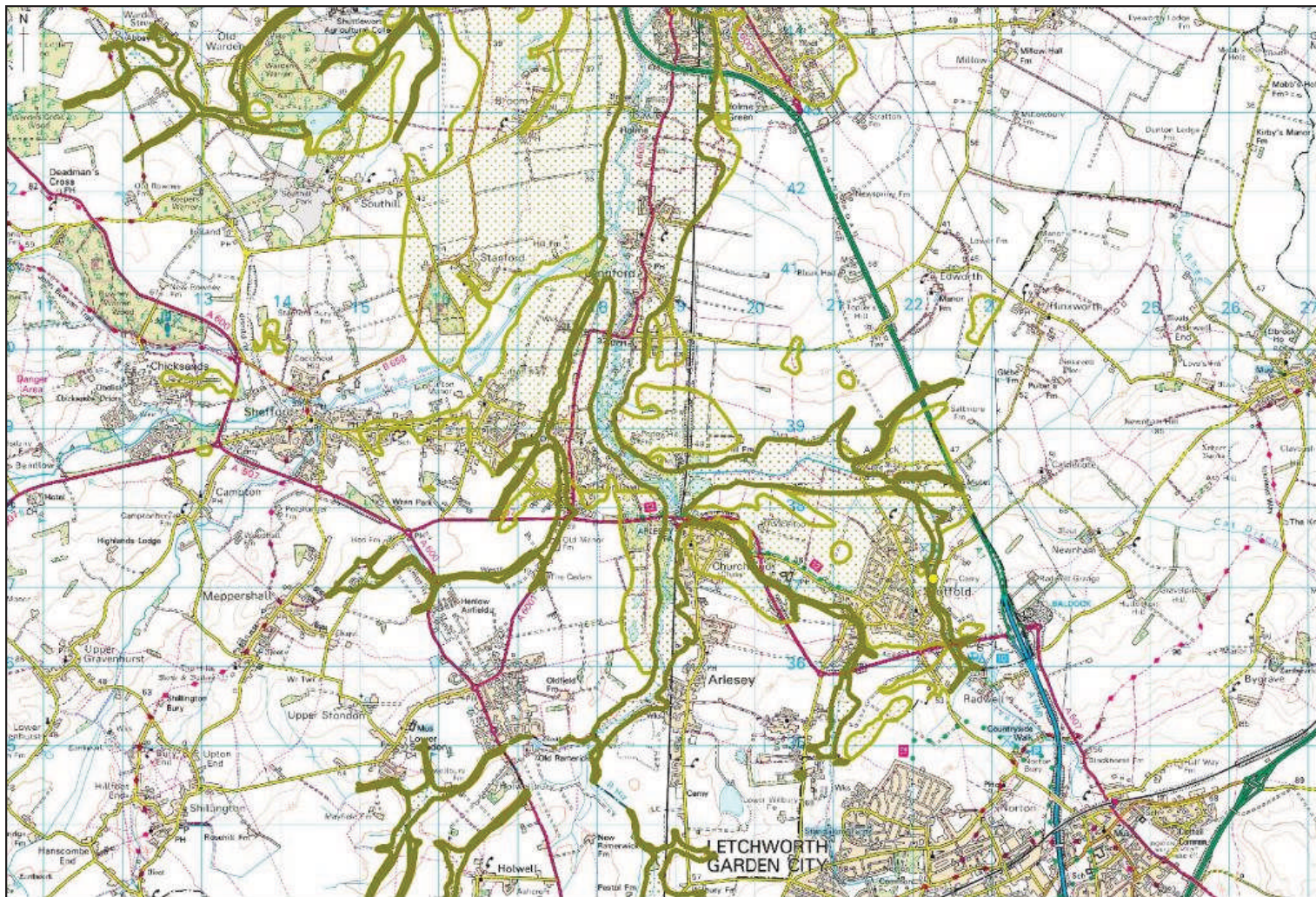

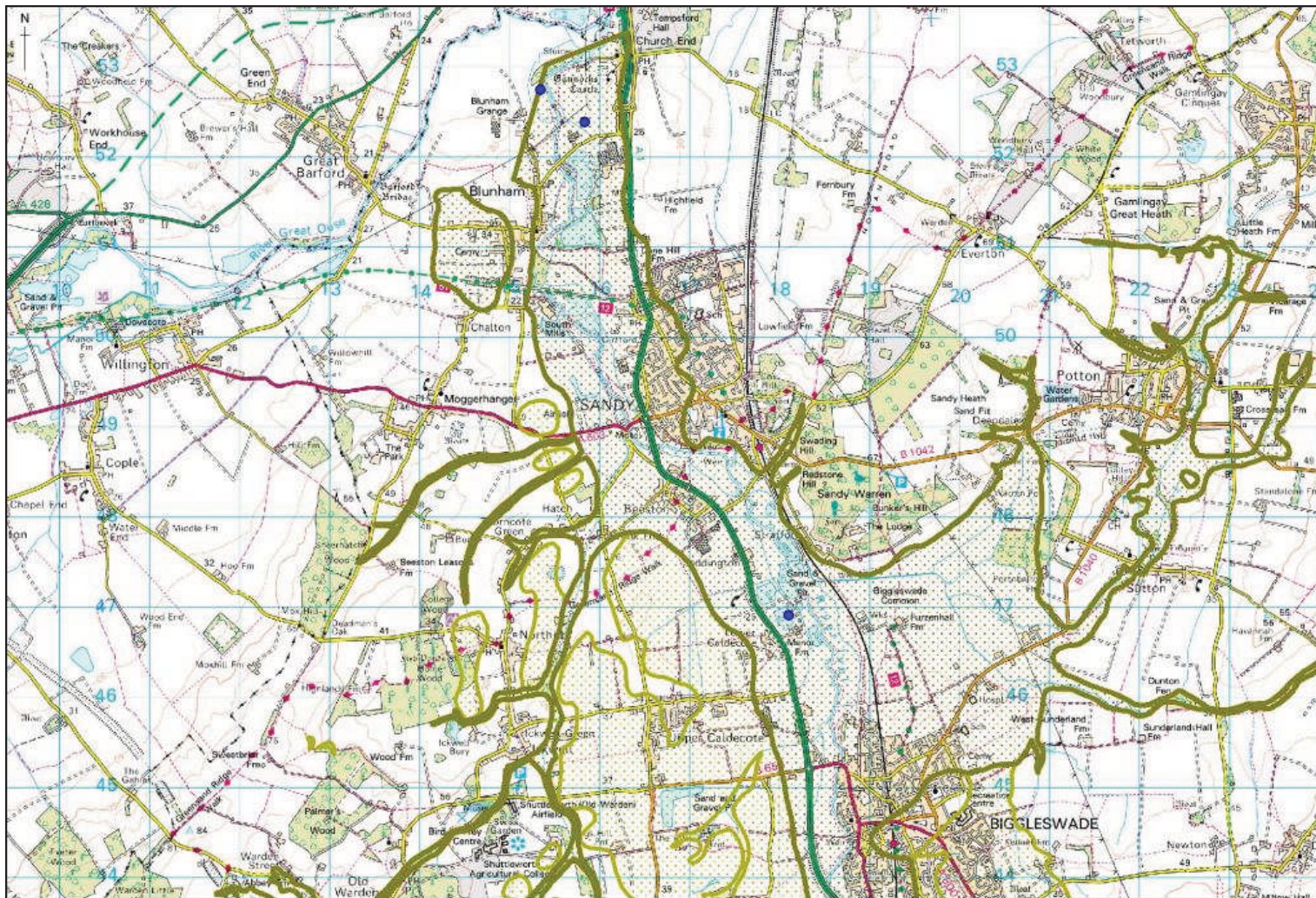

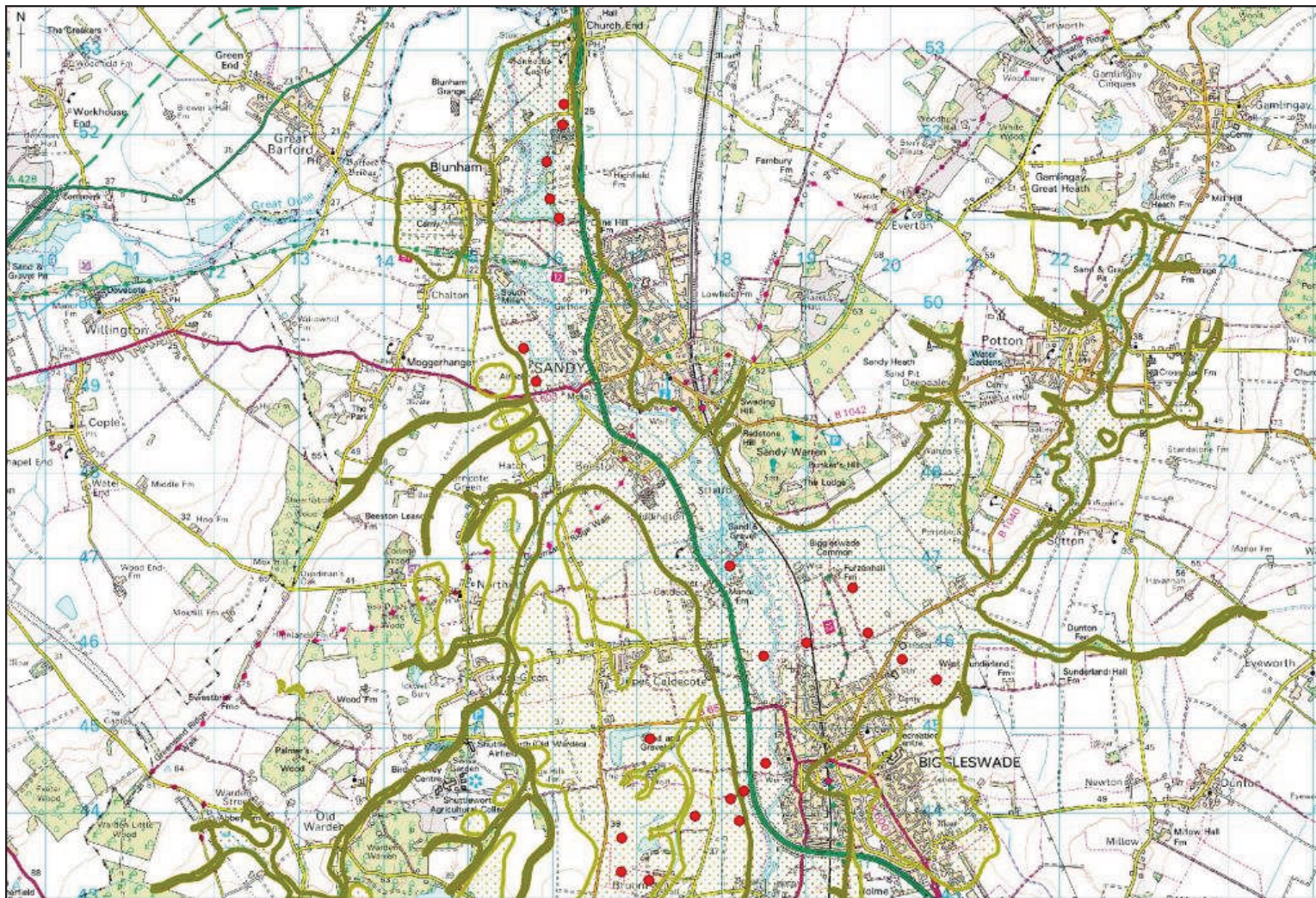
Map 1. River Ivel AS-SA Palaeolithic HER Assets – Northern Area



