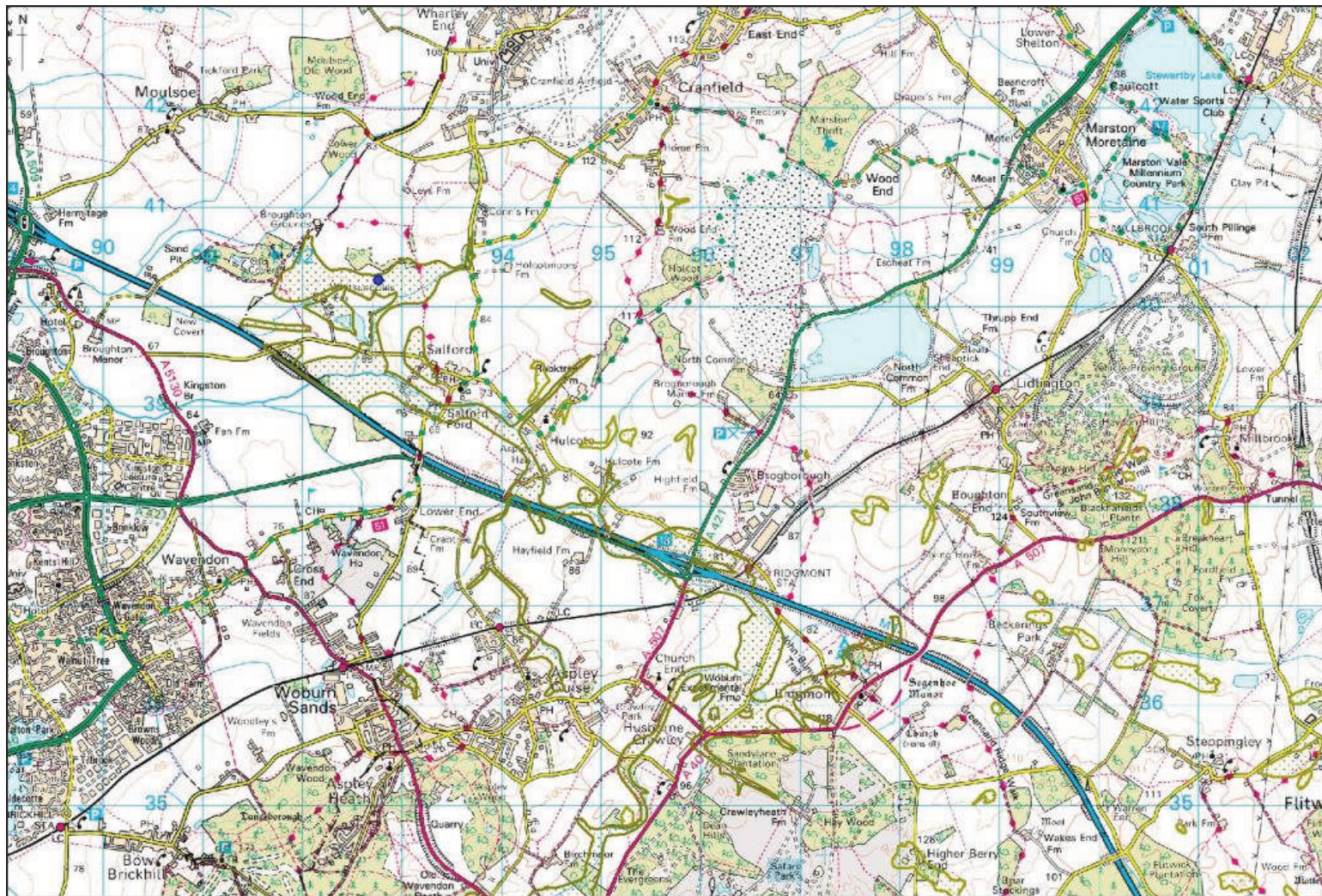

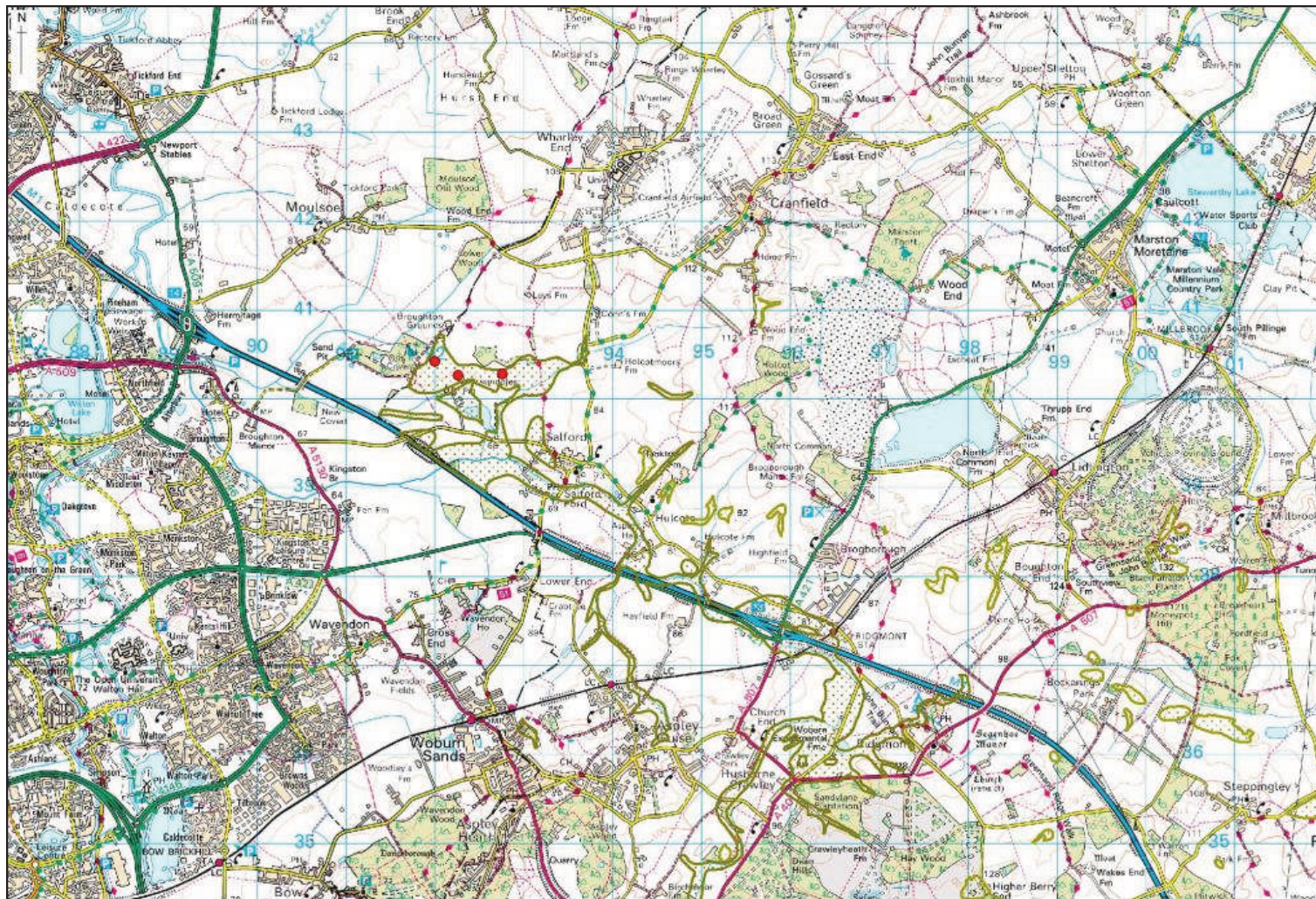

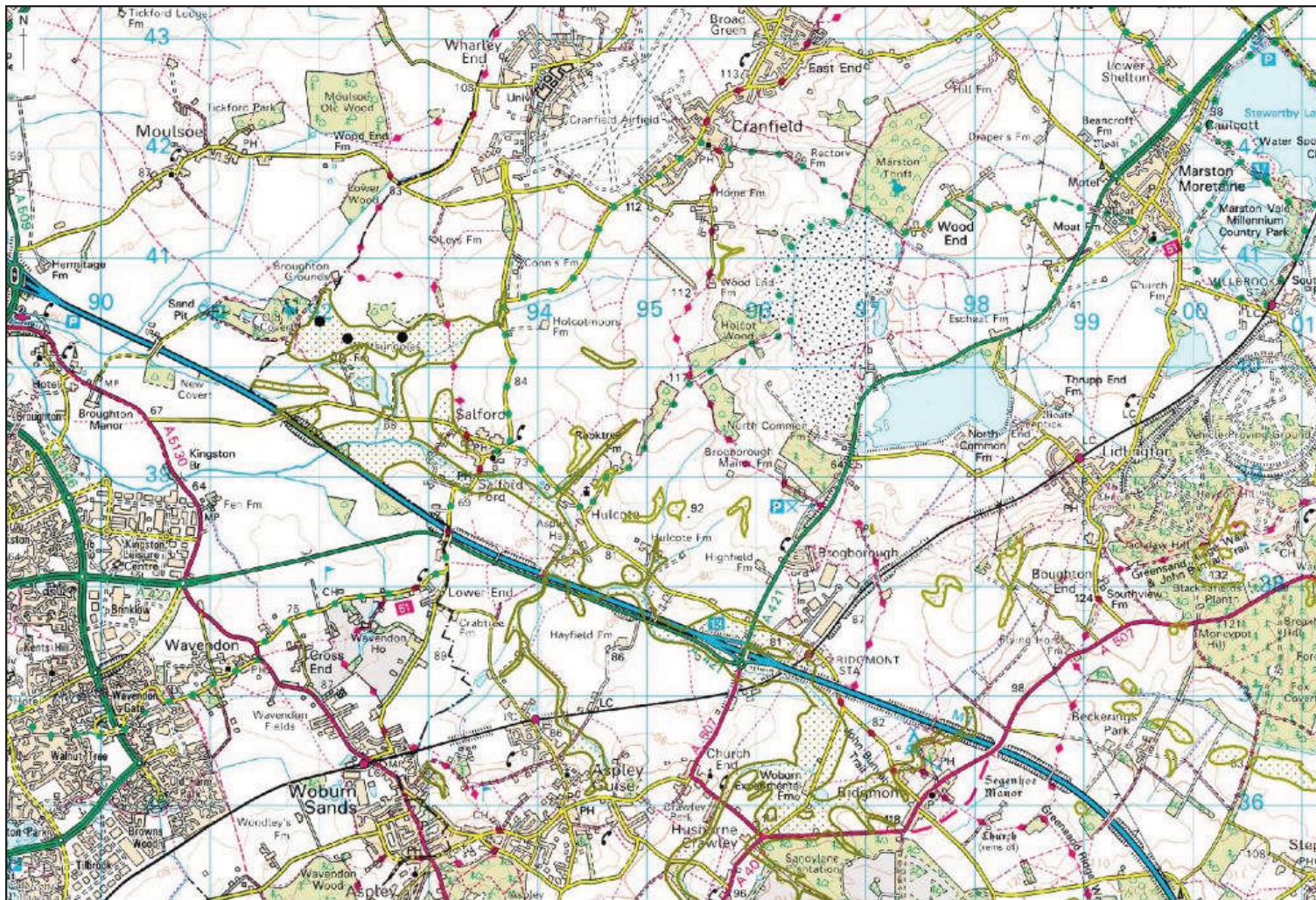
Map 1. River Ouzel AS-SA Palaeolithic HER Assets



