The late President.—In the death of the Hon. Frederick Strutt, on Easter Monday, 12th April, the Society has sustained a heavy loss. A most energetic and indefatigable worker in whatever he undertook, in spite of his infirmities, and an enthusiastic archæologist, he appeared to be the most suitable man the Society could elect as President on the death in 1906 of the late Duke of Rutland. His death has made a wide gap, hard to fill, not only in our Society's Council, but also in many of the important works of the county.

The death, too, of General Wrottesley was a great blow to the Editor, who has from time to time received much valuable and kindly help from him, who was quite in the foremost rank of genealogists.