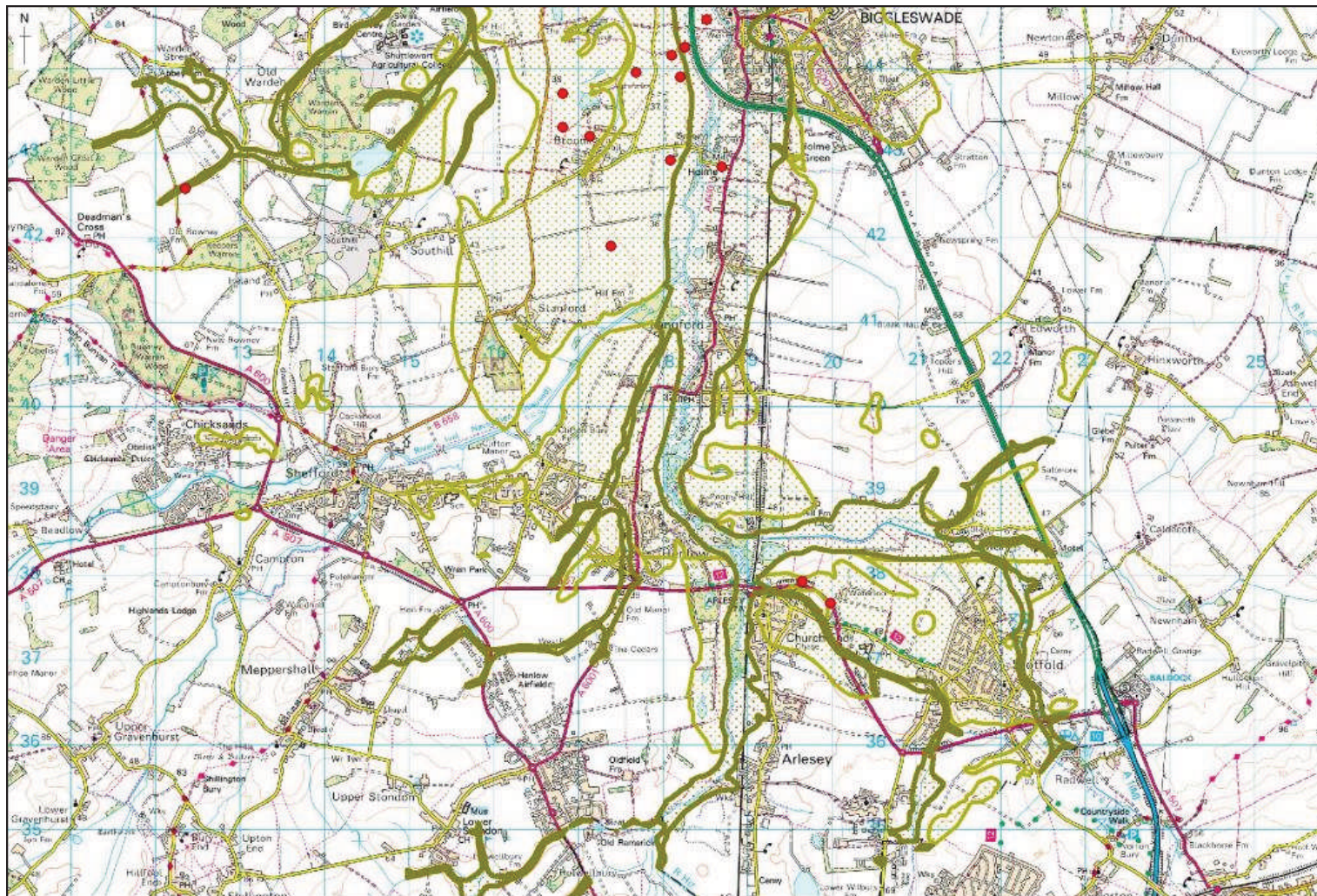
Map 2. River Ivel AS-SA Palaeolithic HER Assets – Southern Area



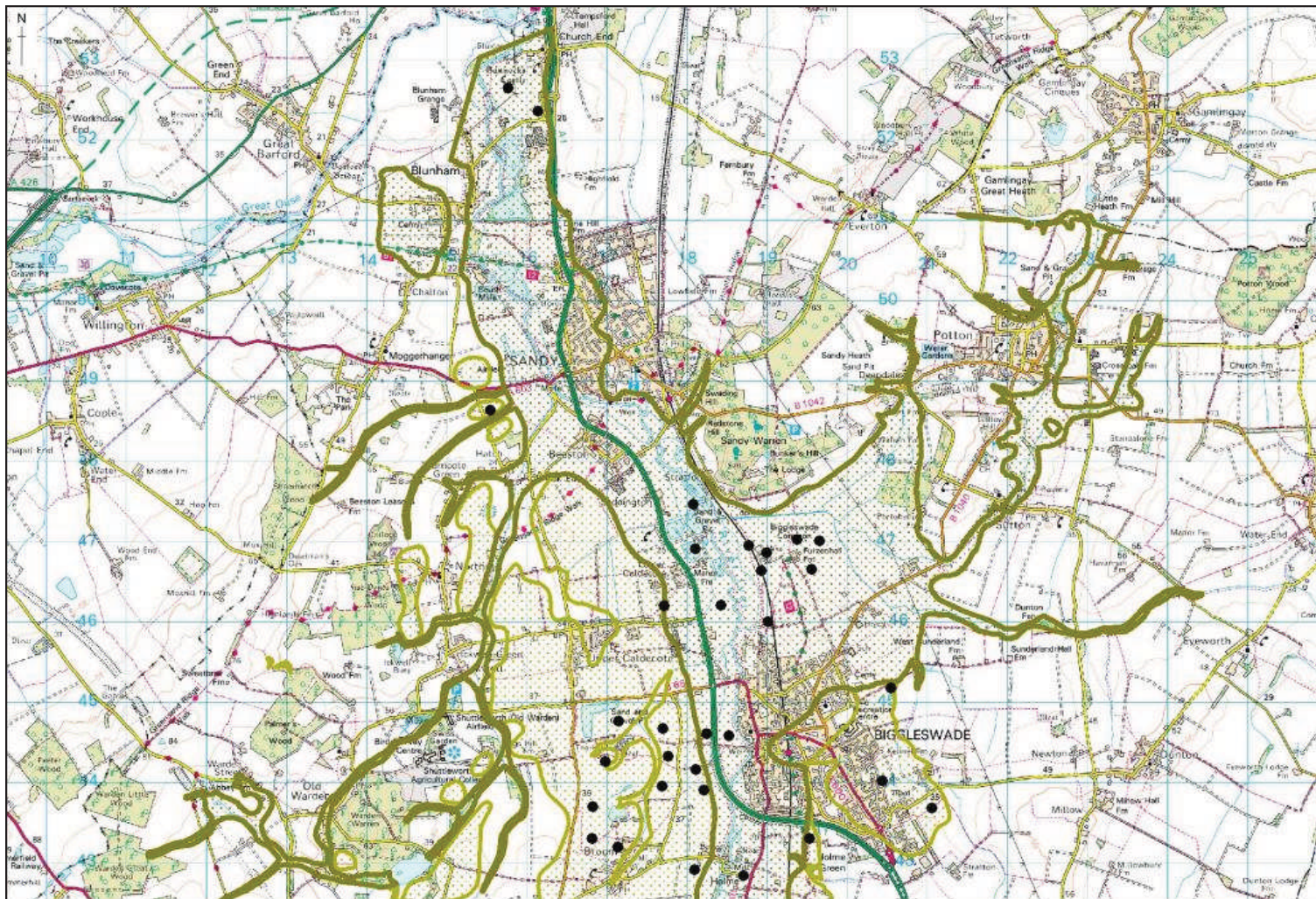
