


Figure 3 A1, Phase 3 – 4 features




Figure 4 A1, Phases 102 – 104 features




Figure 5 A1, Phase 5 features




Figure 6 A1, Phase 6 – 7 features




Figure 7 A1, Phase 8 features




Figure 9 A1, Phase 11 features




Figure 10 A1, Phase 14 features




Figure 11 A1, Phase 15 – 16 features




Figure 13 A1, Phase 18 – 19 features




Figure 16 A1, Phase 22 features




Figure 17 A1, Phase 23 – 24 features




Figure 18 A1, Phases 105 – 111 features




Figure 19 A1, detail of enclosure related features




Figure 20 A1, detail of enclosure ring-gullies




Figure 21 A1, detail of ring-gullies, groups 3 and 17




Figure 22 A1, detail of ring-gullies, groups 4, 5, 8 and 9




Figure 25 A2, features pre-dating the Iron Age enclosure complex




Figure 26 A2, detail of the southern end of the curvilinear ditches




Figure 27 A2, Iron Age enclosure complex




Figure 28 A2, detail of Iron Age enclosure complex




Figure 29 A2, detail of Iron Age roundhouses




Figure 30 A2, detail of Iron Age ring-gullies




Figure 31 A2, lattice-like field system and Roman features




Figure 32 A2, detail of Roman features at the southern end of the area




Figure 33 A2, undated, medieval, post-medieval and modern features




Figure 34 Trenches L1-2 features




Figure 35 Evaluation trenches 12-17 Roman and undated features




Figure 36 Evaluation trenches 12-17 medieval and modern features
