AREA G - LIA/Roman pottery Summary by Joyce Compton

Introduction: 261 contexts producing pottery were recorded, excluding cleaning and machining layers. A total weight of 245187g was recovered dating from the Late Iron Age to the late 4th century. The area is the most north-easterly of those excavated in Area AI. Most of the later deposits appear to have been removed during machining and excavation seems to have been piecemeal resulting in a lack of datable sequences.

The low number of selected contexts reflects the poor quality of the pottery recovered and the lack of cohesive well-dated groups.