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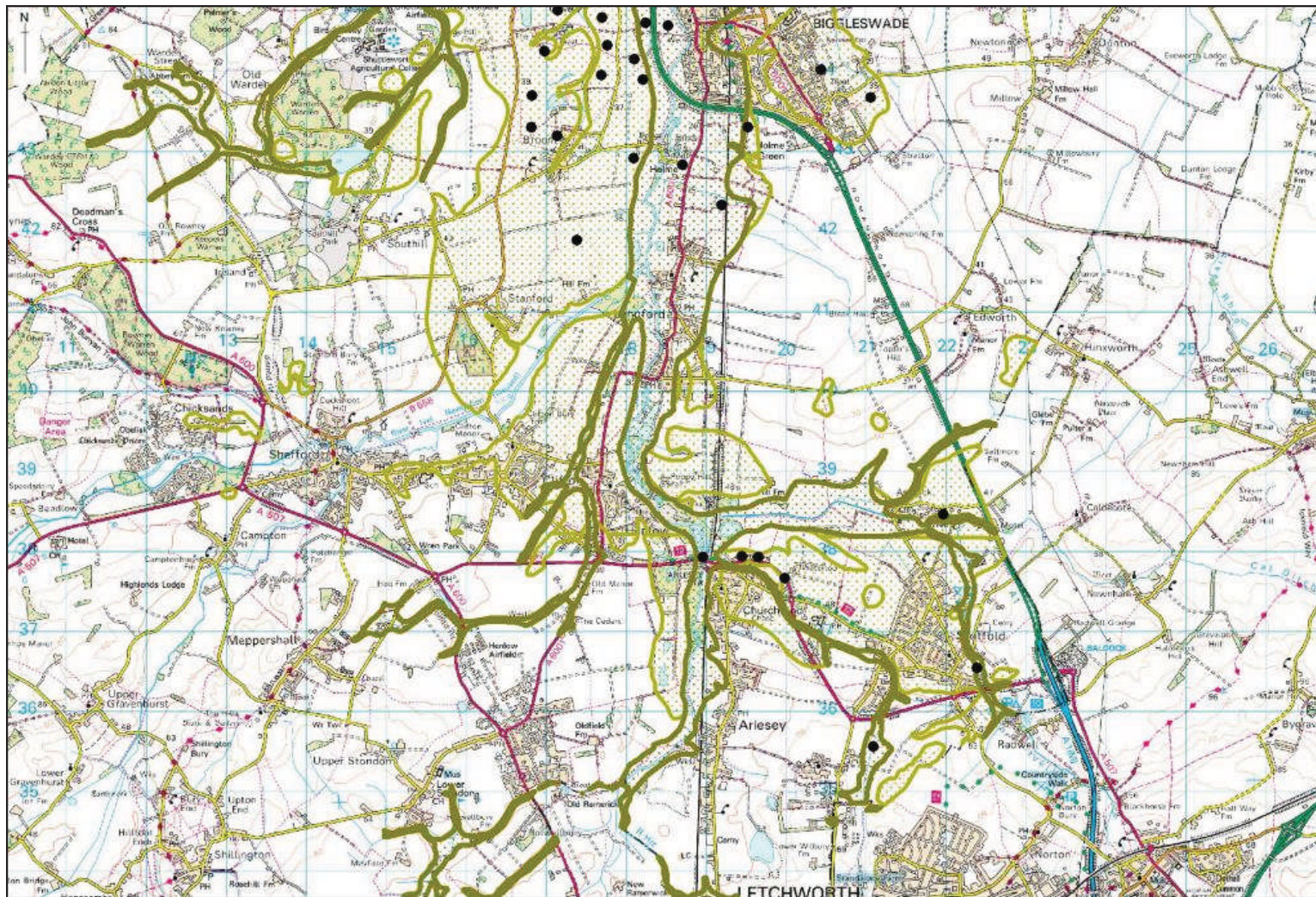
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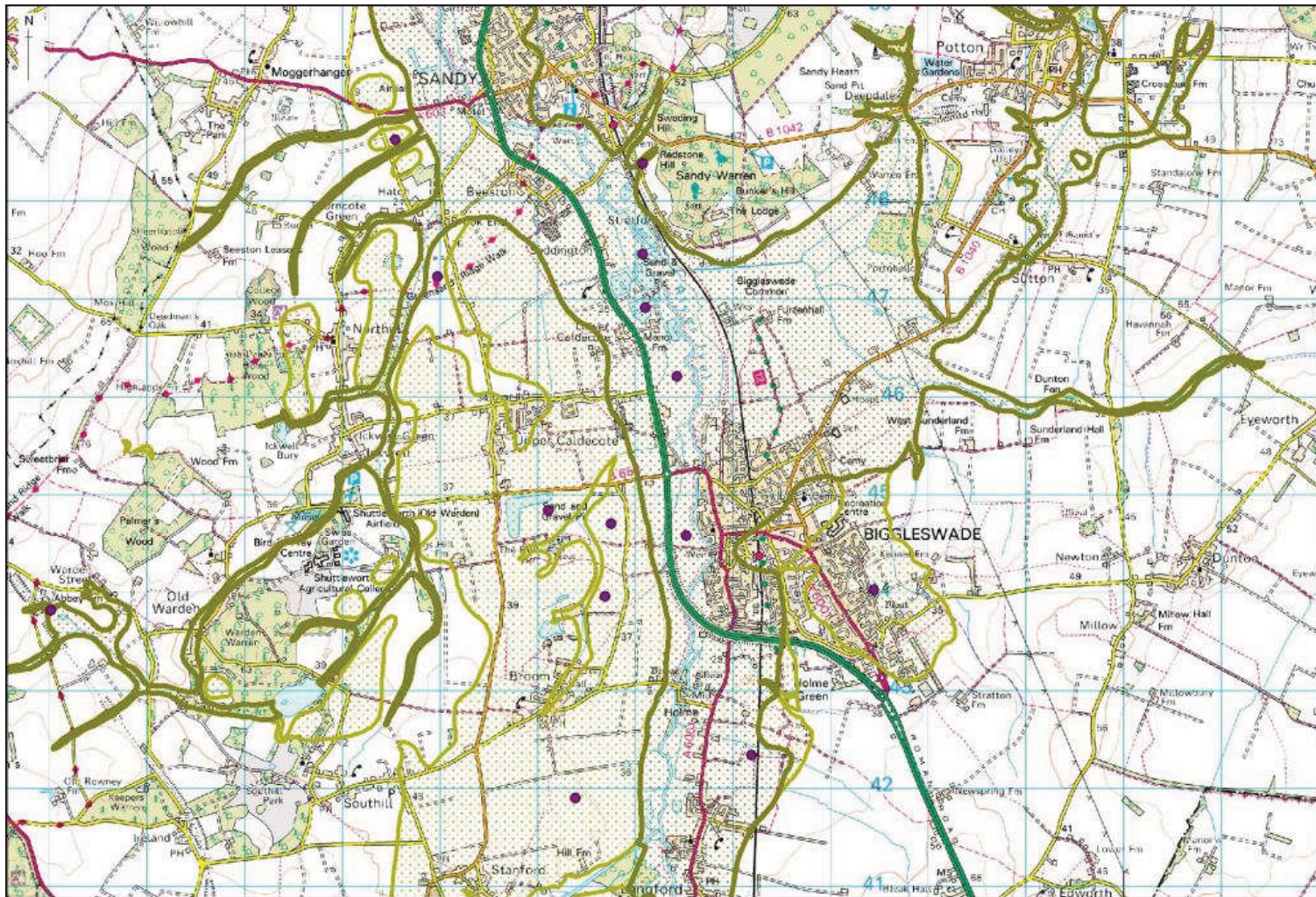