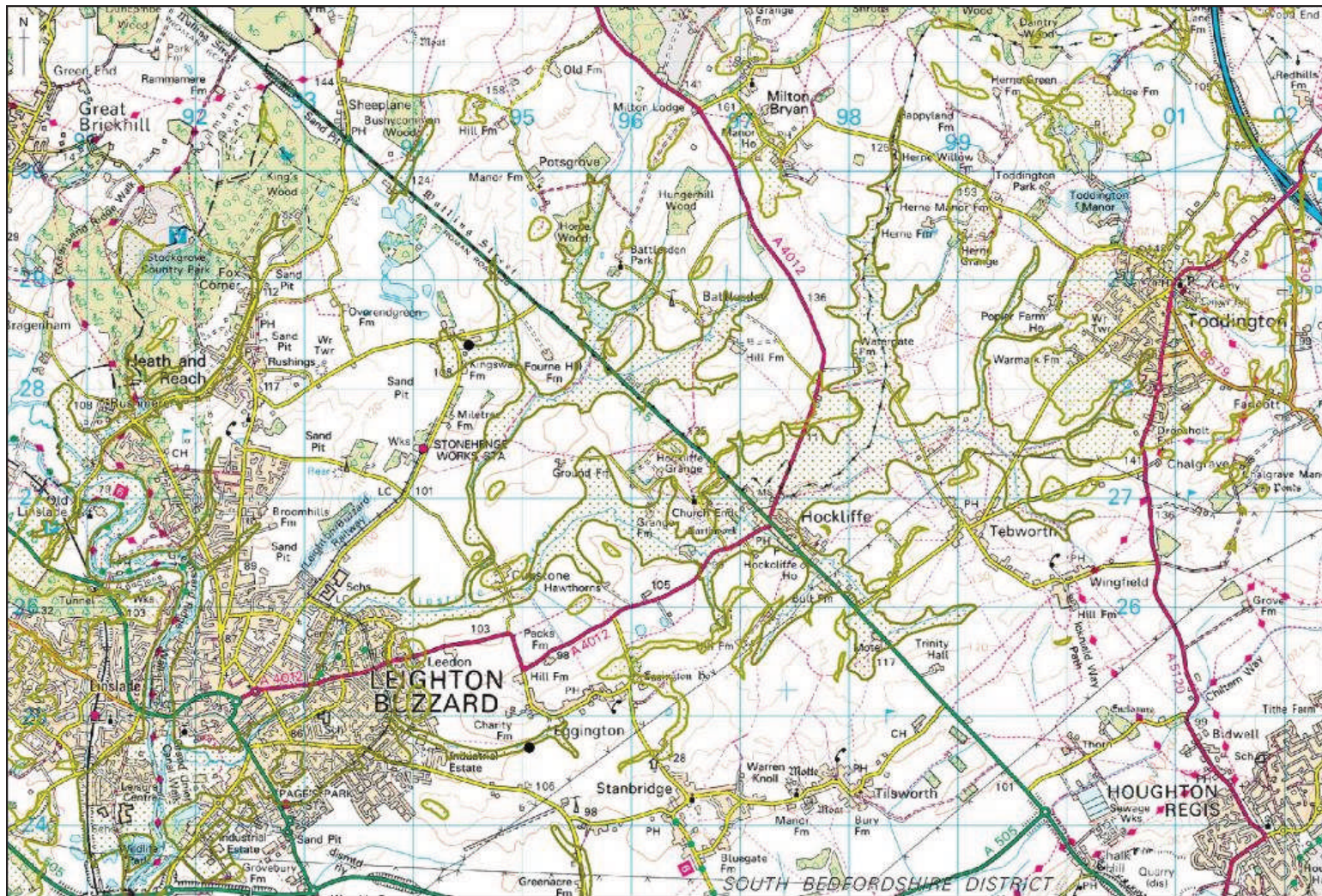
Map 2. River Ouzel AS-SA Mesolithic HER Assets



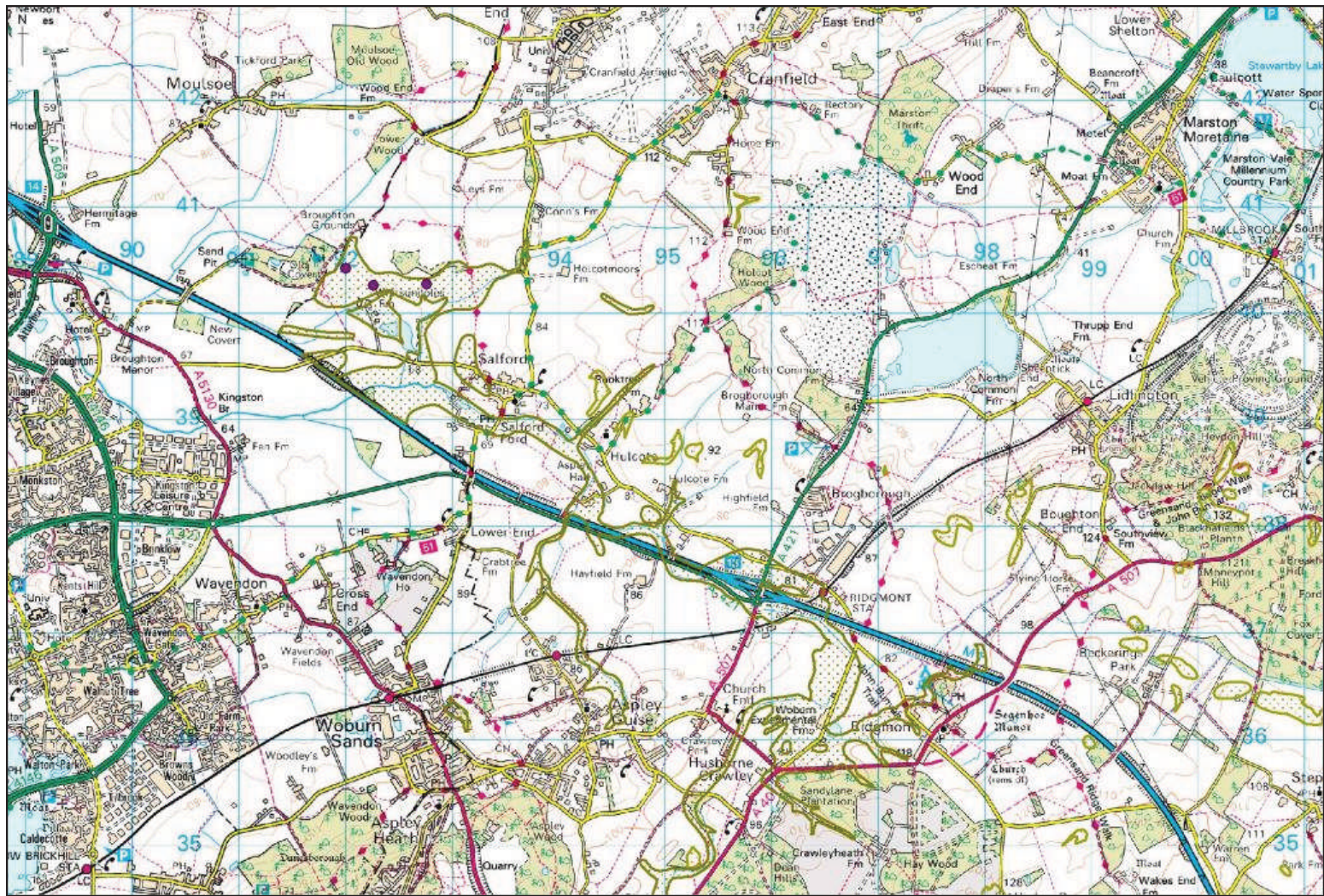
