prehistoric HER Assets – Northern Area



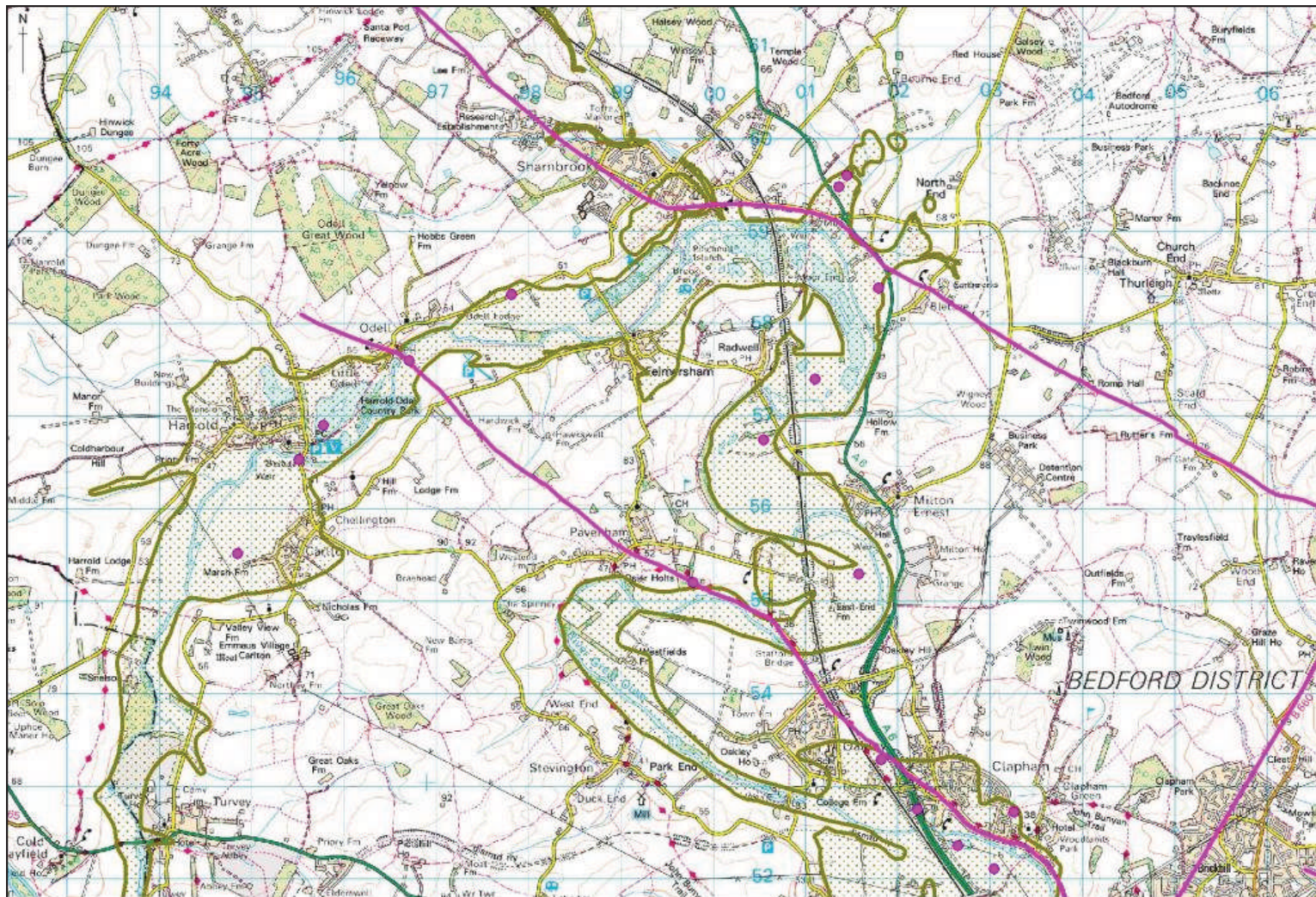
Map 20. River Great Ouse Roman HER Assets – Eastern Area



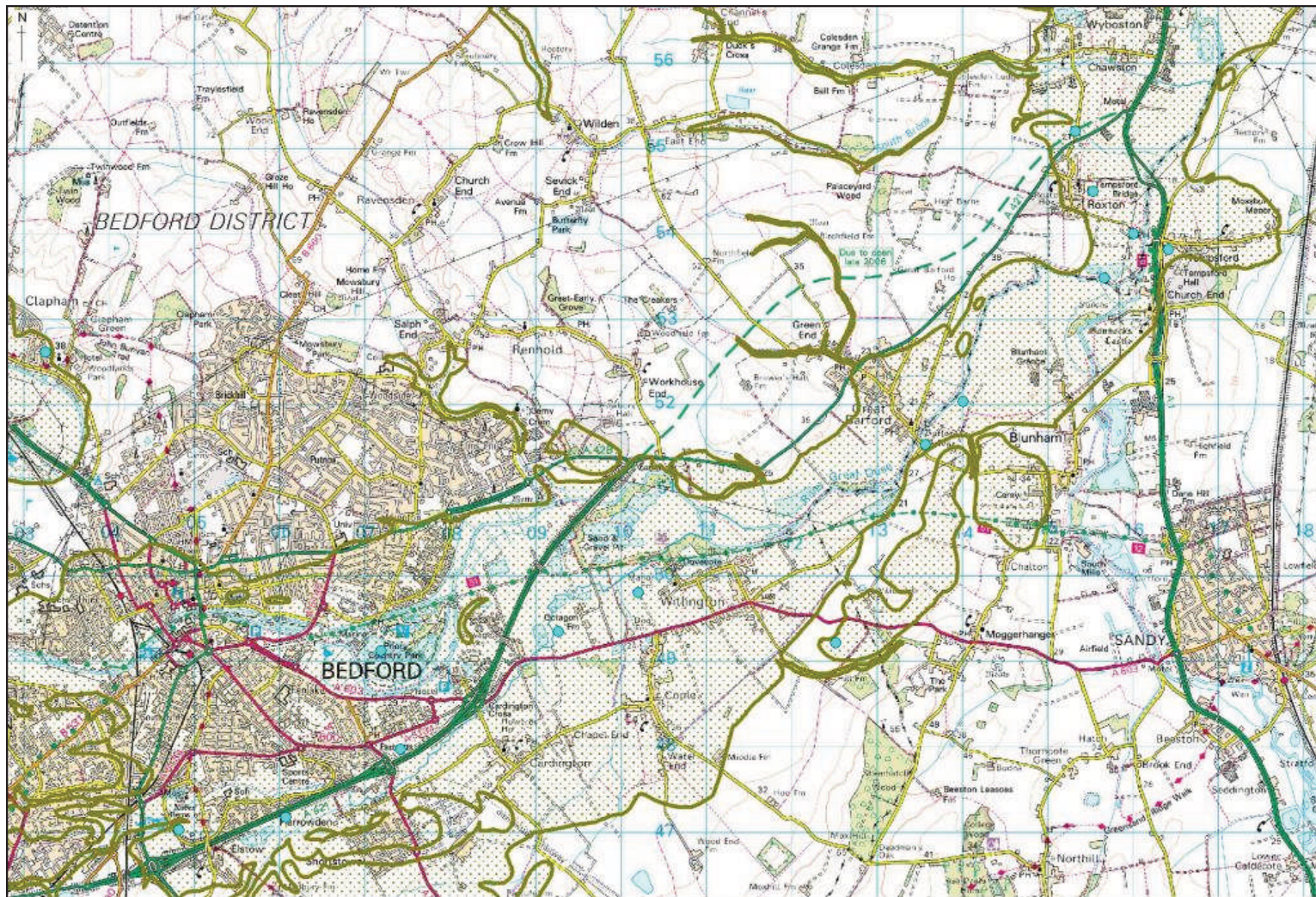
