

It is also essential that your child has had a tetanus injection to participate. Please complete the reply slip below to confirm whether this is the case.



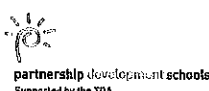

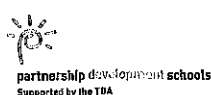