Map 3. River Ouzel AS-SA Neolithic HER Assets



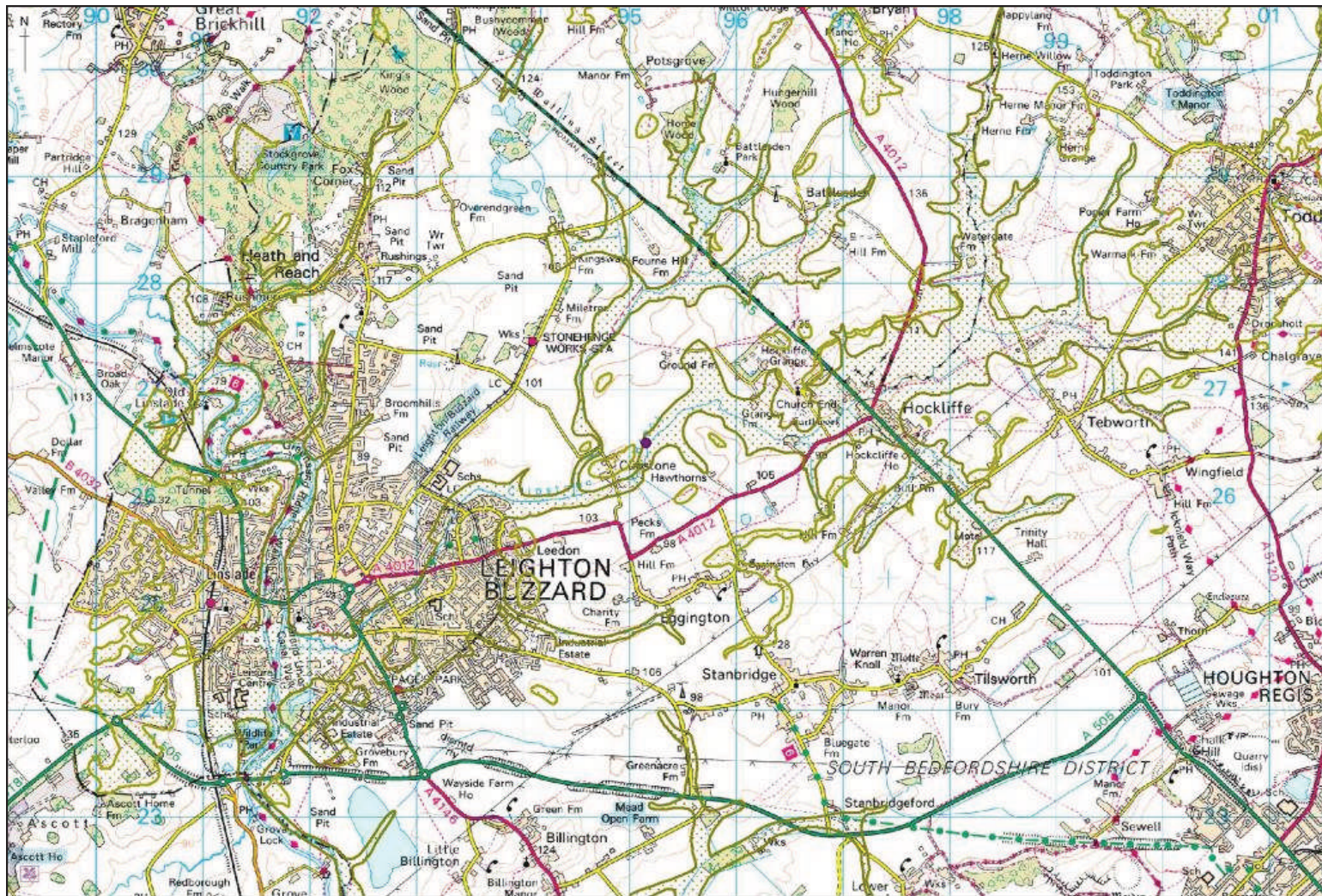
Map 4. River Ouzel AS-SA Bronze Age HER Assets – Northern Area



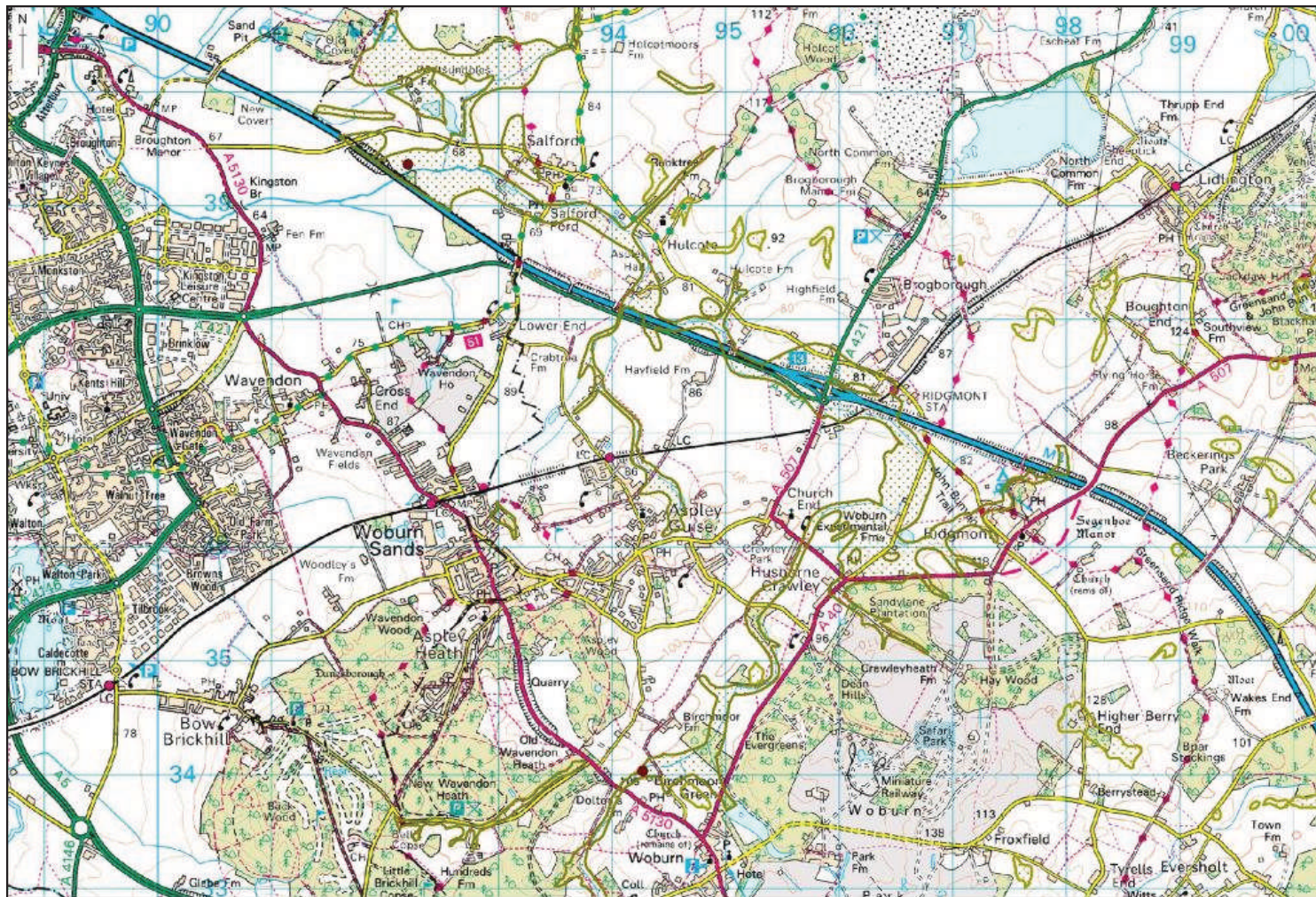