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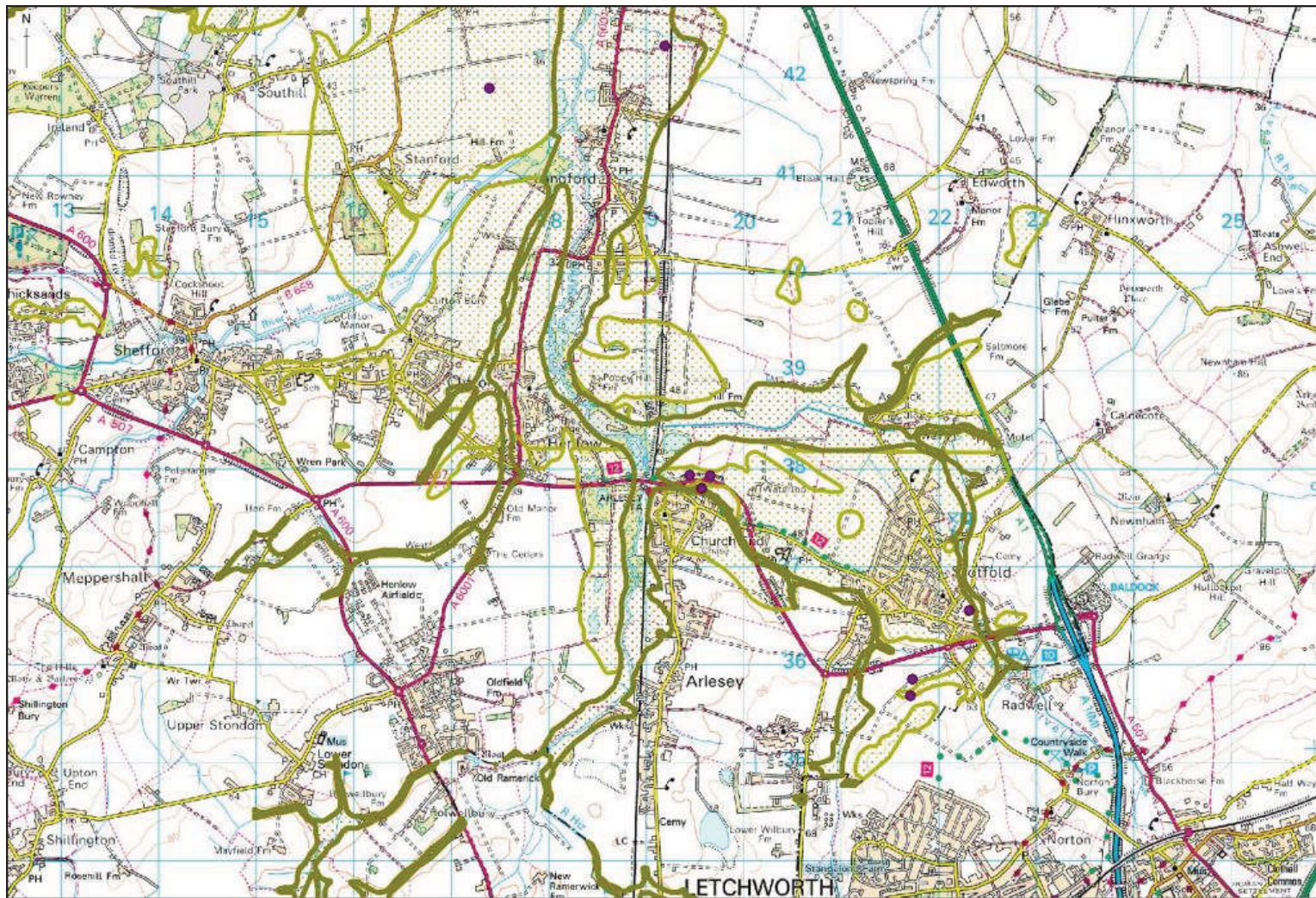
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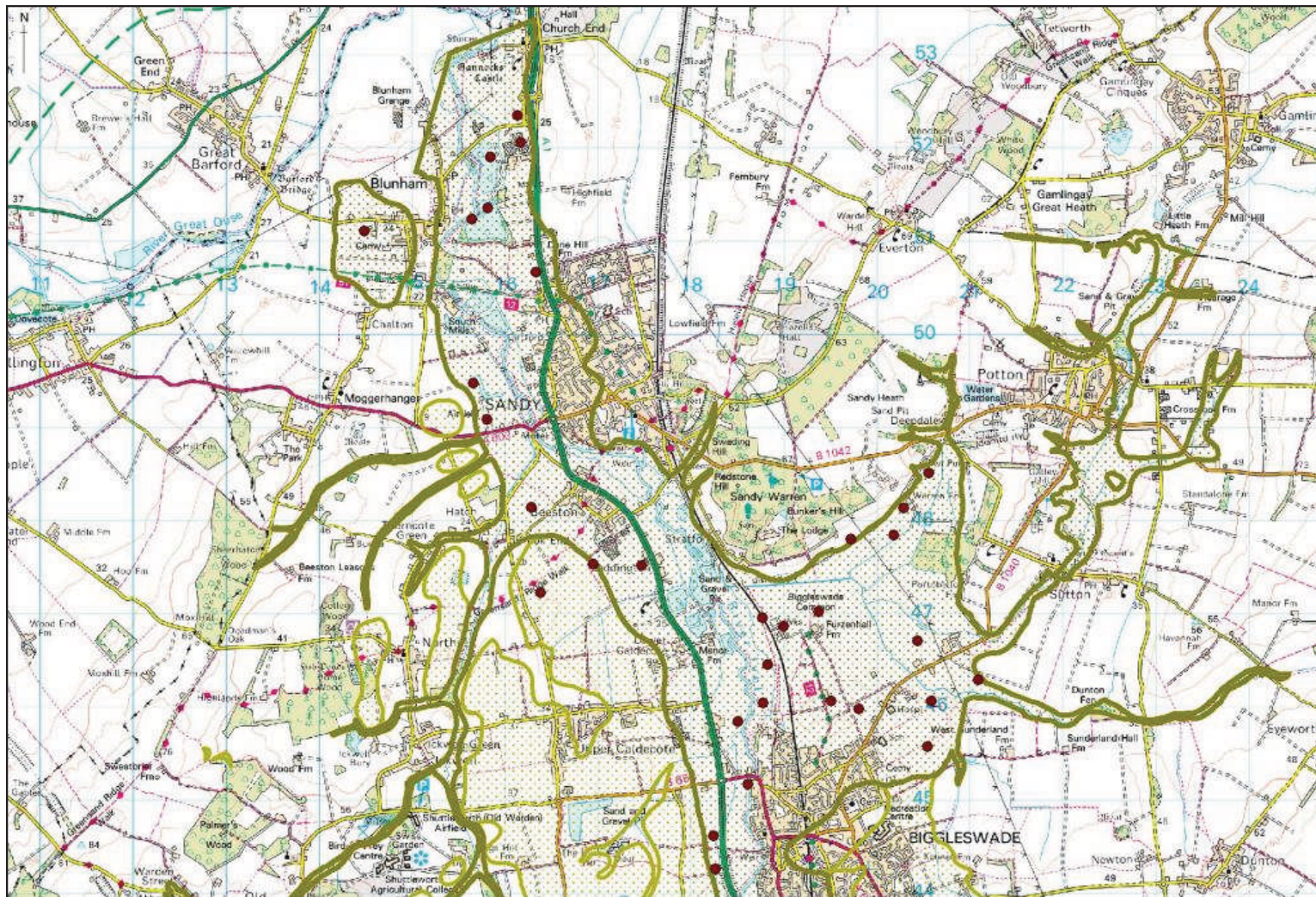
