1. Agriculture - AGR

Land and buildings used for the rearing of livestock

2. Civic and Commercial - CIV

Land and buildings used for public amenity or administration

3. Communications - COM

Areas where the main function is as part of the communications network

4. Extraction - EXT

Areas where the character is dominated by current or previous mineral and aggregate extraction

5. Fields and Enclosed Land - FIE

Enclosed areas of land primarily used for agriculture

6. Historic Earthworks - HEW

Upstanding archaeological earthwork remains

7. Industry - IND

Areas of industrial or manufacturing activity

8. Military – MIL

Land and Buildings used by the armed forces

9. Orchards and Allotments - ORC

Land used for horticultural purposes

10. Parkland - PRK

Country houses and their associated estates and subsidiary buildings

11. Recreational Open Space - ROS

Recreational space for public use, usually found in or around towns and villages

12. Settlement - SET

Areas where people currently live, or have lived in the past

13. Unenclosed Land - UNE

Areas of unimproved or unenclosed land

14. Water and Wetland - WAW

Areas of open water, marshes and floodplain fields

15. Woodland - WDL

All blocks of woodland 1ha or above in size

Appendix 3 – HLC Types

1. Agricultural - AGR

AGR – 01 Livestock Rearing

Barns or other large agricultural buildings used for sheltering and/or rearing animals

AGR – 02 Fish Farm

Pools and associated buildings for commercial fish farming

AGR – 03 Crop Storage

Sheds or silos used for the storage of crops

2. Civic and Commercial - CIV

Educational – CIV-04

Educational establishments such as colleges, universities and larger school complexes.

Religious – CIV-05

Churches and associated land or buildings. Includes Almshouses and Graveyards.

Medical – CIV-06

Areas utilised by large medical facilities such as hospitals or health centres.

Municipal – CIV-07

Public buildings such as council offices and emergency services

Leisure – CIV-08

Building or group primarily used for recreational or sporting purposes.

Offices – CIV-104

Office buildings, usually found in an urban setting.

Large Retail Outlets – CIV-105

Large modern retail developments, such as supermarkets or retail parks.

High Street Shops – CIV-106

Retail spaces in the centre of a town or village, often resulting from a change of use from residential buildings. Used where several small retail outlets occur outside an Historic Settlement Core.

Car Parks – CIV-110

Multi storey building in which cars are parked.

Cemeteries – CIV-111

Areas of land designated for the burial of the dead. This type includes crematoria, but does not include graveyards associated with religious buildings.

3. Communications - COM

Sidings – COM-09

Railway features such as sidings or goods-yards.

Cuttings and Embankments – COM-10

Railway features created for the continuation of railway tracks across relatively higher or lower ground.

Public Transport Station – COM-11

Railway or bus stations usually found in or near settlements. These will often include associated car-parks

Canal Lock/Basin – COM-12

This category defines canal locks, basins, wharfs and marinas marked on the current 1:10,000 OS map if this is the Current Character and marked on earlier OS editions if this is the Previous Character.

Service Station – COM-13

Service areas typically associated with motorways and the larger trunk roads and marked on the modern OS map base.

Civil Airports/Airfield – COM-14

Airports and airfields in civil use. A number of these will have formally been for military use and given over to civil use after the Second World War.

Junction – COM-15

This category defines major road junctions marked on the current 1:10,000 OS map.

4. Extraction - EXT

Limestone Quarry – EXT-16

Active or Inactive feature associated with the extraction of limestone, typically as a building material.

Reinstated Land – EXT-17

Used as a previous type where an intermediate stage of landfill cannot be reliably used, for example when reinstatement occurs before c.1950

Clay Pit – EXT-18

Active or inactive feature associated with the extraction of clay for brick or tile making. This type is intended for use where processing of the extracted material is undertaken elsewhere.

Sand and Gravel Quarry – EXT-19

Active or inactive feature associated with the extraction of sands and gravels.

Ironstone Quarry – EXT-20

Active or Inactive feature associated with the extraction of material for the production of iron.

Chalk Pit – EXT-21

Active or inactive feature associated with the extraction of chalk.

Landfill – EXT-22

Indicates a former quarry that is used for the disposal of commercial, industrial or domestic waste. This can be encountered as a current type where the process is ongoing, or as a previous type when reinstatement is complete.

5. Fields and Enclosed Land - FIE

Estate Fields – FIE-24

This type is a result of the transformation of landscaped parks or deer parks to agricultural use. This is usually seen in the 20th century, and may be seen as a variation on the Modern Fields type.

Ancient Enclosure – FIE-25

Pre-18th century enclosures of former open fields or common grazing land. Field morphology of this type may be used to infer the previous type.

Strip Fields – FIE-26

This category identifies areas which are likely to have formed part of medieval open fields, the presence of which can be suggested through the presence of ancient enclosure or ridge and furrow earthwork remains.

Re-organised Piecemeal Enclosure – FIE-27

Small irregular or rectilinear fields that have lost 10% or more field boundaries since the 1st ed 6" map, or areas of large irregular or rectilinear fields. In both cases at least two field boundaries will have an 's-curve' or 'dog-leg' morphology.