Map 5. River Ouzel AS-SA Bronze Age HER Assets – Southern Area



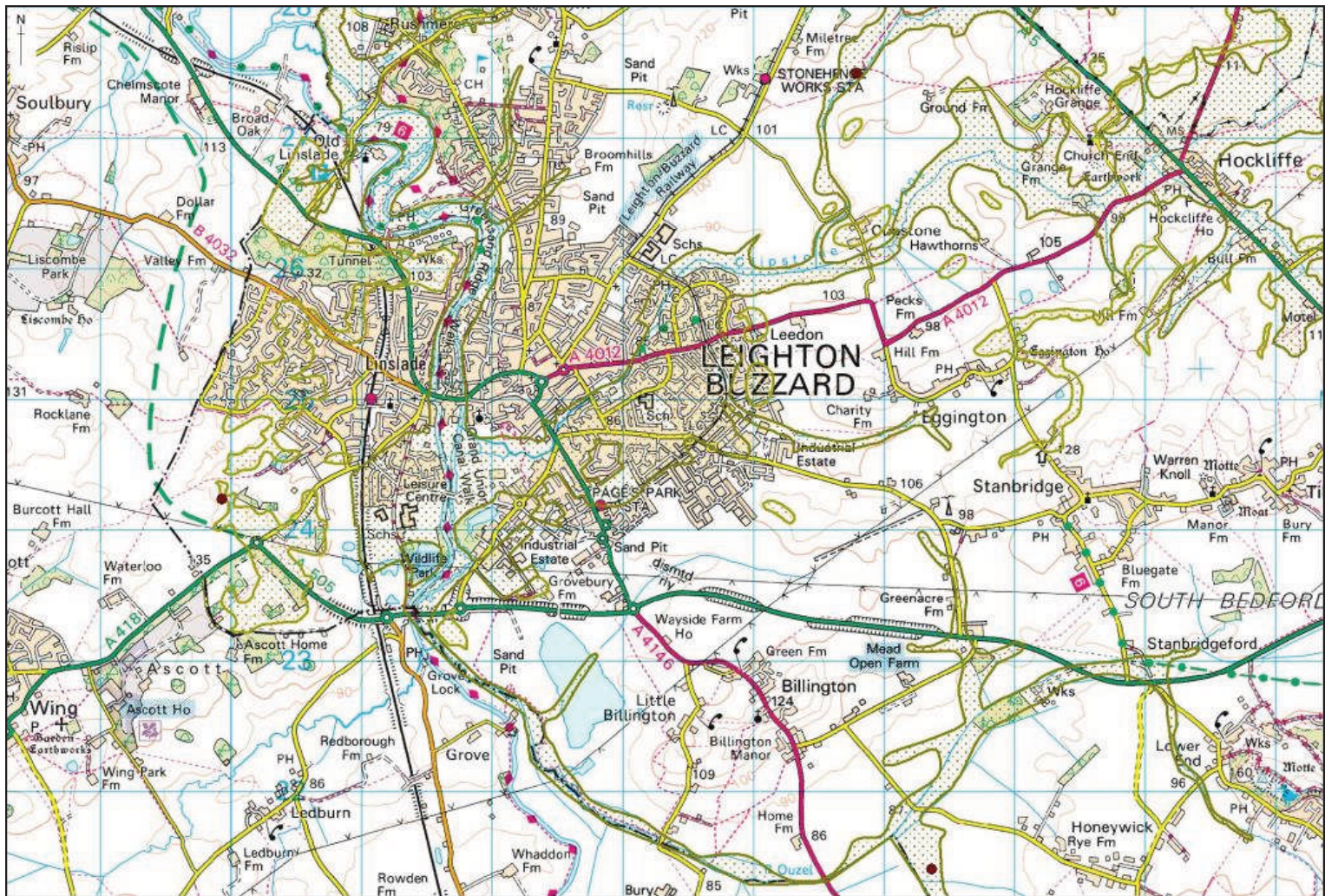
Map 6. River Ouzel AS-SA Iron Age HER Assets – Northern Area