Map 21. River Great Ouse Roman HER Assets – Central Area



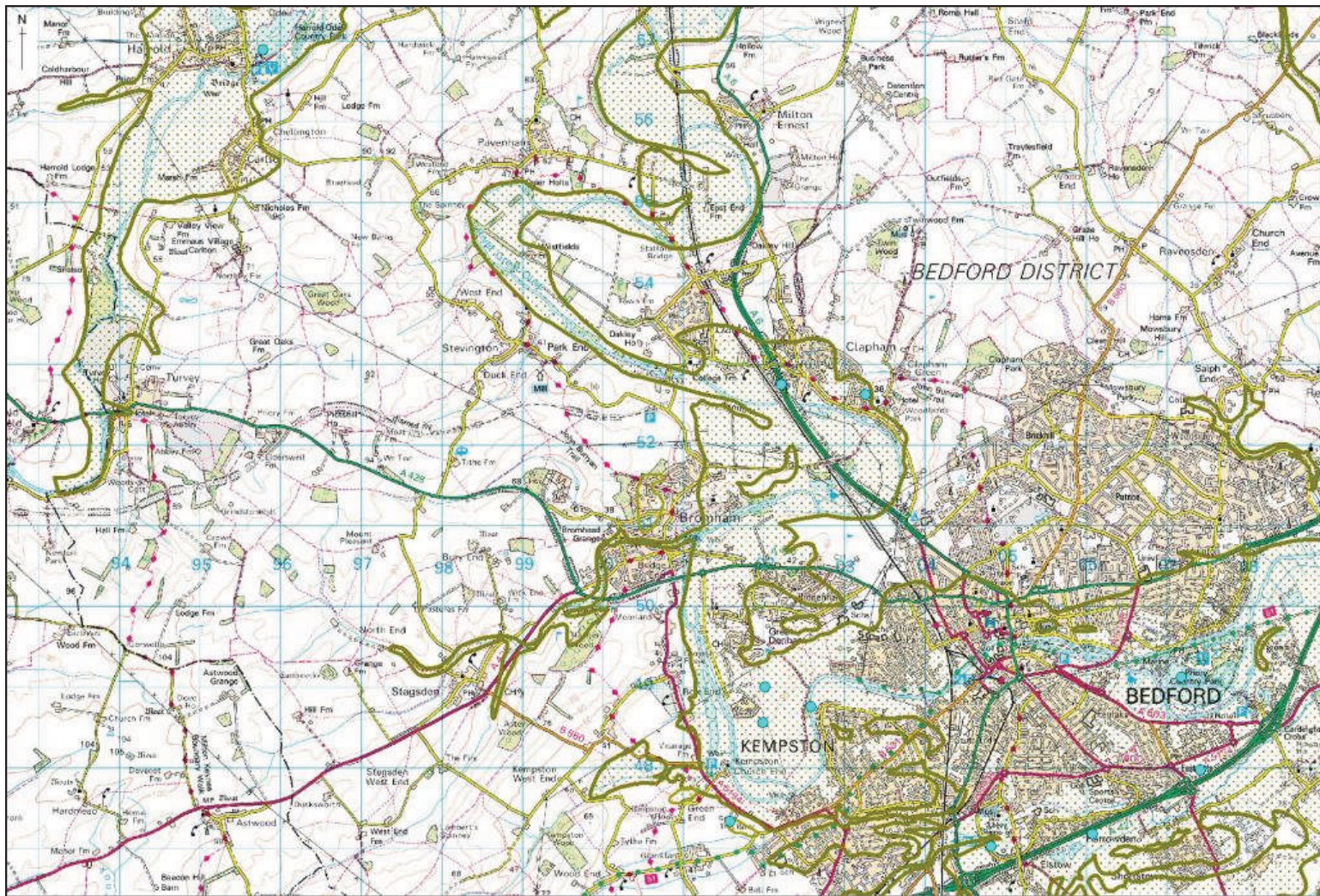
Map 22. River Great Ouse Roman HER Assets – Western Area

