Miss Katherine Sophia Hodgson, F.S.A., President of the Society 1948-1951 and Chairman of the Council 1955-1965, died in Penrith on 27th March, 1974. Her work for the Society over many years is gratefully remembered. She became a member in 1918 and was elected an honorary member in 1962. Her first contribution to *Transactions* appeared in Volume x 64 years ago. The picture above, taken at the Society's centenary dinner in Carlisle in 1966, shows Miss Hodgson in the centre with some of her successors in the office of President. The group includes the Mayor and Mayoress of Carlisle on the left with Mr Roger Fulford, President 1966-1968, between the Mayor and Miss Hodgson. Professor Eric Birley, President 1957-1960, is behind Miss Hodgson, with Mr C. Roy Hudleston, President 1960-1963, and Miss Clare Fell, President 1963-1966, on the right.
