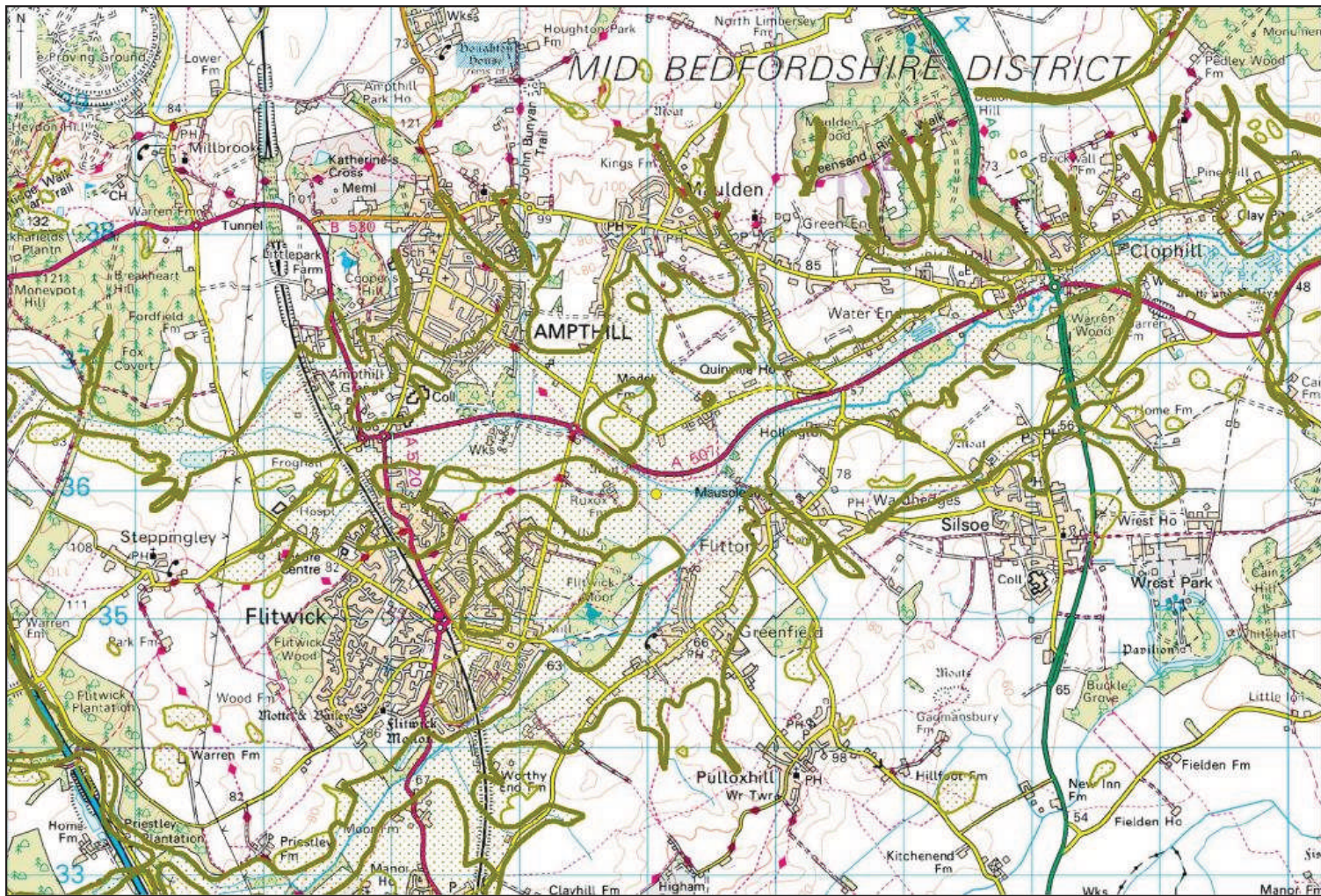

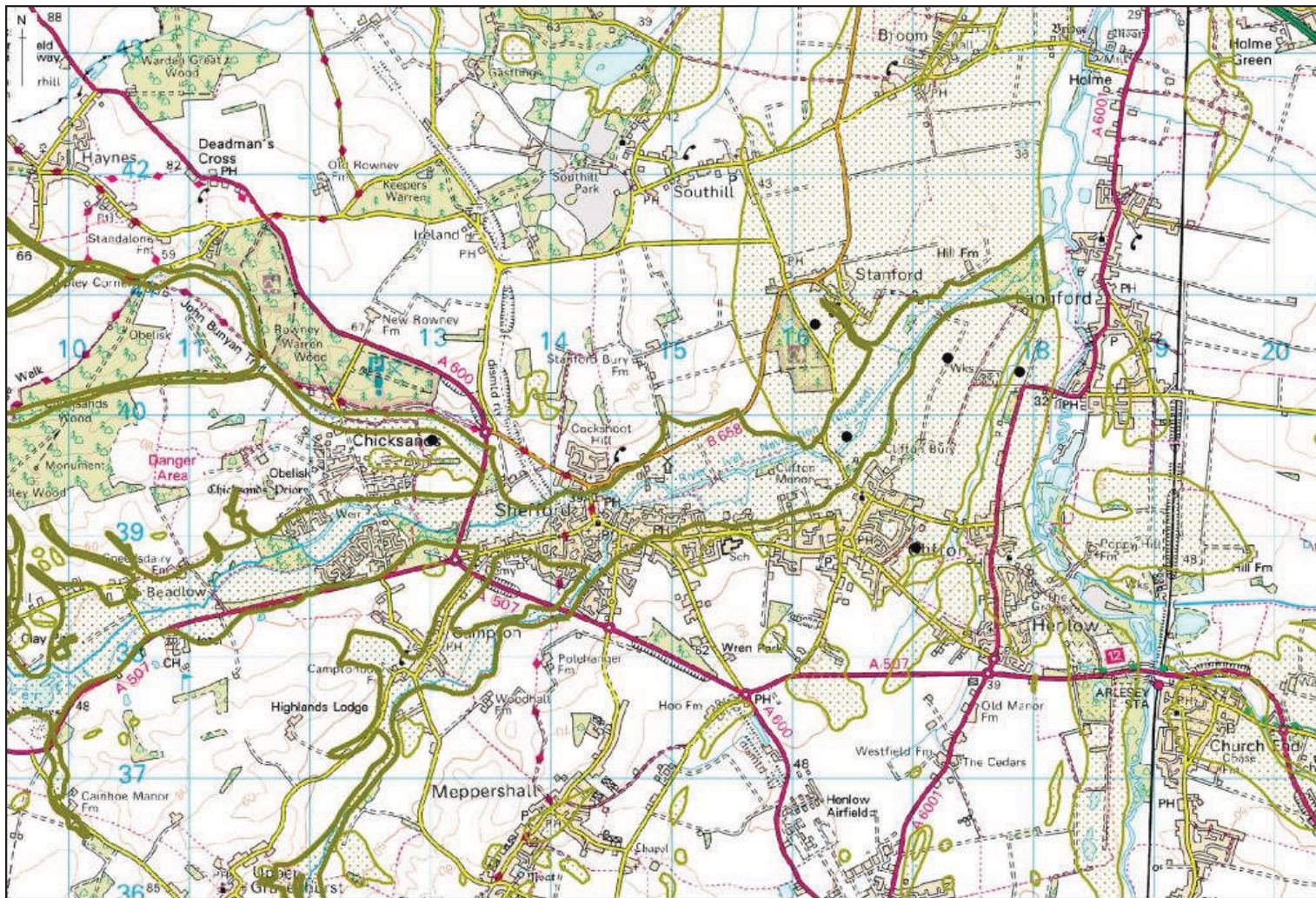