Parliamentary Planned Enclosure – FIE-28

Highly rectilinear field patterns resulting from the enclosure of common land and open fields by act of parliament. This type of landscape is predominantly 18th/19th century, although some earlier examples may exist.

Modern Fields – FIE-29

Typically post WW2 reorganisation of agricultural land, resulting in large fields exhibiting significant boundary loss from 1st Ed Ordnance Survey.

Paddocks and Closes – FIE-30

These small fields are usually seen at the edge of settlements, possibly indicating small scale enclosure by agreement, or the re-use and agglomeration of derelict housing plots.

Private Enclosure from Woodland – FIE-31

Small irregular or rectilinear fields which appear to have been created through woodland clearance. Typically these will border or occur close to areas of ancient woodland.

Private Planned Enclosure – FIE-32

Similar to the Parliamentary Planned Enclosure type, in that it is characterised by a highly rectilinear pattern of boundaries. Differs in that it is not the result of an act of parliament.

6. Historic Earthworks - HEW

Saltern Earthworks – HEW-33

Earthwork remains associated with the production of salt from seawater.

Medieval Village Earthworks – HEW-34

Earthworks interpreted as the remains of vernacular medieval settlement. This type can be used to demonstrate shrinkage or desertion, and is associated with Historic Settlement Core as a previous type.

Medieval High Status Residence – HEW-35

Earthworks identified as the remains of a high status residence. Many examples are moated. Typically seen at the edge of a medieval settlement, and identifiable from Aerial Photographs, map data or HER/SMR records

Medieval Religious Complex – HEW-36

Earthworks associated with a medieval religious foundation.

Prehistoric Earthworks – HEW-96

Earthwork remains dating from pre-Medieval periods. Identified from HER records.

7. Industrial-IND

Other Industrial Works – IND-37

This category includes water treatment plants, power stations and other utilities.

Other Factory – IND-38

Manufacturing facility, usually identified from OS mapping, that does not allow a more specific interpretation.

Docks, Wharves and Havens – IND-39

Facilities for loading and unloading waterborne cargo.

Warehouses and Distribution – IND-40

Facilities used for temporary storage and /or distribution of goods. Typically characterised by larger buildings and car parks, often situated away from main settlements

Derelict Industrial Land – IND-41

Former industrial sites which have been cleared and had no subsequent development on them.

Brick and Tile Works – IND-42

Industrial facilities for manufacturing bricks and tiles. Raw material for the process is often extracted on site, resulting in characteristic ponds.

Saltern – IND-44

Previous type showing former industrial salt production up to the Late Medieval period

Chemical Works – IND-45

Large industrial developments related to the petro-chemicals industry, including storage tanks, refineries and flare towers.

Industrial Estate – IND-46

Modern complex of industrial buildings, often found at the edge of settlements.

Car Storage – IND-47

Areas of hard standing where cars and other small vehicles are stored prior to export, or between import and sale.

8. Military - MIL

Missile Base – MIL-48

Facilities for the basing and operation of offensive or defensive missile batteries.

Bombing Range – MIL-49

Large area of land or sea used for training, and testing of air-to-ground weaponry.

Ordnance Depot – MIL-50

Areas characterised as having been used for munitions storage.

Military Airfield – MIL-51

Active or Inactive facility for the operation of military aircraft. Characterised by the presence of runways, hangars and air traffic control buildings.

Barracks – MIL-103

Military complexes for the accommodation and training of personnel.

Military Other – MIL-109

Encompasses all other military sites not included above, such as radar and communications sites.

9. Orchards and Allotments - ORC

Nurseries – ORC-52

Land used for growing plants or trees for later planting sale. Identifiable from map data or by the large areas of greenhousing seen on site.

Allotment Gardens – ORC-53

Publicly owned land that has been divided into small plots for rental by individuals. Identifiable from APs and map data. Not to be confused with Land Association Allotments and smallholdings.

Orchards – ORC-54

Areas of land given over to the commercial growing of fruit. These can often be seen on 1st edition OS maps, but large modern examples are more common.

10. Parkland - PRK

Landscape Park – PRK-55

Parkland that has been landscaped by the planting of trees, digging/raising of earthwork features and lakes, for the purpose of providing an aesthetically pleasing setting for a country house.

Formal Gardens – PRK-56

Designed ornamental gardens, usually found in the immediate vicinity of a country house or stately home.

Kitchen Gardens – PRK-57

Often surrounded by a brick wall, these features are also found associated with country houses. They are clearly indicated by a regular pattern of cultivation.

Deer Park – PRK-58

Identifies those areas known to have been medieval deer parks and have been identified on the HER or where the boundaries can still be distinguished on the modern or 1st ed OS map base.

Estate Buildings – PRK-59

Farm buildings and cottages associated with an estate. Residential buildings are often constructed to a common design in a planned fashion

Country House – PRK-60

Large stately homes, often surrounded by extensive estates or landscape parks. Although intended as residential features, these are now often preserved as museums by national organisations. This HLC type is included here as it is inappropriate to divorce these objects from their surroundings.