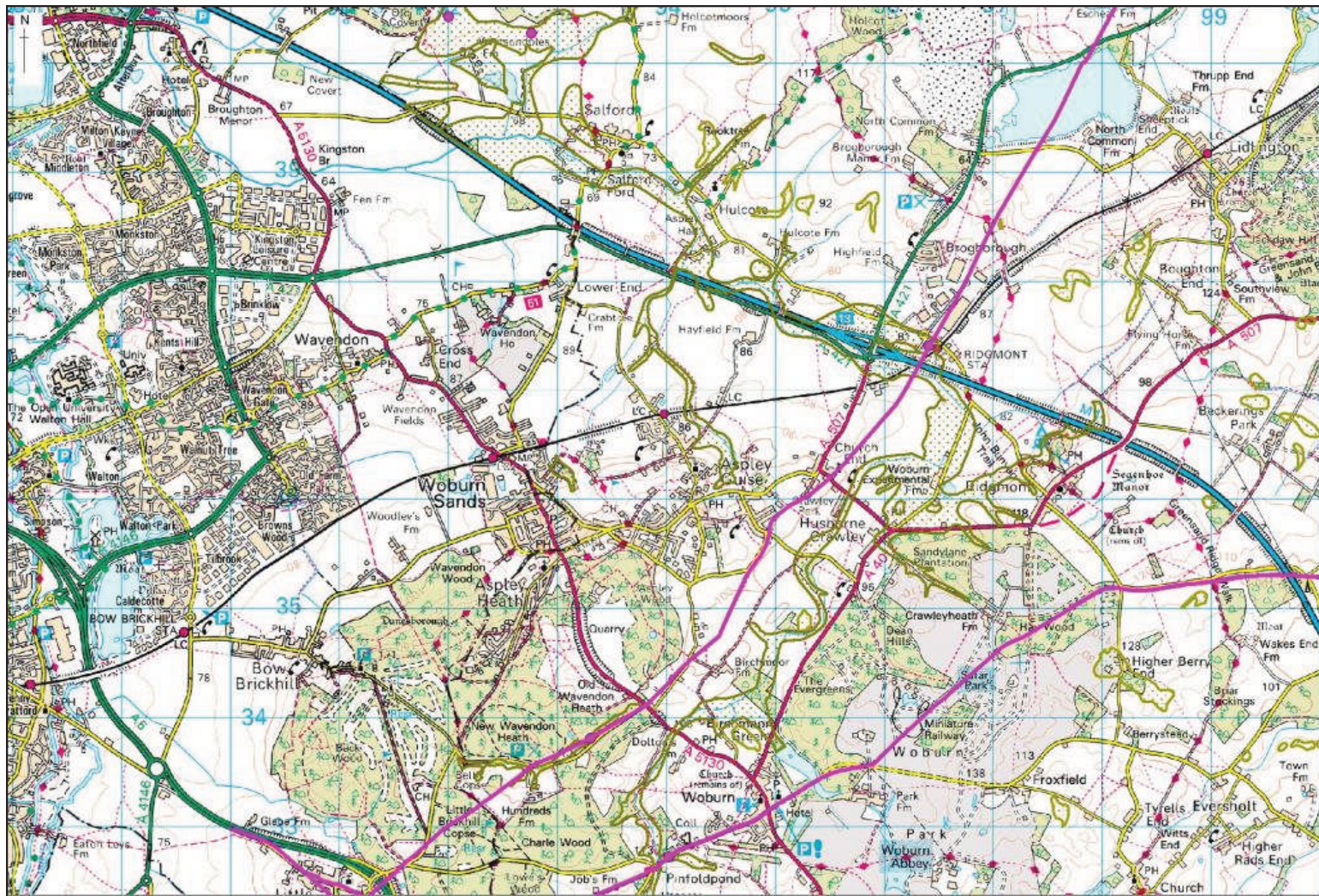
Map 7. River Ouzel AS-SA Iron Age HER Assets – Southern Area



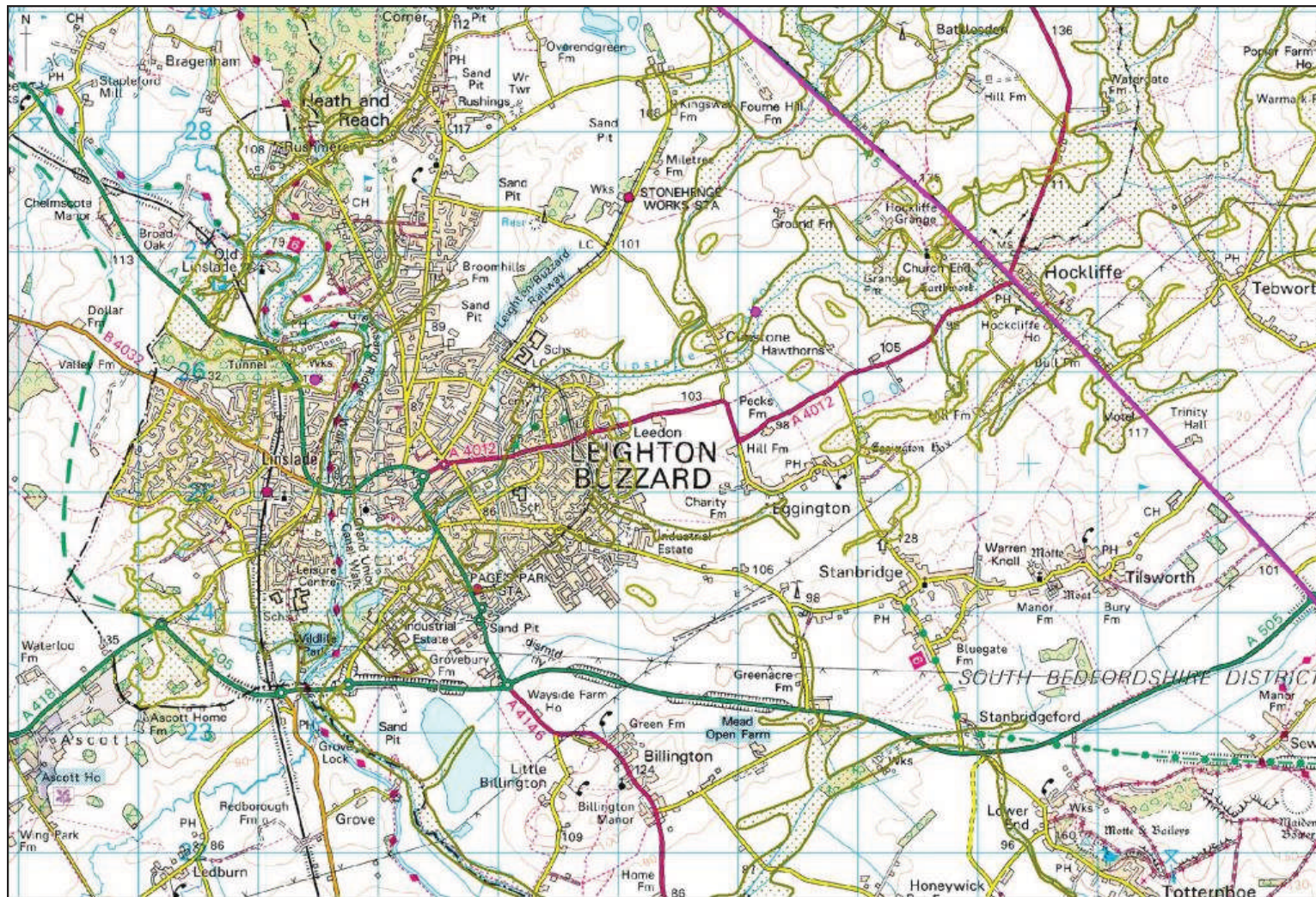