Map 1. River Flit AS-SA Palaeolithic HER Assets



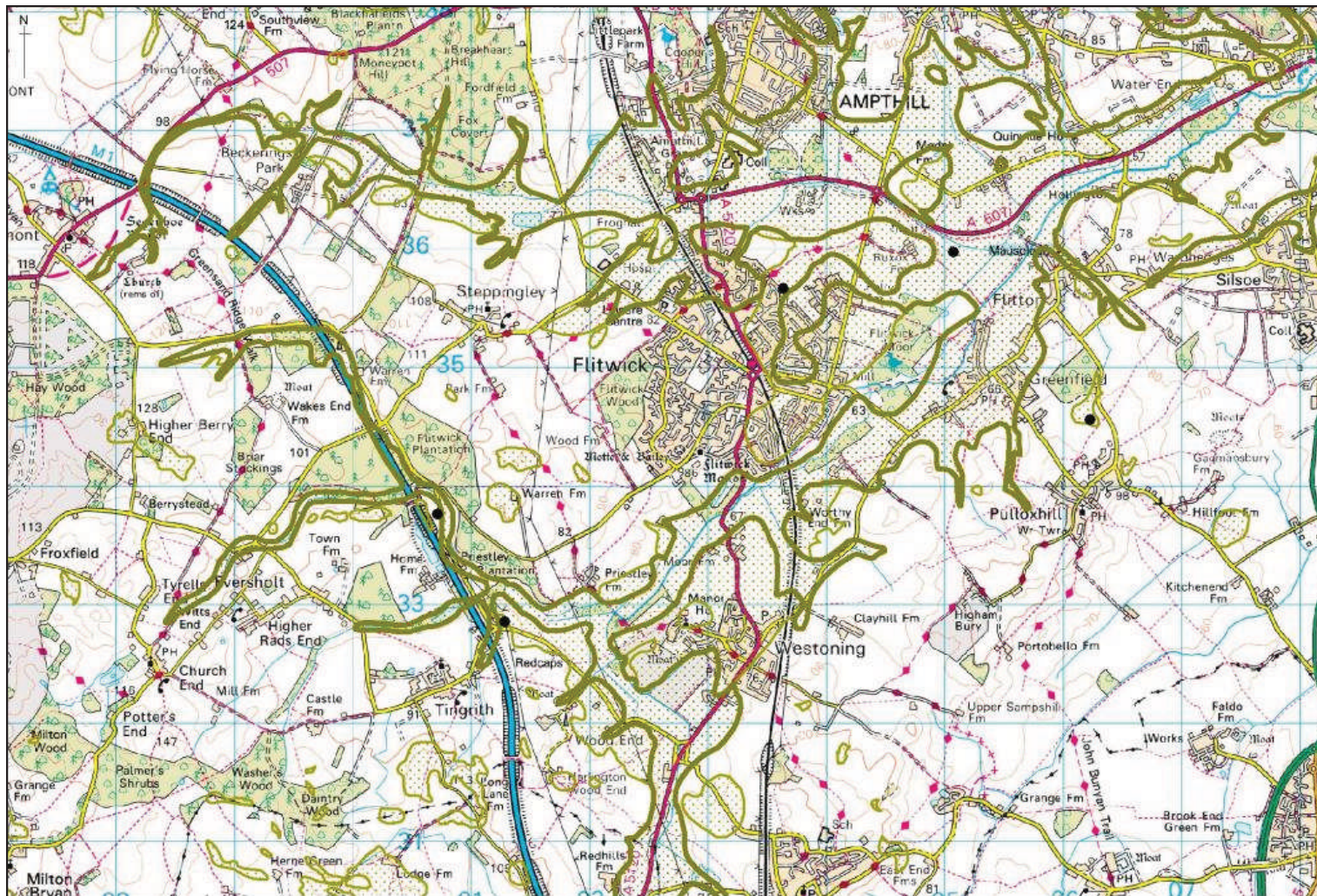
Map 2. River Flit AS-SA Mesolithic