

Given this, the following course of action was taken:-

- A base scale of 1:25,000 was used.
- The characterisation was mapped on drawing film overlays of OS Pathfinder maps at A1 size - an equivalent area to a single 1:50,000 scale sheets at A3 size.
- As the digitised polygons, lines and symbols could be reproduced at any scale or in any combination of colours from the GIS, it was not felt that shading different types was either helpful or necessary

Since the information was digitised from originals at a scale of 1:25,000, this is the largest scale at which a degree of accuracy can be guaranteed.

#### **D.iv Sub-divisions of the assessment area**

For practical purposes, it is always necessary to subdivide any large survey area into manageable blocks.

The option of sub-dividing the characterisation area into parishes was considered, although this was rejected for the following reasons:-

- Few of the data sources are parish specific (see Appendix 2), although it was found that an informal consideration of parish boundaries was necessary when using those which were (e.g. Victoria County History information).
- As many of the parish boundaries lay across the edges of more than one OS map sheet, it was felt that rigorously undertaking the survey by parish would involve a lot of time-consuming double handing of map sheets.

It was found to be most efficient to divide the characterisation area into sectors based on the OS map sheets. This effectively consisted of blocks 10 x 10km (100km<sup>2</sup>), although where the Ordnance Survey base consisted of double sheets (200km<sup>2</sup>), a single film overlay was used for both sectors.

The following slight problems were encountered with this methodology:-

- Handling difficulties when checking that the edges of large map sheets were reconciled.
- The survey area was, in some places, confined to very small areas in the corners of OS map sheets, which had to be mapped on separate overlays.
- When parish based information was used (see above) it could be inconvenient if parishes were split between different overlays.

It was felt that the overall handling advantages of working in accordance with the OS map sheet divisions outweighed these minor difficulties.

#### **D.v Further refinements of the methodology for the Gloucestershire and Wye Valley AONB HLC**

##### **D.v.i Scale of the mapping of the assessment results**

The same scale of mapping (1:25,000) was used throughout the Gloucestershire and Wye Valley AONB HLC.

##### **D.v.ii Digitisation**

The digitisation arrangements used for the Cotswolds AONB HLC were maintained for the Gloucestershire and Wye Valley AONB HLC.

The only difference between the digitisation of the two surveys was that whereas the Cotswolds AONB HLC used only polygons (point features were digitised as fixed size circles and line features were digitised as long thin polygons) the digitisation of the Gloucestershire and Wye Valley AONB HLC made use of digitised point and line features.

### D.v.iii Sub-divisions of the assessment area

During the Gloucestershire and Wye Valley AONB HLC, the way in which the survey process was subdivided was modified, as the Ordnance Survey had ceased to publish 1:25,000 scale maps based on the 10km grid. Accordingly it was decided to use the most up-to-date OS maps at this scale (Outdoor Leisure, and Explorer series), and subdivide the manual record into drawing film overlays based on those maps rather than the OS grid.

### D.v.iv Primary Types

Some new Primary Types were identified in the course of the Gloucestershire and Wye Valley AONB HLC, and some Primary Type designations were revised as part of the process of standardising the results of the two surveys. The details of these are set out in Section 0 above, and in D.vi below.

### D.v.v Sources

The principal difference between the two surveys was in the sources which were used and the information which was derived from them. Details of this can be found in Appendix A above.

## Appendix E The archive

The project archive is retained by the Archaeology Service, Gloucestershire County Council, Environment Department. Copies of relevant sections of the archive have been sent to participating County Councils.

The archive is divided by both county and sector, and consists of the following:-

- Copies of the historic landscape characterisation results mapped in ink on film overlays to the 1:25,000 scale OS map bases.
- Rough copies of the OS base maps annotated with certain categories of information e.g. indicative place names, indicative boundaries, visible ridge and furrow, earthworks, relevant SMR and nature conservation information. These are not intended as a comprehensive record of all source information, but acted as a useful medium for partial data collection to facilitate the historic landscape type characterisation process.
- Copies of a pro-forma for each sector (see Appendix 3 above) acting as a formal record of all the sources utilised during the characterisation of that area
- Copies of a pro-forma for each sector (see Appendix 3 above) acting as a record of parliamentary enclosure information derived from Tate 1978
- Copies of a pro-forma recording of comments on the characterisation process for each sector (see Appendix 3 above).
- Copies of relevant Midlands Open Field Project data
- Copies of notes or photocopies of relevant Victoria County History entries. As parish based data these are collated by county rather than sector.
- Copies of mapped information and GIS output of the work undertaken on the preliminary areas.
- Copies of all progress reports produced during the course of the characterisation.
- Copies of all historic landscape character type lists produced as part of the project.
- Copies of OS map bases for each sector (see Appendix 3 above) annotated with some categories of information e.g. selected SMR data, some ridge and furrow data, selected nature conservation designations.