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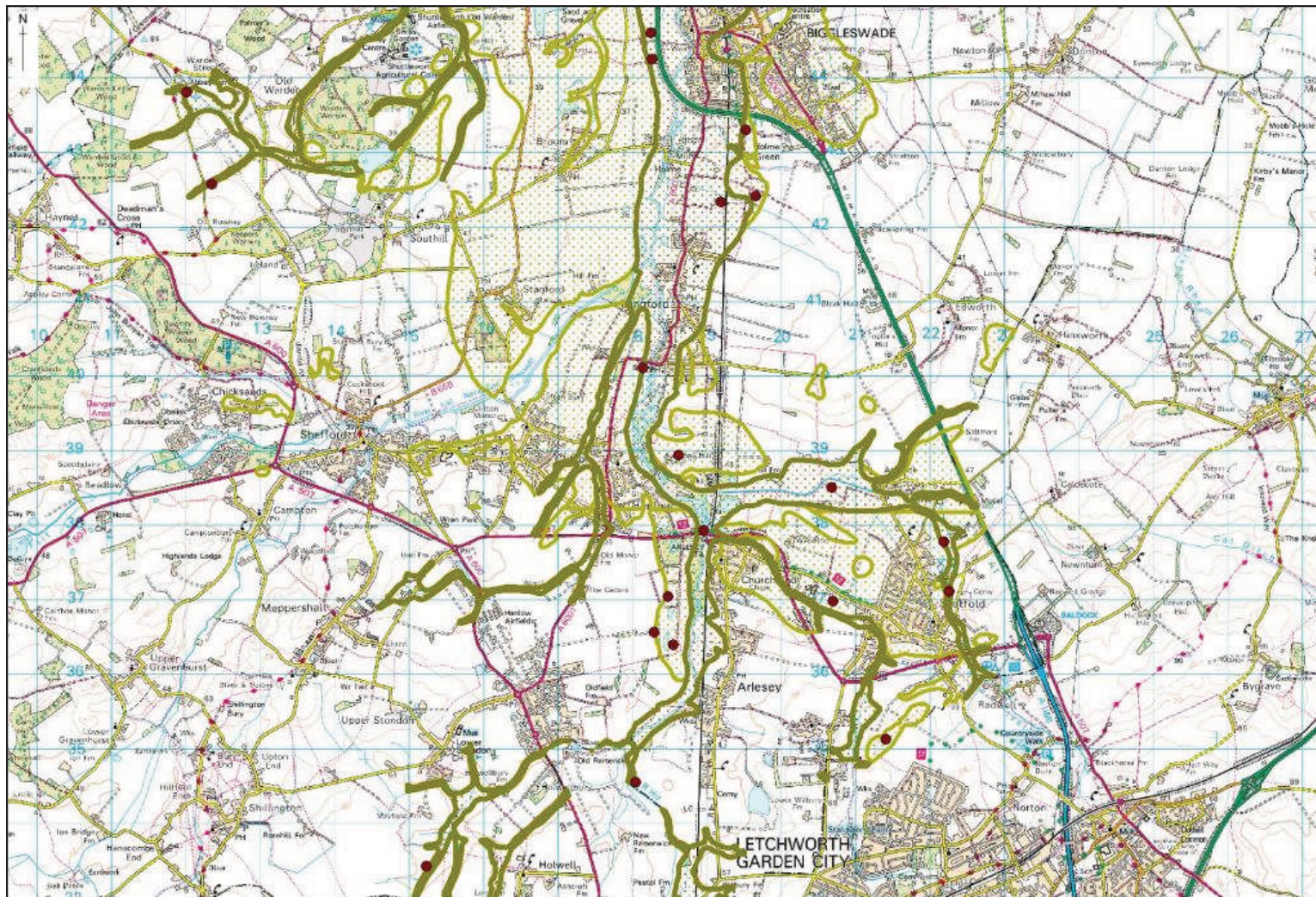
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