HER Assets

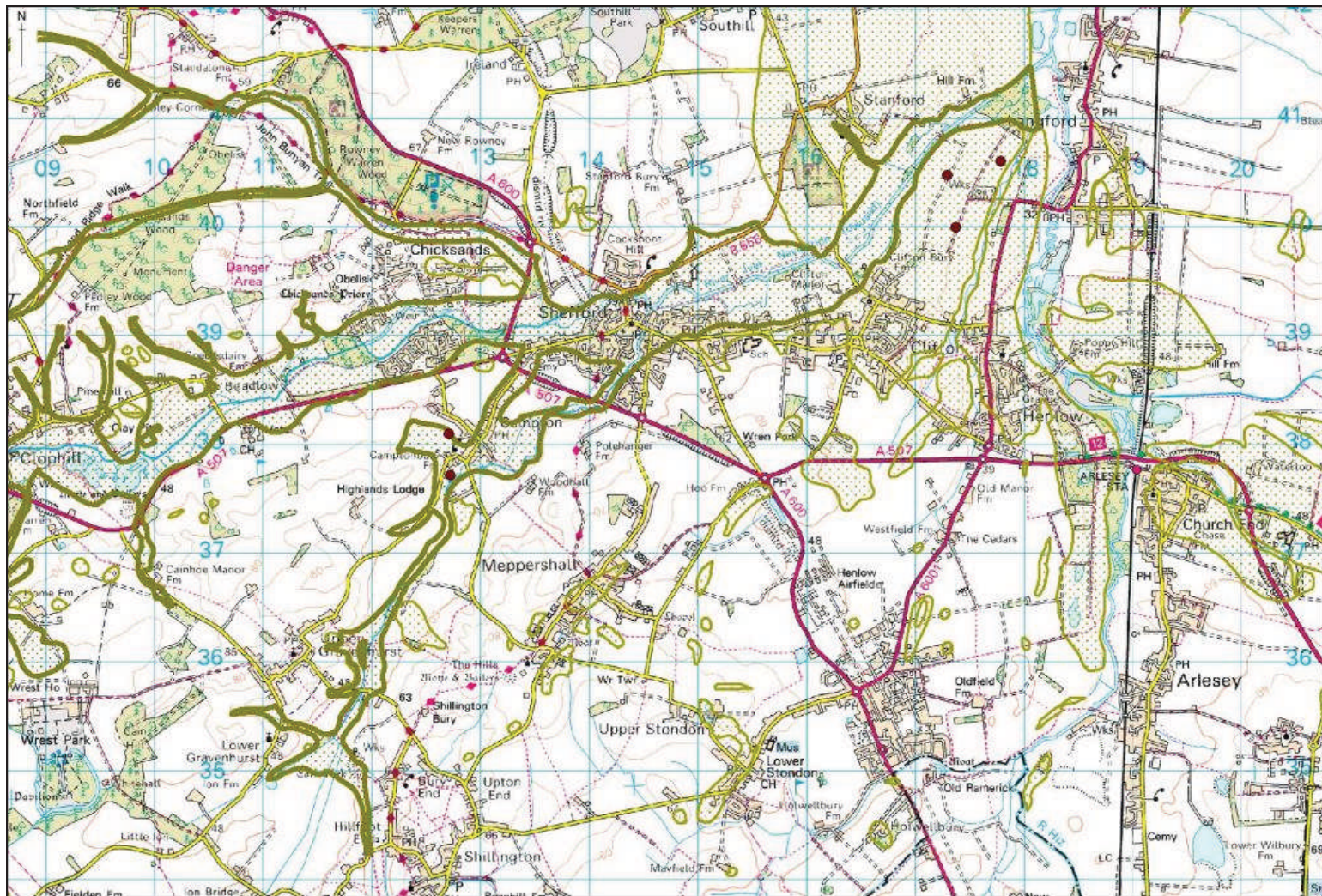

