BONE WORK REPORT

- Pin 88 53 Length:- 28mm
Lower part of bone pin.
- Pin 245 75 Length:- 28mm
Lower part of bone pin, both ends broken.
- Pin 156 64 Length:- 63mm
Broken below head and with tip missing.
Possibly unfinished.
- Bead? 179 65 Length:- 30mm
Hollowed out and highly polished decorated on
outer edge by 5 raised notches. Possibly a
spacer head?

- Pin 186 63 Length:- 46mm
Middle section of bone pin, with both ends
broken.
- Needle 189 75 Length:- 65mm 27mm
Needle with elongated eye, broken with part
of lower middle section and extreme tip missing.
cf. WEAG p.100, fig.50, 8.
- Pin 224 78 Length:- 32mm
Pin with 2 reels beneath a conical head and
Round sectioned shaft prob. C 4th AD
cf. The Roman Small Finds from excavations -
Colchester 1971-9.

- Pin 247 79 Length:- 37mm
Lower half of round sectioned bone pin.
Extreme tip broken.
- Pin 252 65 Length:- 51mm
Lower left of highly polished pin, with extreme
tip broken, circular in section.
- Needle 274 79 Length:- 49mm
Upper part of needle, lower portion broken and
the upper, perforated section is broken at the
start of the probably elongated eye. The eye is
crudely carved and a deep groove runs $c.\frac{1}{3}$ along
the remaining shaft from the upper broken end.
- Pin Head 361 64 Length:- 20mm
Carved head with small fragment of shaft of bone
pin. The head consists of a reel surmounted by a
large cone, upon which sits a further rool beneath
a small dome. prob. C2nd AD.

- Pin 477 64 Length:- 52mm
Lower half of a round sectioned pin.
- Pin 616 64 Length:-
Middle section of a round sectioned pin, broken
just below the head, probably had transverse
grooves beneath a conical head. C2nd AD
cf. N. Crummy op.cit.
- Pin 664 111
Head and upper half of multi faceted head pin
prob C3rd/4th.
cf. N. Crummy op.cit. p.22, fig.19, 288.

- *Counter 56 62 Diameter:- 17 mm
 Bone gaming counter, hollowed on the upper surface with a graffito:- AM scratched on the side C3rd-4th AD cf. Baldock, the Excavation of a Roman and Pre Roman Settlement 1968-72 I.M. Stead and V. Rigby, Britannia Monograph No.7, 1986, p.163, fig.70, 616.
- Pin 1066 217
 Middle section of circular sectioned bone pin
 Length:- 36mm
- Pin 1387 111
 Upper half of a thick bone pin. Roughly oval in section
 Length:- 31mm
- Pin 1549 340 Lower half of circular sectioned bone pin.
 Length: 42mm
- Pin 1599 335 Middle section of circular sectioned bone pin.
 Length: 43mm
