<p>Summary of Fieldwork Results:</p> <p>A small group of archaeological features was recorded in the area of Lodge Wood. The features comprised a ditch and two pits of late Iron Age date, a medieval gully, two undated ditches and a posthole (the undated features are most likely to be Iron Age). Although the number of features identified is small, the presence of significant finds concentrations from some features suggests the presence of a late Iron Age settlement focus in the near vicinity. Poor visibility during the watching brief prevented recovery of a coherent site plan. The watching brief followed an evaluation of the area which identified a low density of features thought to be of Iron Age and Roman date (see evaluation report ARCLWD98, OAU, 1998).</p>