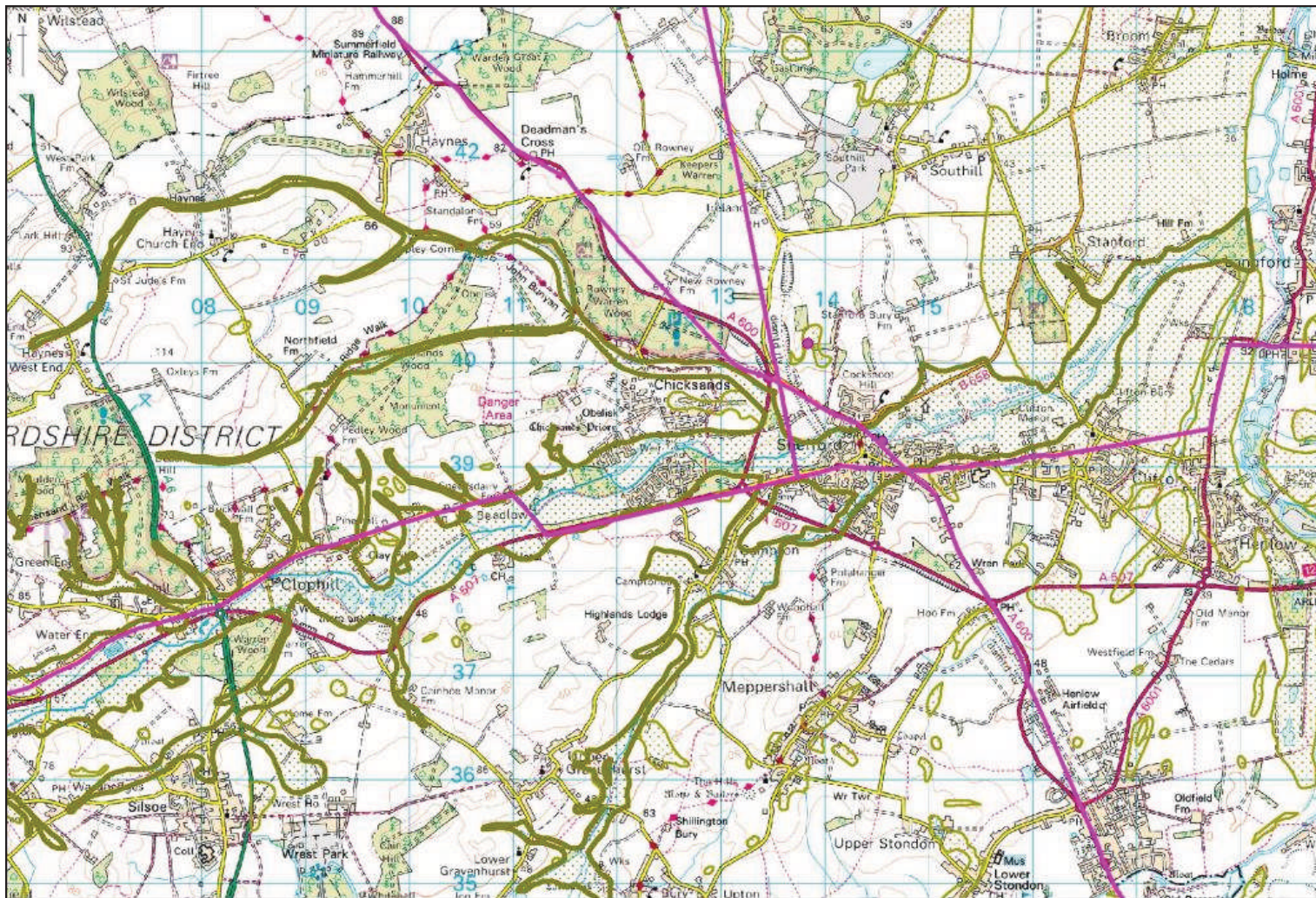
Map 10. River Flit AS-SA Late Prehistoric