Map 8. River Ouzel AS-SA Late Prehistoric HER Assets – Northern Area



Map 9. River Ouzel AS-SA Late Prehistoric HER Assets – Southern Area



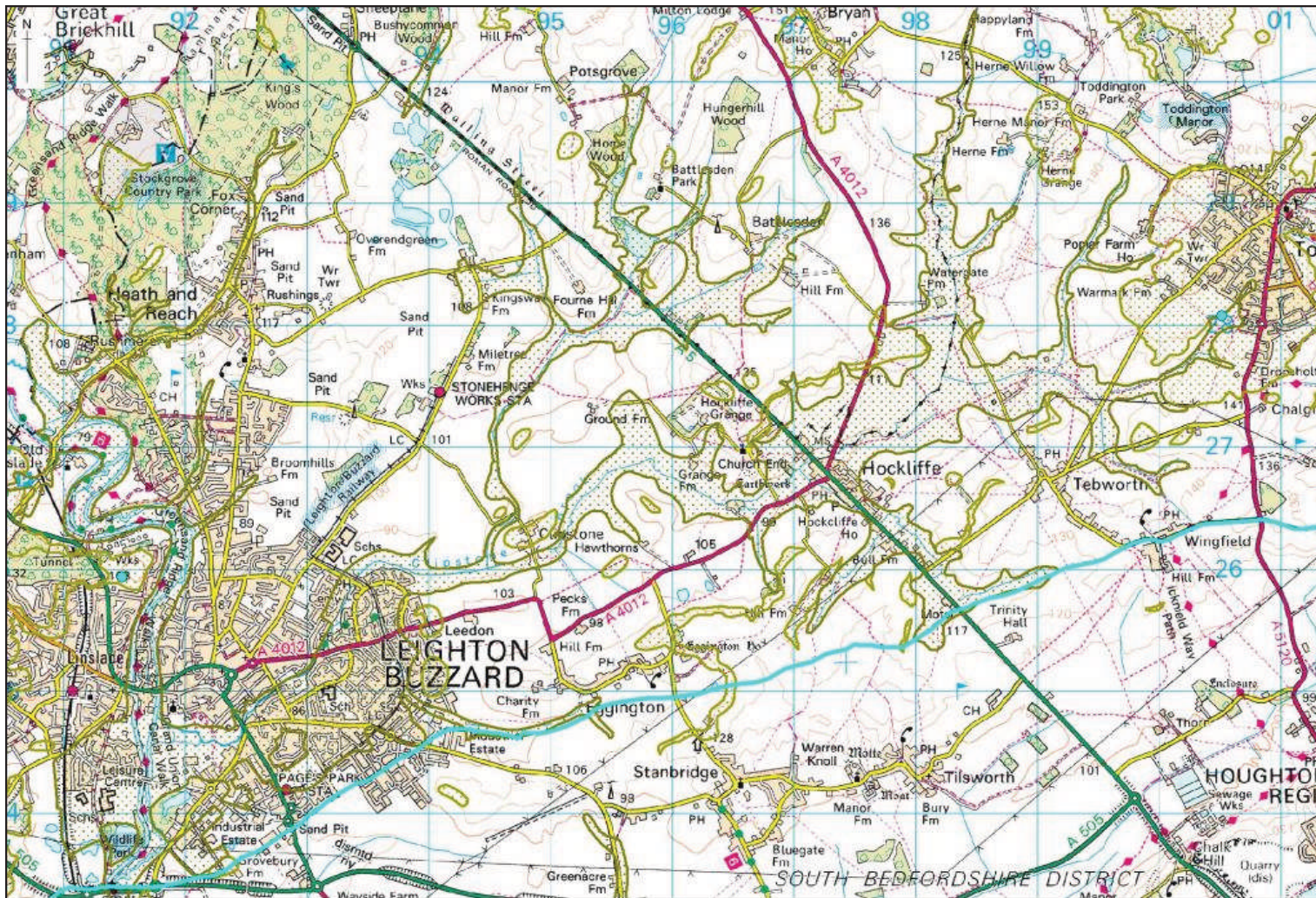