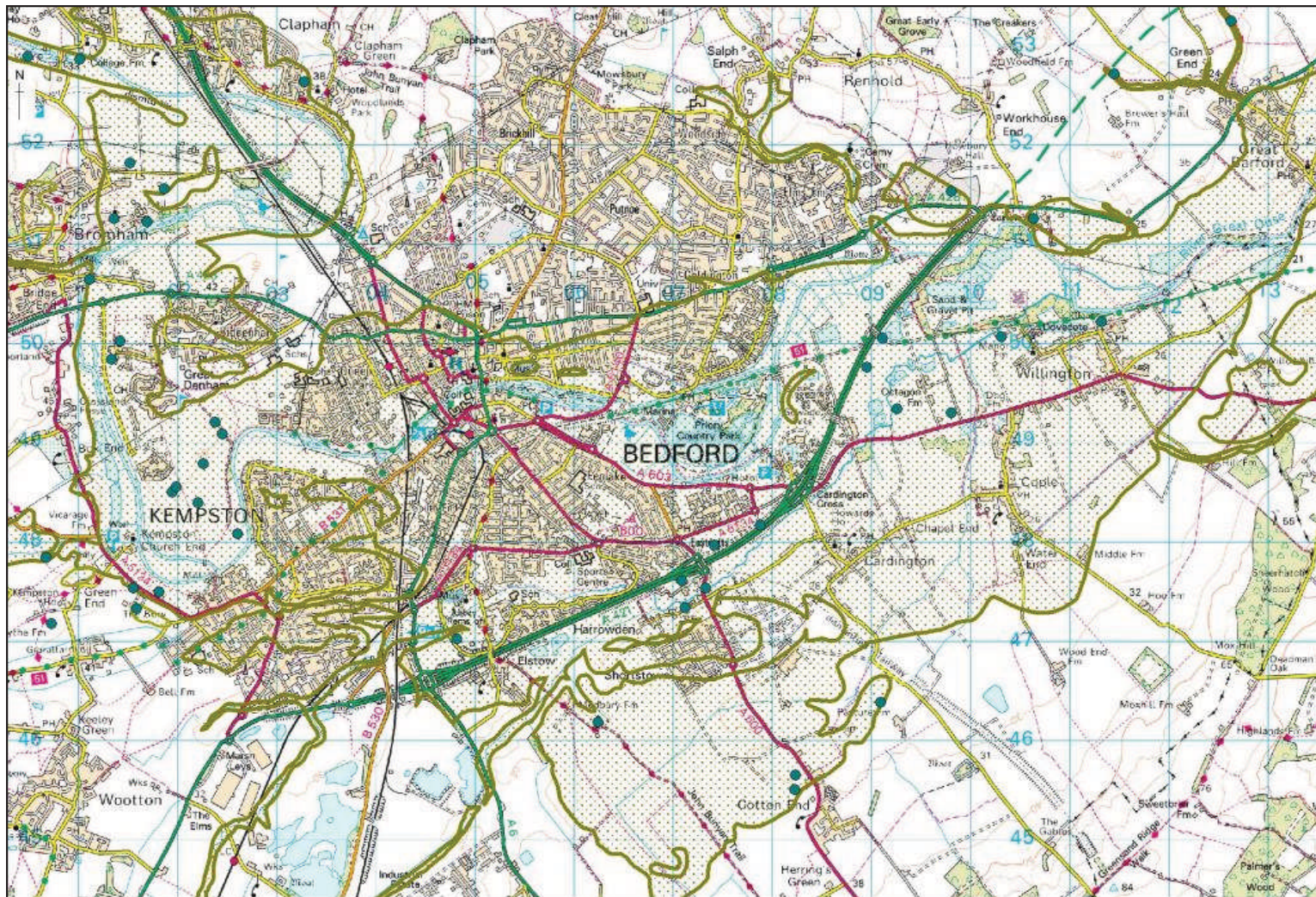
Map 25. River Great Ouse Saxon HER Assets – Western Area

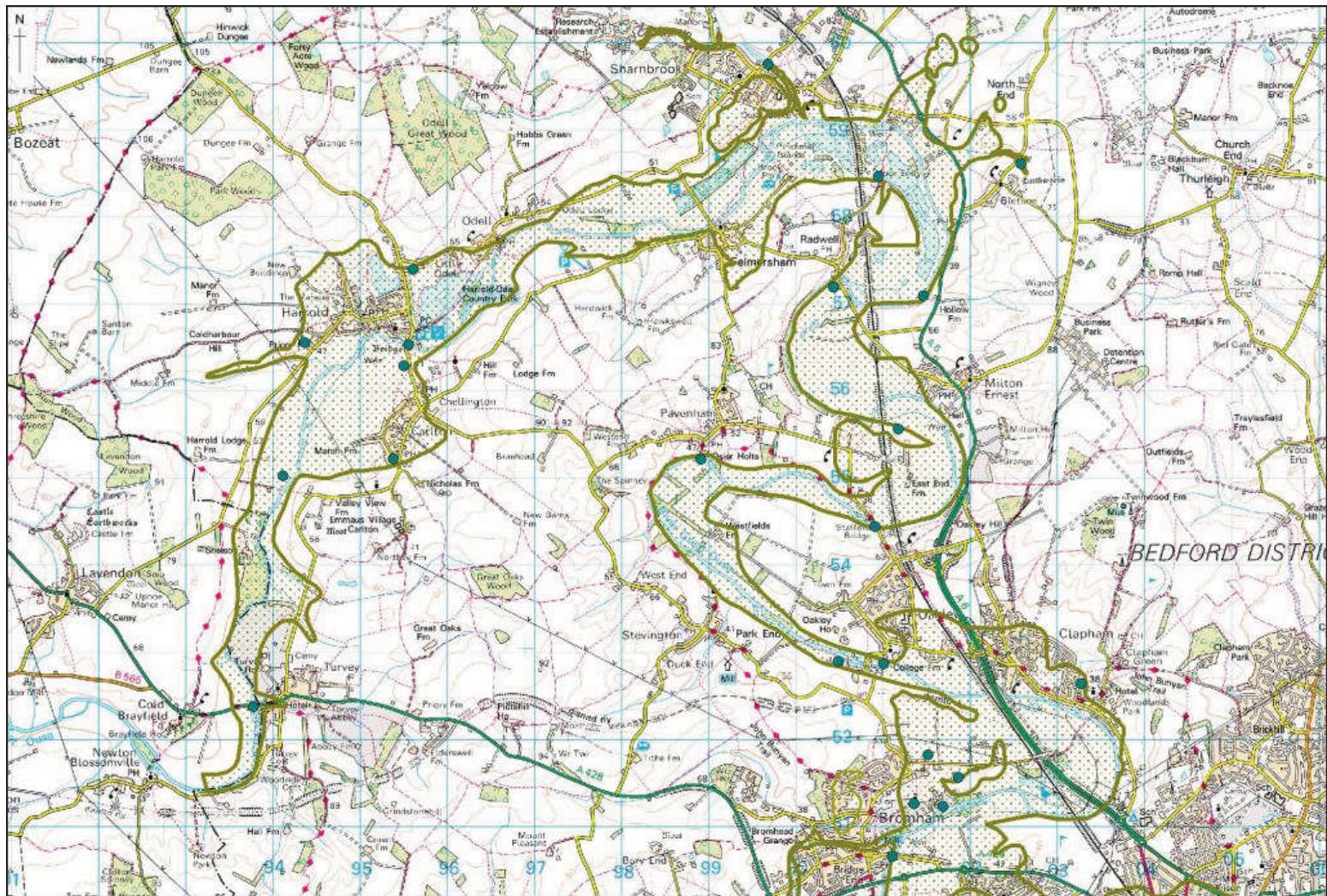
Map 27. River Great Ouse Medieval HER Assets – Eastern Area

