Figure 243: Saltwood Tunnel. The Merovingian four-brooch costume, reconstructed as a sleeveless 'Frankish coat' over a dress with a long front opening (from Walton Rogers in press). In Saltwood Eastern cemetery grave W1453 the top two brooches were a pair of quatrefoils and the bottom two a pair of small *Jutlandisch* brooches, and in grave W1762 there was a Kentish bird brooch at the top above a continental silver disc brooch, combined with a pair of Kentish square-headed brooches below.