Map 10. River Ouzel AS-SA Roman HER Assets – Northern Area



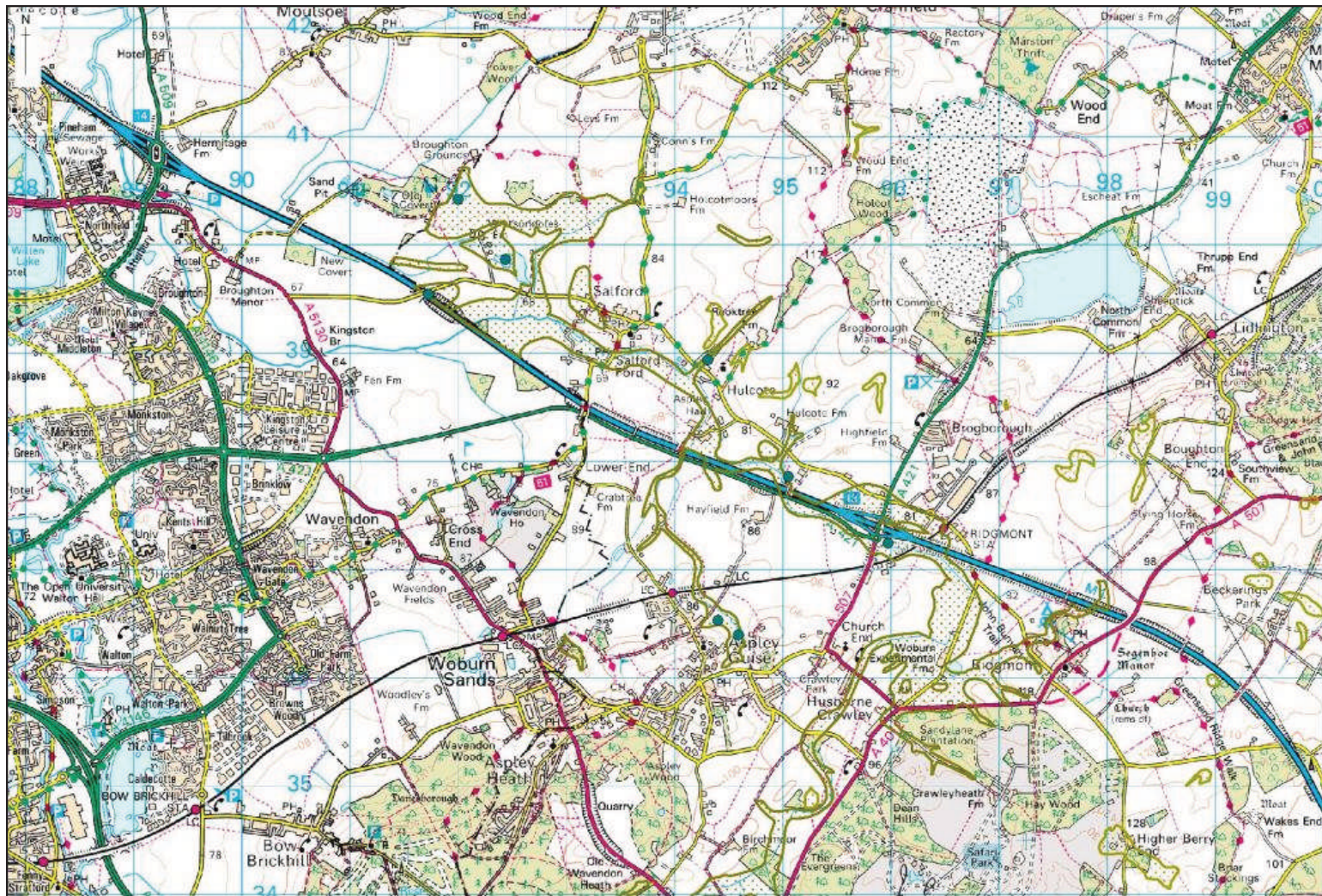
Map 11. River Ouzel AS-SA Roman HER Assets – Southern Area