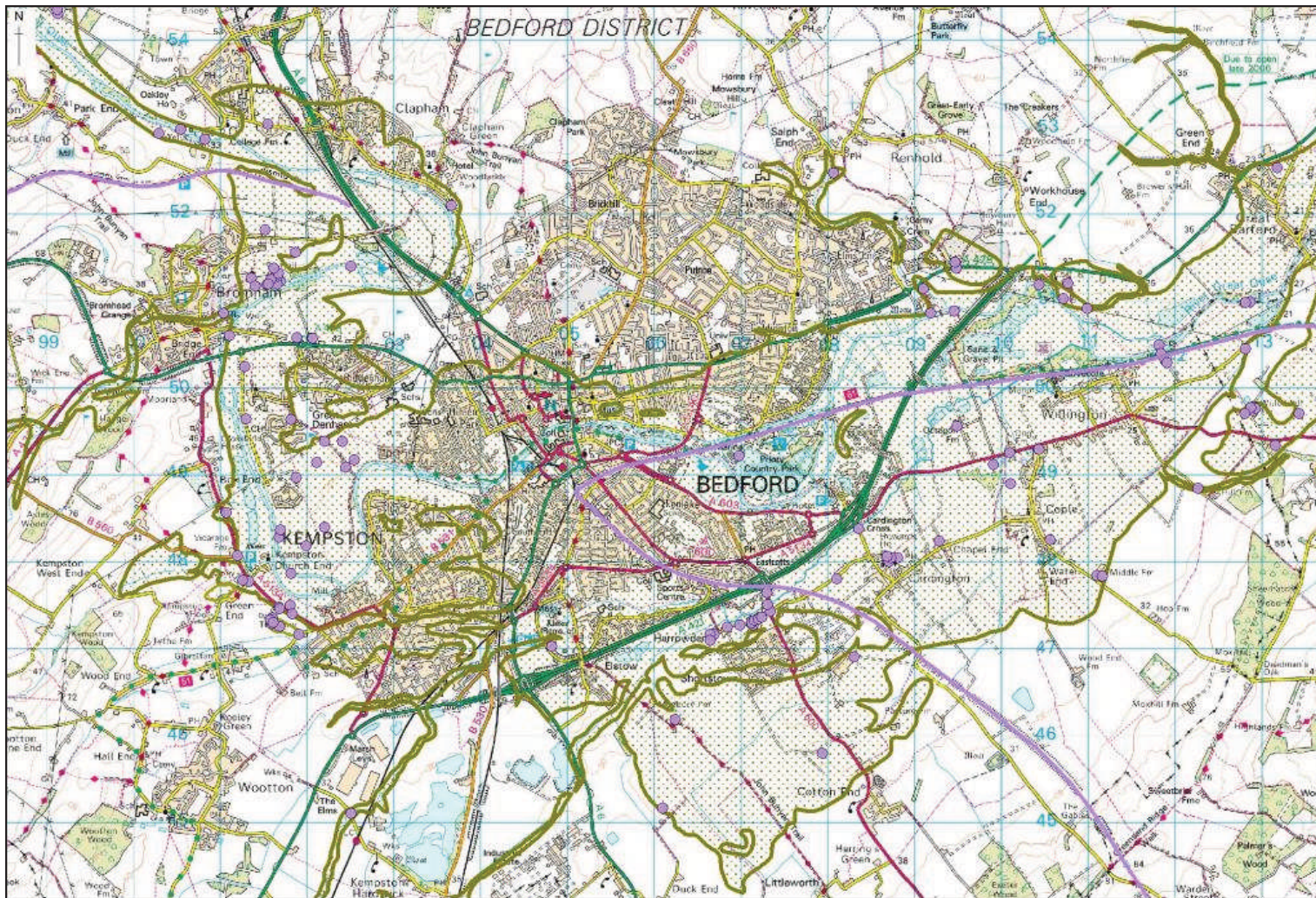
Map 30. River Great Ouse Medieval HER Assets – North-Western Area



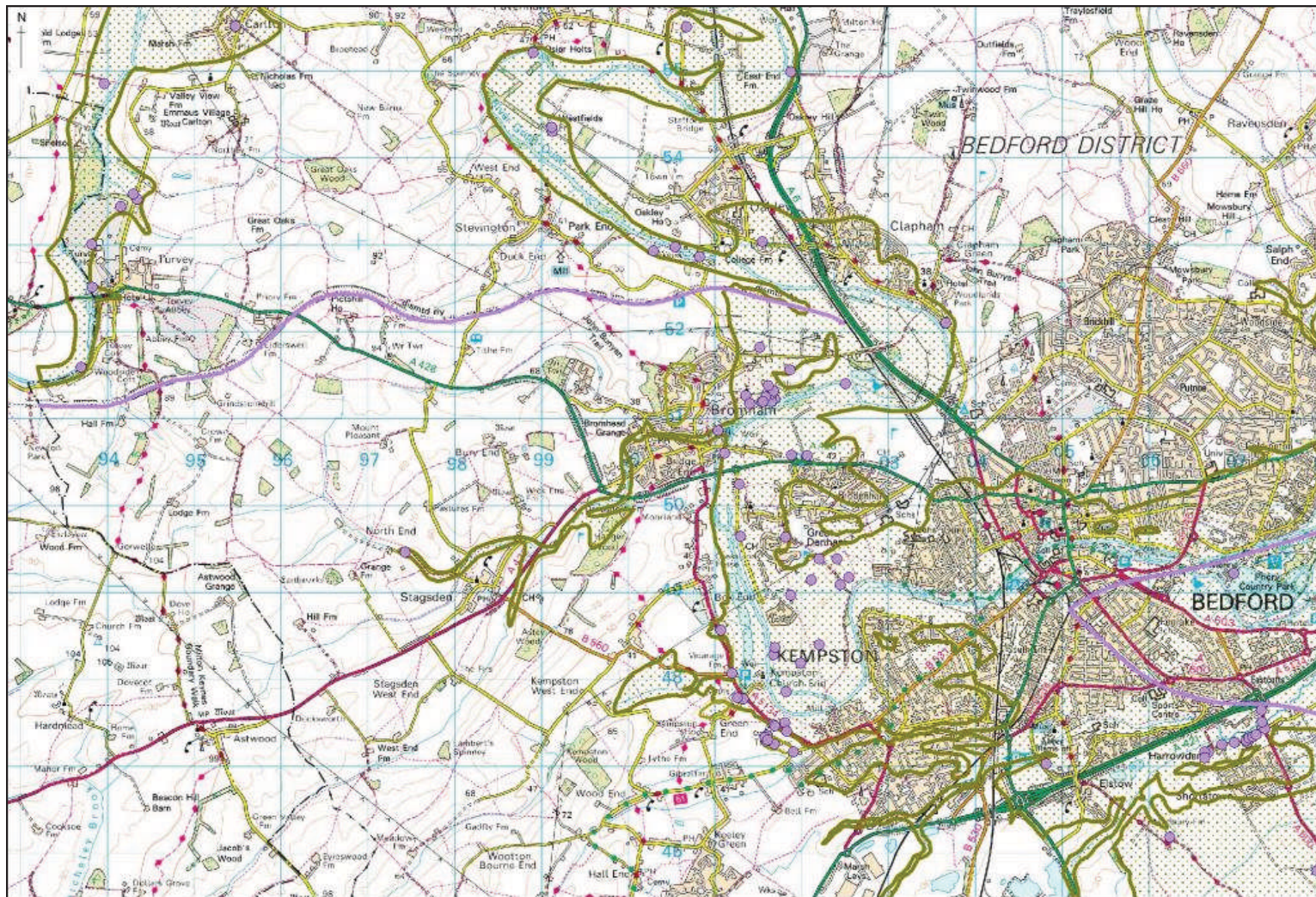