11. Recreational Open Space - ROS

Recreation Ground – ROS-61

Areas of land accessible to the public commonly in an urban context and has undergone a degree of landscaping, can include wider roadside verges.

Golf Course – ROS-62

Golf courses identified as such from the current OS map base.

Nature Reserve – ROS-64

Area of land given over to the conservation of wildlife or habitats. Often results from a previous land use that renders the area useless for other purposes, such as quarrying or peat extraction.

Recreational Seafront – ROS-97

Coastal resort amenities such as amusement arcades and fairground rides.

12. Settlement – SET

Caravan Park – SET-65

Generally for recreational use. However, some are used year round as low-cost housing in the vicinity of urban centres.

Isolated Farmstead – SET-66

Residential farm buildings standing alone in open countryside. These will typically date from after Enclosure, as farmers moved away from villages and closer to their new holdings.

Terraced Housing (C20th) – SET-67

Terraced housing appearing on 2nd edition or modern OS mapping.

Detached Housing (C20th /21st) – SET-68

Areas of detached housing visible on 2nd edition or modern OS mapping.

Terraced Housing (C18th) – SET-69

Terraced housing appearing on 1st edition OS mapping and identified from street level photography.

Detached Housing (C18th) – SET-70

Detached housing appearing on 1st edition OS mapping and identified from street level photography.

Flats and Apartments – SET-71

Multi storey residential buildings.

Planned Residential Development – SET-72

Settlement areas that have been designed and built in a planned fashion, such as post-WWII council estates and modern private housing estates.

Historic Settlement Core – SET-73

Historic settlement cores suggested by morphology, data held in the HER, or earthwork remains. These are often more extensive than current survival would indicate, and use of the previous type function will allow this to be shown.

Terraced Housing (C19th) – SET-74

Terraced housing visible on 1st edition (1888) OS mapping.

Pre 1960s Semi Detached Housing – SET-75

Semi detached housing built before 1960.

Detached Housing (C19th) – SET-76

Areas of detached housing visible on 1st edition OS mapping.

Medieval High Status Residence – SET-77

Previous HLC type used to indicate the presence of a medieval centre of government. These can be indicated by place name evidence, morphological features, or may be found in the HER.

Religious Foundation – SET-78

Religious foundations, such as monasteries. These are often indicated on OS mapping, and are usually kept as records by the HER.

Village Farmstead – SET-79

Residential farm buildings within or immediately adjacent to an historic settlement core. Such buildings will probably date from before the enclosure of open fields and commons.

Holiday Camps – SET-98

Self-contained holiday accommodation and entertainment facilities.

Post 1960s Semi-Detached Housing – SET-102

Semi detached housing built after 1960.

13. Unenclosed Land - UNE

Water Meadow – UNE-80

Area of wetland grazing adjacent to a river or stream. Indicated by place name evidence, such as 'Ings' or 'Meadows'.

Turbary – UNE-81

Area of land where a legal right exists for the cutting of turf and peat for fuel and building material, and where this right has been exercised, resulting in a depressed area of wetland.

Heathland – UNE-82

These areas are usually identified from map data and place-name evidence, along with the English Nature lowland and upland heath datasets.

Fenland – UNE-83

Open grazing land that was waterlogged in winter due to seasonal rainfall and river flooding.

Marshland – UNE-84

Open grazing land that was subject to tidal inundation by salt water.

Rabbit Warren – UNE-85

Land given over to the raising of rabbits.

14. Water and Wetlands - WAW

Raised Mire – WAW-86

Areas of unimproved peats, formation of which will typically have begun in the prehistoric period.

Marsh – WAW-87

Areas marked as marsh on the modern OS map base.

Ornamental Open Water – WAW-88

Bodies of water created or modified for the purpose of landscaping or recreational use.

Artificial Open Water – WAW-89

This type includes reservoirs, irrigation ponds, settling pools and quarry pits.

Natural Open Water – WAW-90

Expanses of open water over 1ha which have natural origins. Typically these will occupy basins formed during the last glaciation.

15. Woodland - WDL

Estate Woodland – WDL-91

Ornamental woodland planted as part of landscaping projects, usually in the 18th and 19th centuries. Such woodlands often define the boundaries of a major country estate, and where they have been cleared, can often be recognised from 1st edition OS maps.

Ancient/Semi Natural Woodland – WDL-92

Woods classified by English Nature as 'Ancient Semi-Natural'. This type is derived from the Ancient Woodland Inventory dataset supplied by English Nature.

Plantation Woodland – WDL-93

Woods identified as plantations from morphology or name. This type includes those that have been cleared, and these will be represented as a previous type.

Other Woodland – WDL-94

Areas of woodland that do not fit into the above categories, such as natural growth over derelict land.

Fox Coverts – WDL-95

Areas of plantation woodland specifically planted to provide cover for foxes and other game animals. These often form part of a wider hunting landscape.
