


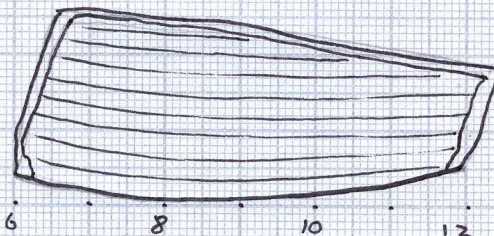
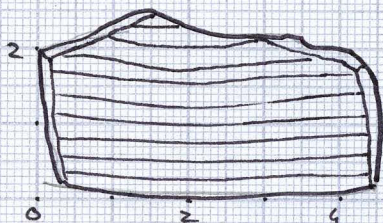

Description Two fragments of a wooden bowl. Found in sample #209. Both pieces join together. The largest of the two pieces measured 66mm x 25mm x 5mm. The smaller piece measured 45mm x 24mm x 5mm. Both pieces have one original edge - presumably the top rim of the vessel. Both pieces are stained dark on the inner surface and are much paler in colour on their outer surfaces. The outer surface has a chamfered edge around the top rim.

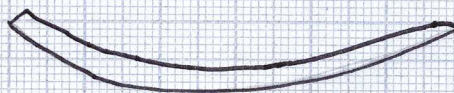

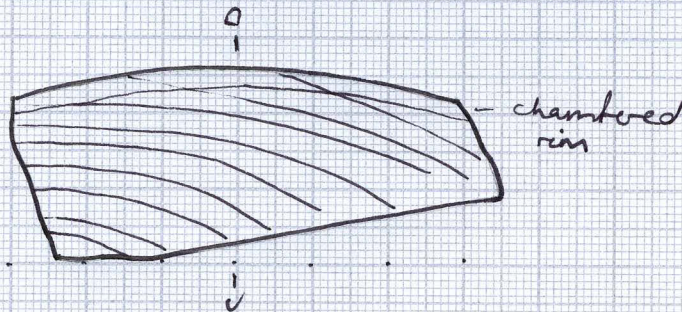
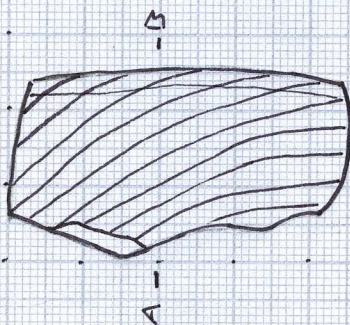
PLAN VIEW
INNER SURFACE



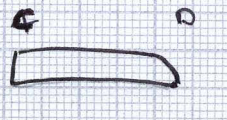
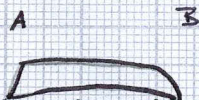
PROFILE
