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NOTE: In the event of the discovery of a previously unknown monument, or  
of the threatened damage to or destruction of a known monument, coming to  
the notice of members, they are urged to report the same forthwith to the  
Correspondent who lives nearest to the site in question, or to the Chief  
Correspondent concerned. It is important to note that scheduling of an  
ancient monument by the Ministry of Works is not in itself a guarantee of  
its immunity from damage or destruction, and the co-operation of local  
observers is necessary to ensure such immunity; for a prosecution under  
the Ancient Monuments Acts to be valid, it is necessary for proceedings  
to be begun within six months of the committing of an offence, so that it  
is essential that cases of damage or threatened damage to a monument  
should be reported as promptly as possible.