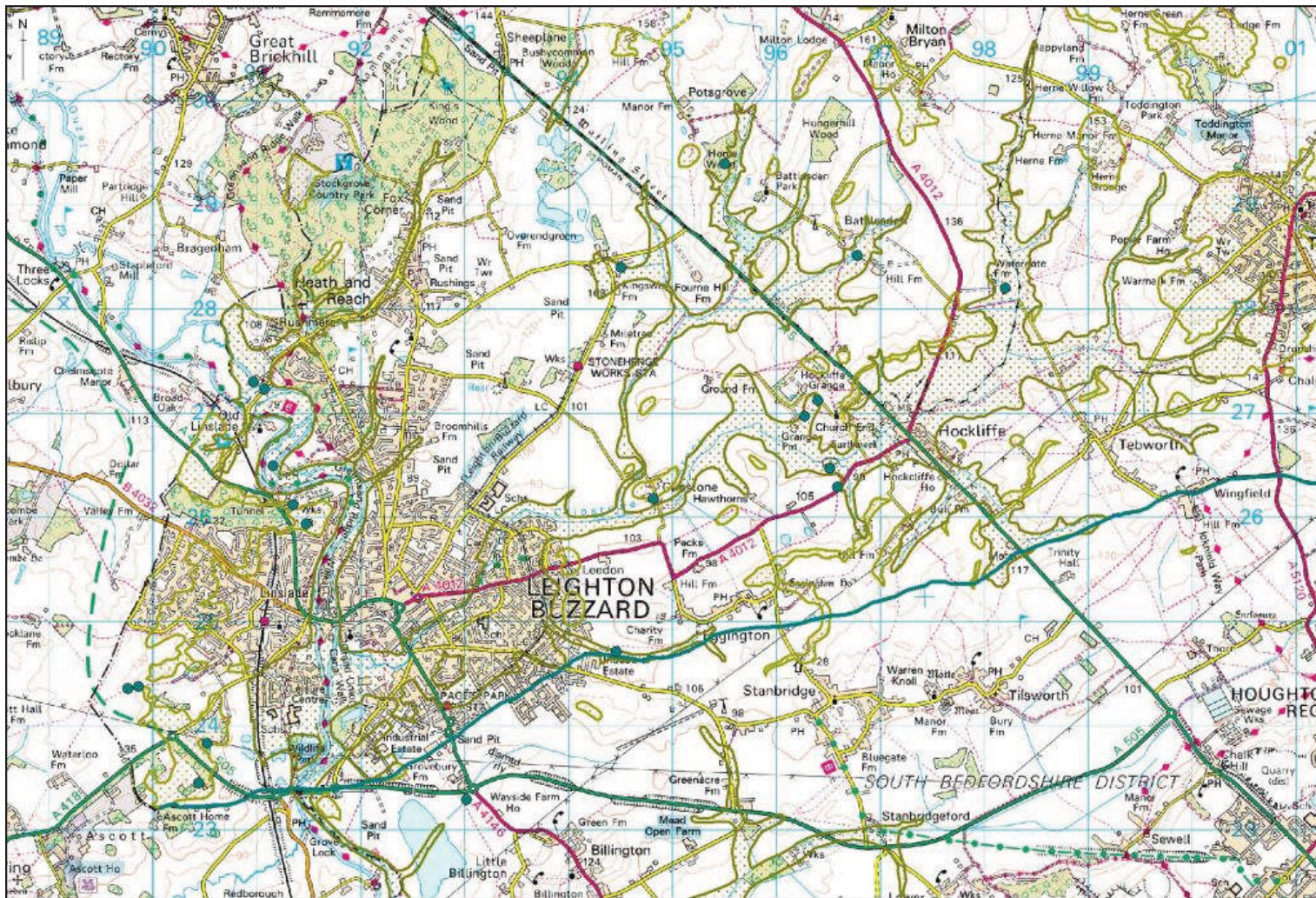
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Map 15. River Ouzel AS-SA Medieval HER Assets – Southern Area