HER Assets Eastern Area

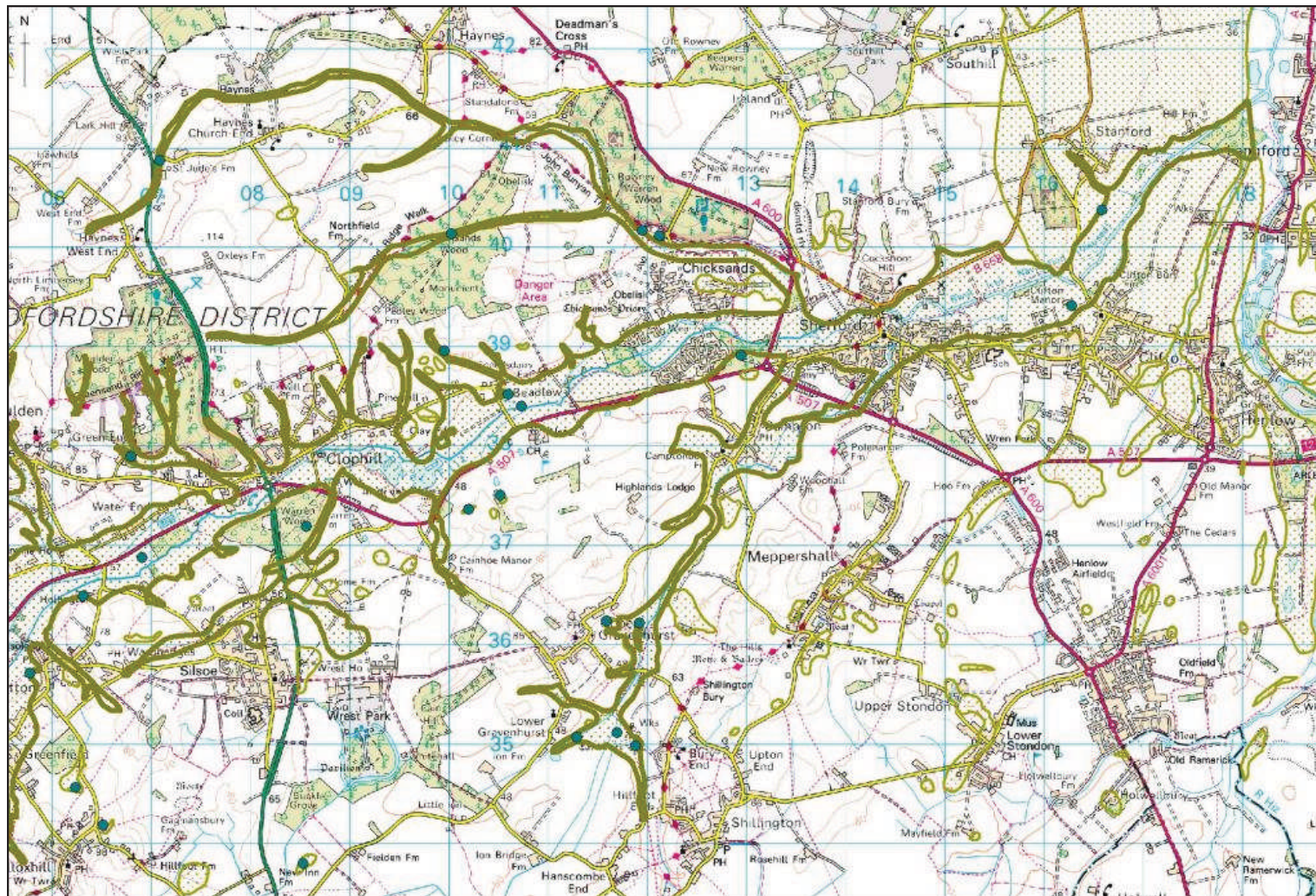