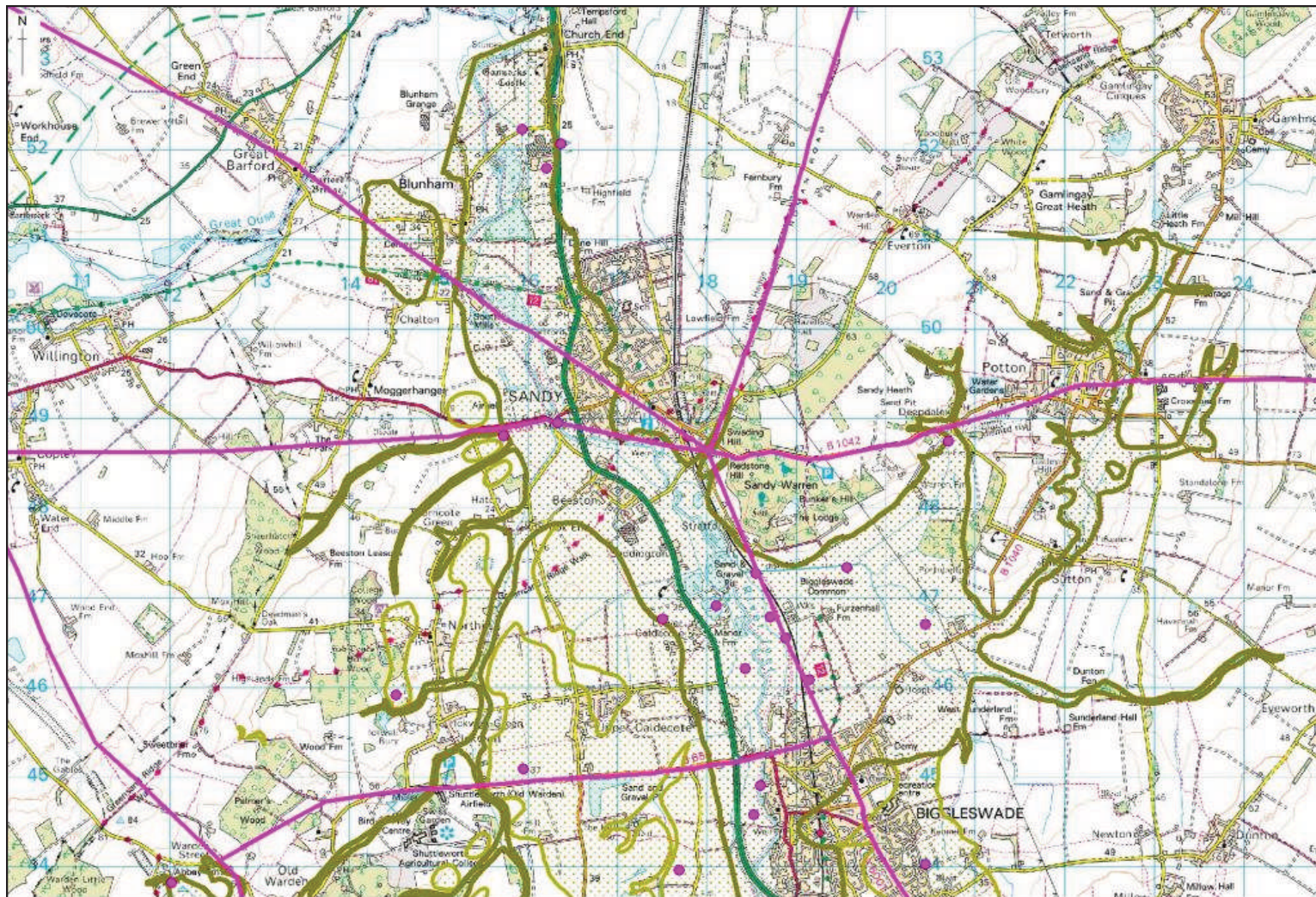
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Map 10. River Ivel AS-SA Late Prehistoric HER Assets – Northern Area