Map 31. River Great Ouse Medieval HER Assets – Northern Area



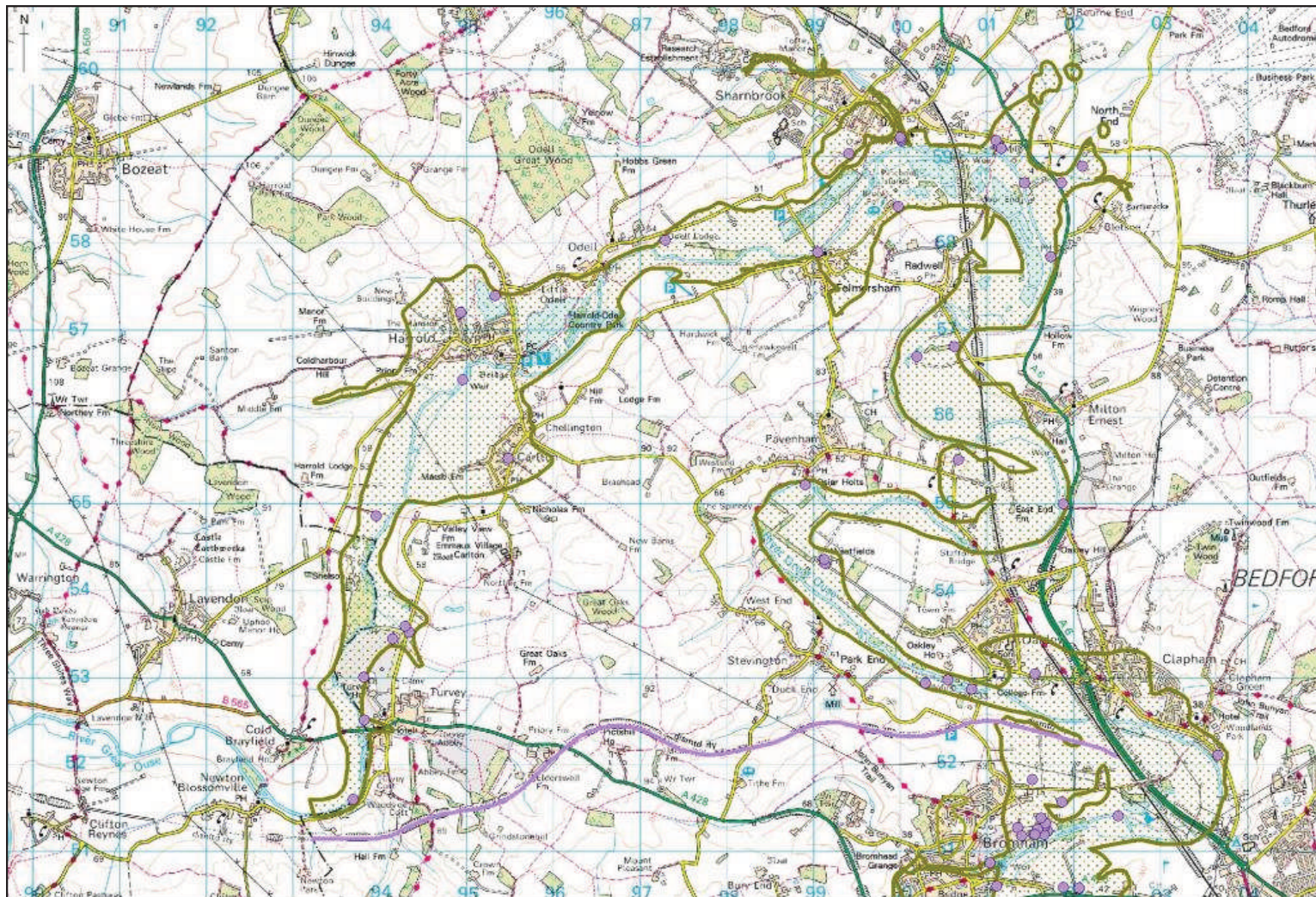
Map 32. River Great Ouse Post Medieval HER Assets – Eastern Area



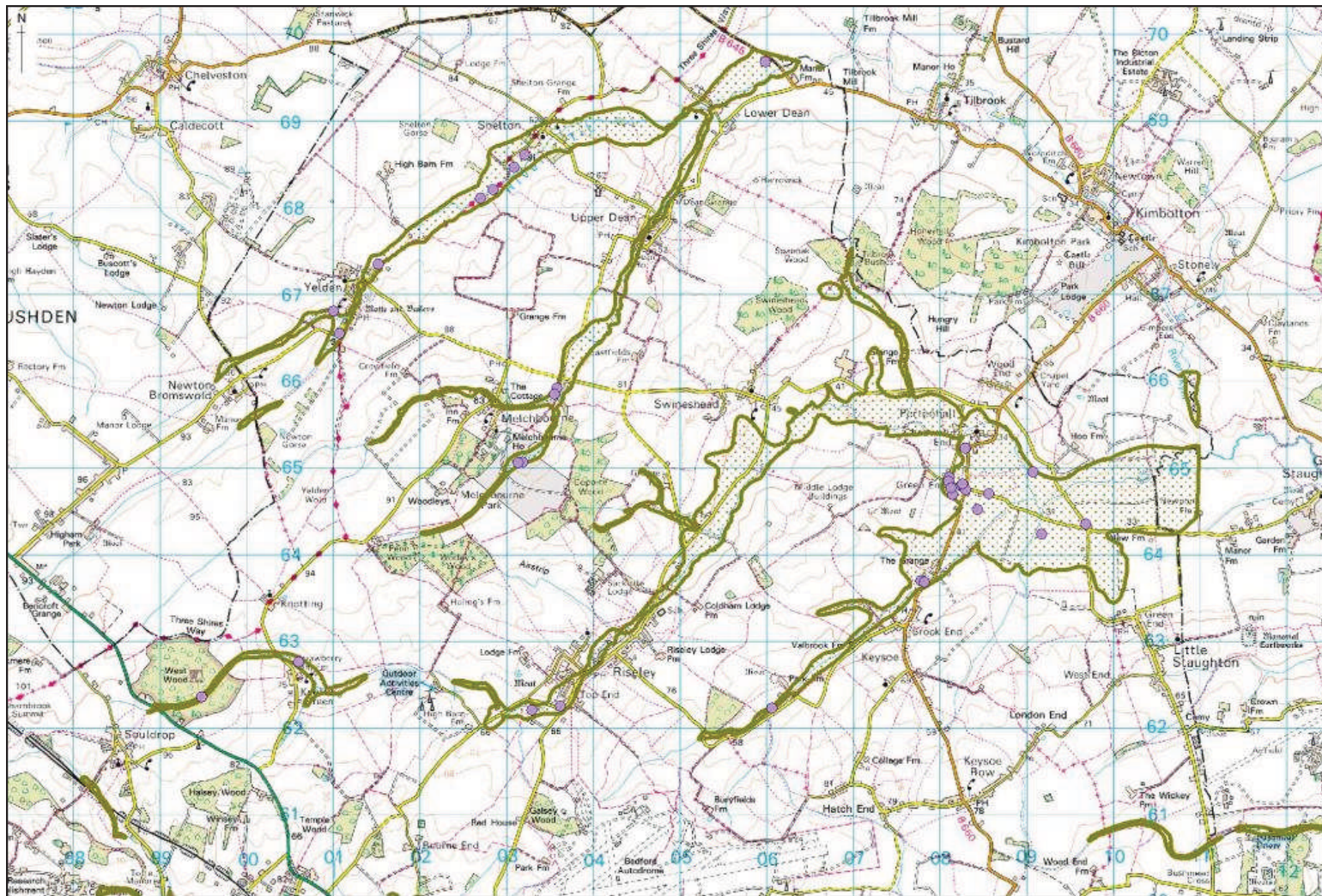
Map 33. River Great Ouse Post Medieval HER Assets – Central Area



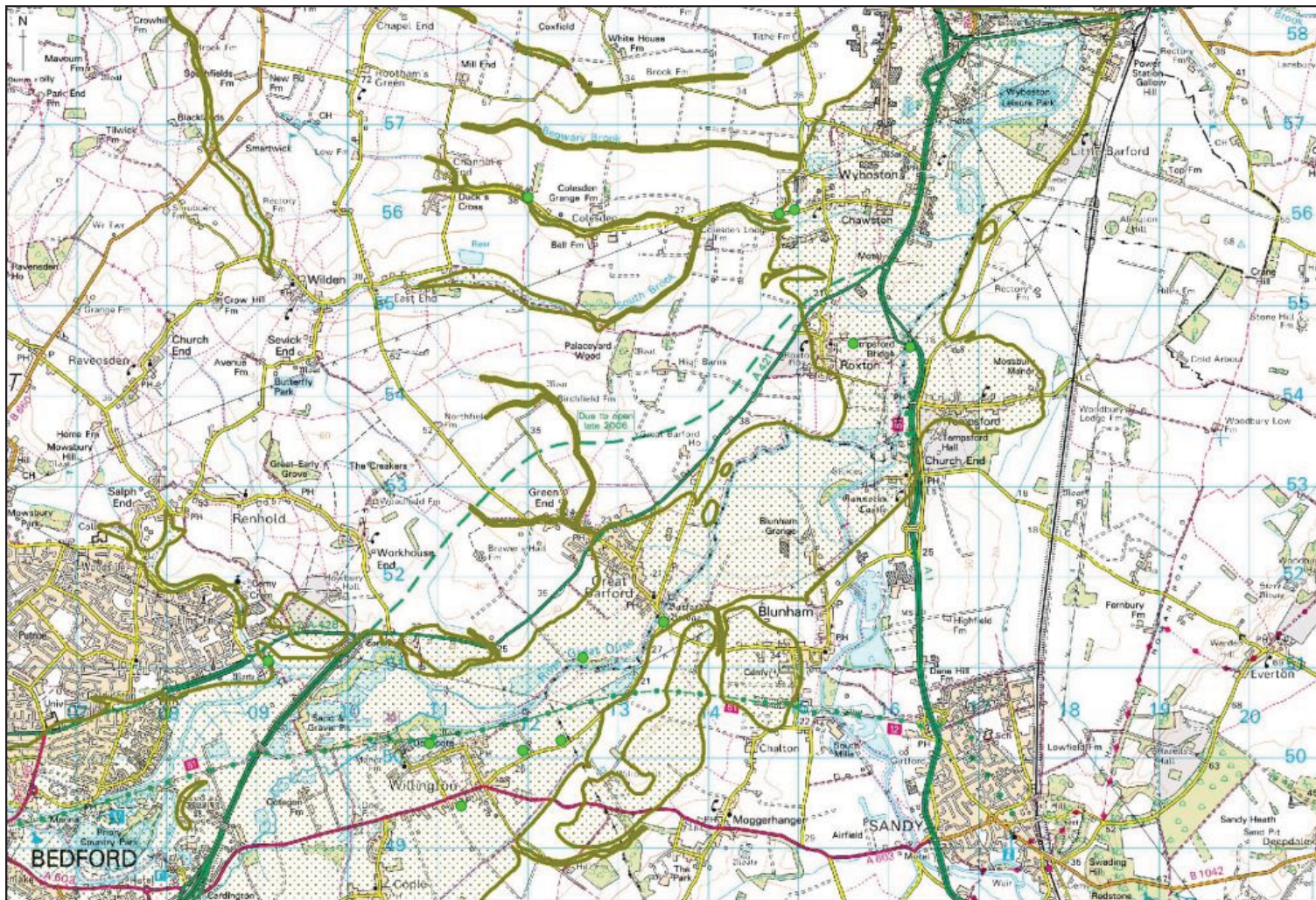
Map 34. River Great Ouse Post Medieval