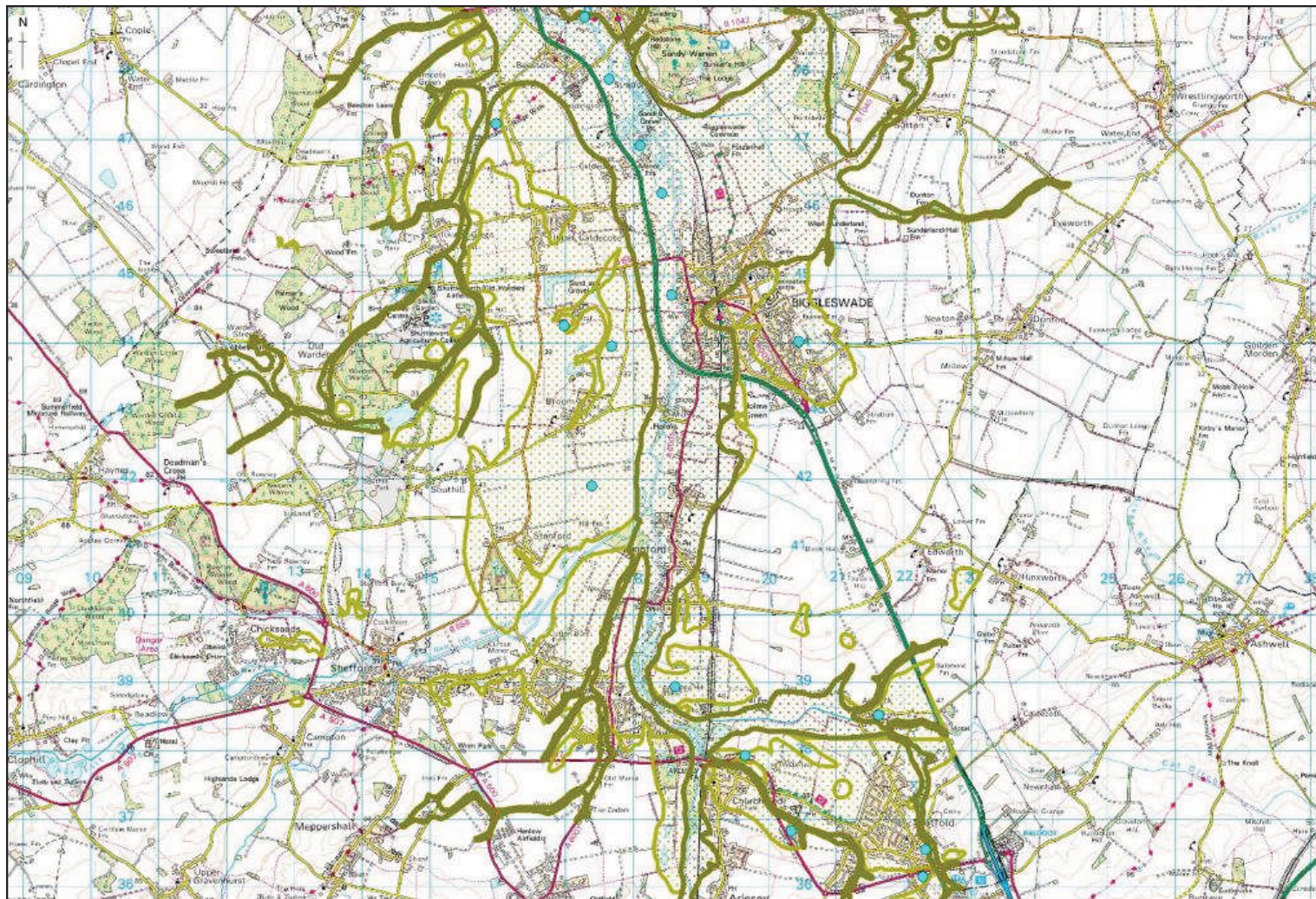
Map 11. River Ivel AS-SA Late Prehistoric HER Assets – Southern Area

Map 14. River Ivel AS-SA Saxon HER Assets



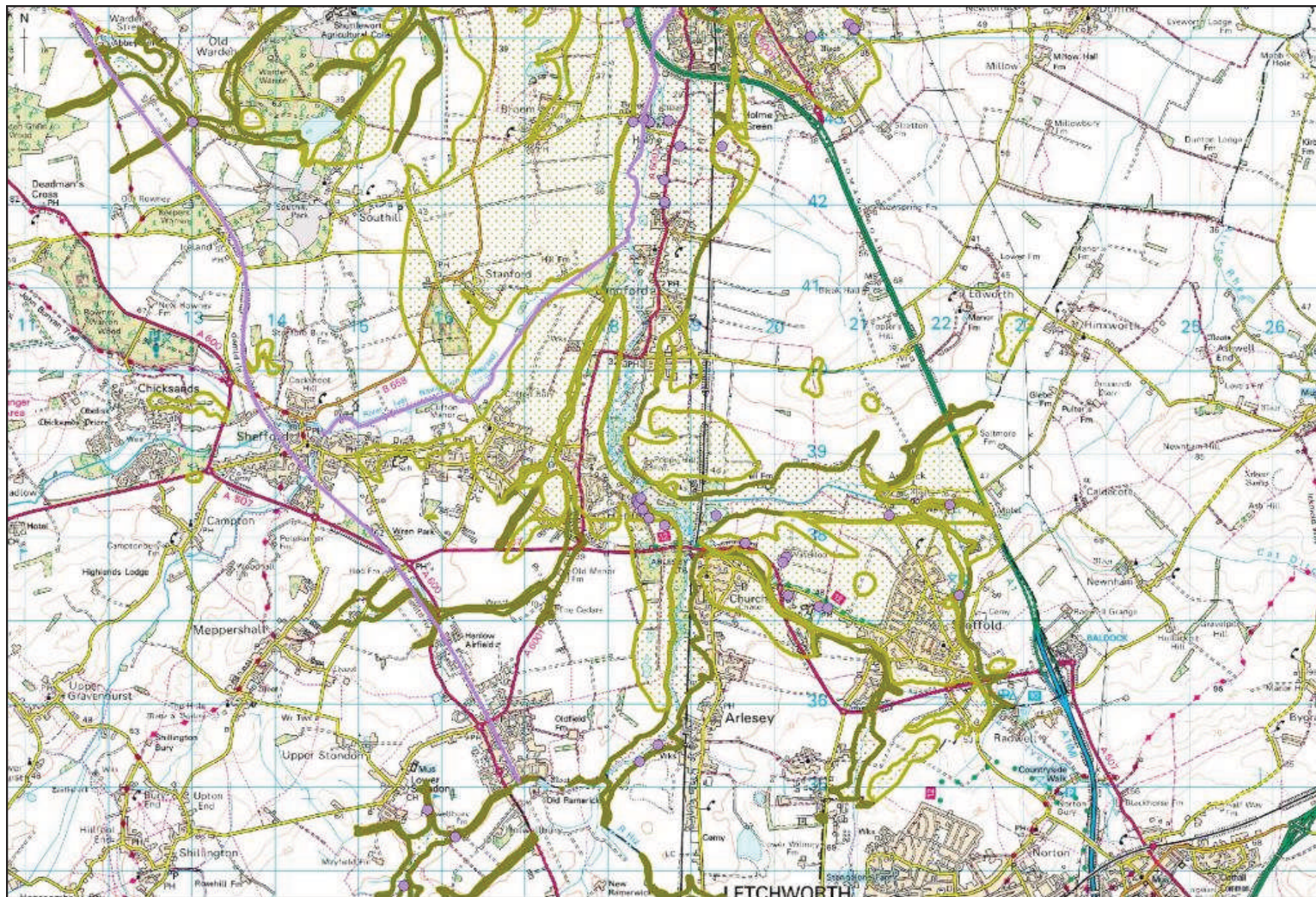