HER Assets – Western Area



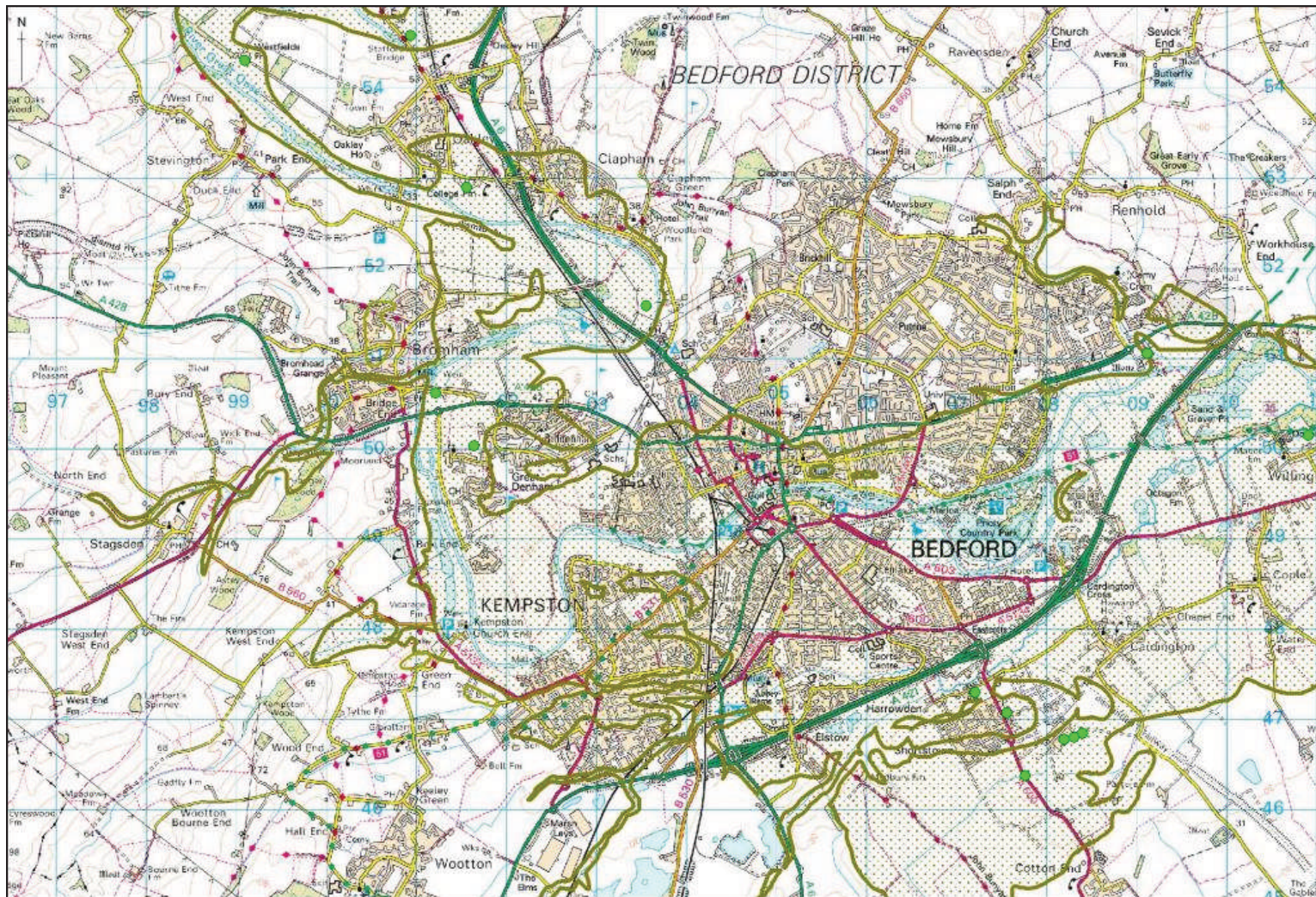
Map 35. River Great Ouse Post Medieval HER Assets – North-Western Area



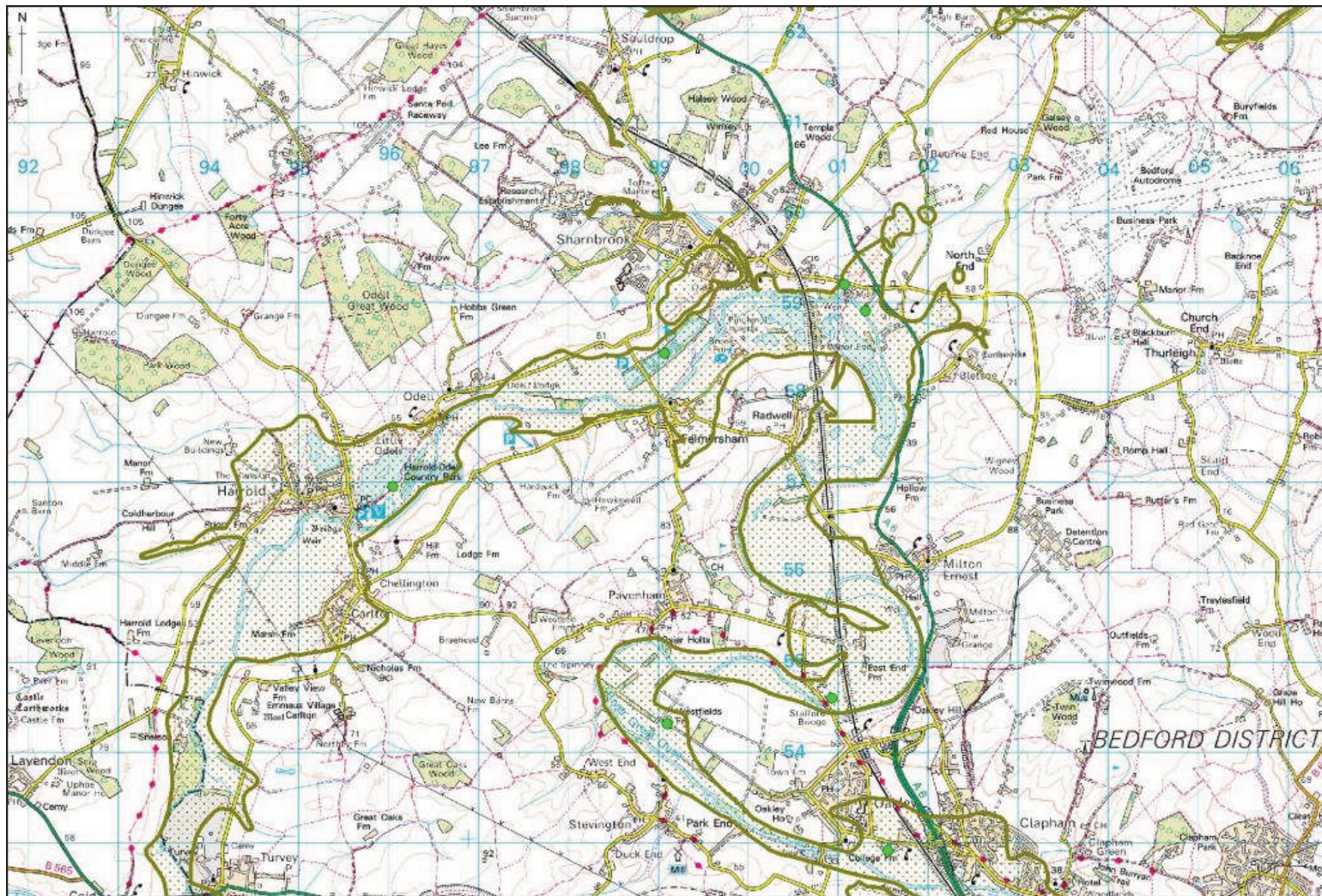