Map 15. River Ivel AS-SA Medieval Assets – Northern Area



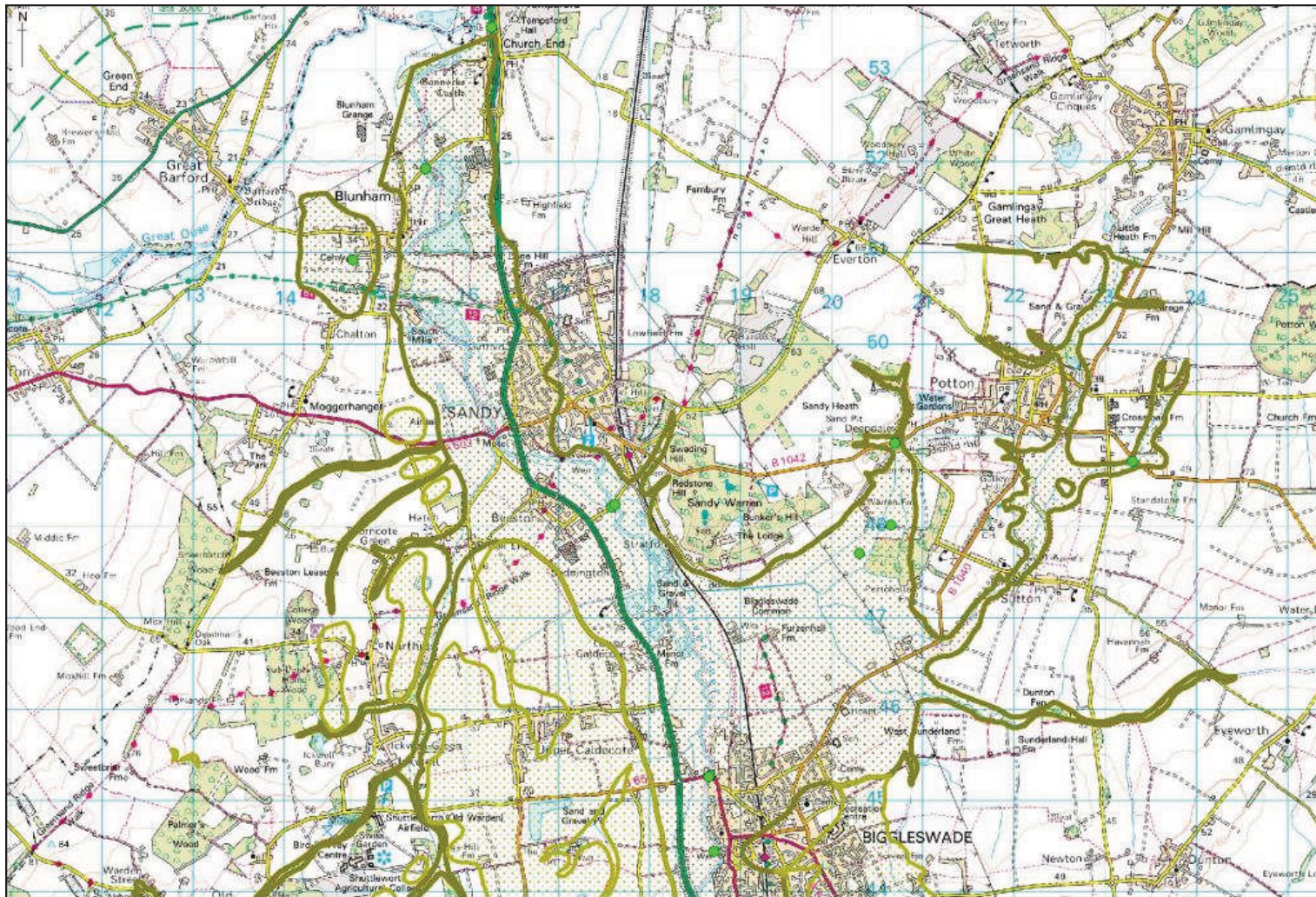
Map 16. River Ivel AS-SA Medieval Assets – Southern Area