Map 36. River Great Ouse Post Medieval HER Assets – Northern Area



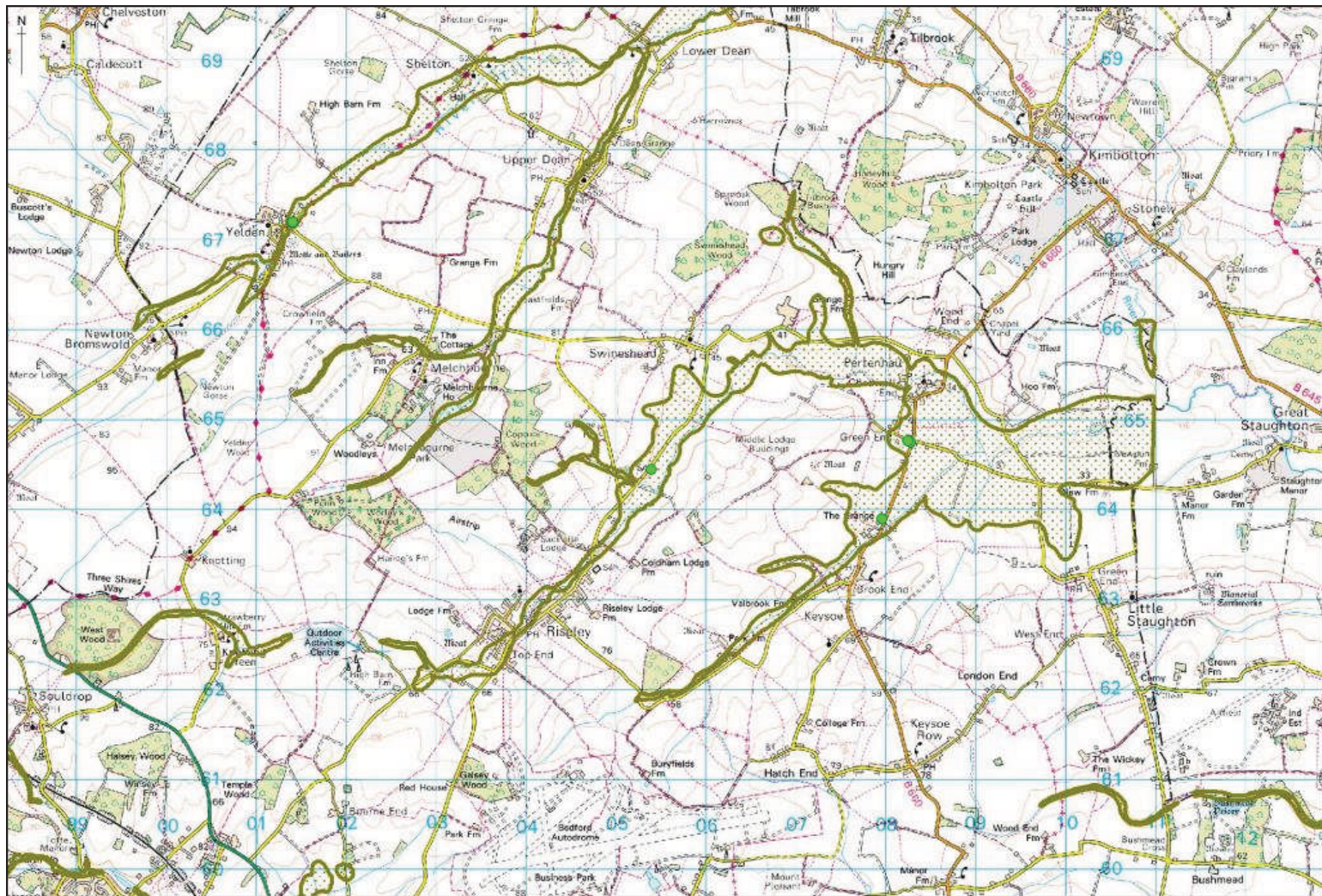
Map 37. River Great Ouse Modern HER Assets – Eastern Area
