

WC Cuttings 6n & 6x

6n. East of Cutting 6 (across E. edge of pit)

6n. See Fig. XXX. No finds, no notes check with PJF!! One section drawing. 12' in length (EW) by 4' in width (NS). Cutting to section E. edge of pit. A nail, Type 6, noted in TWA metalwork report, had '6 N' on label. GF6 is from Cutting 2, area 2E, not N, so this could be a nail from Cutting 6N.

6x

Not a beer, but another cutting. This one 10' in length (EW) by 3' in width (NS) and 20' E. from the SE corner of SEf of Cutting 6 (although cutting plan says 25' from SEf). Many sherds in top 9" (**GF387**, 'Sherds'. Black soil & flint. To 9" in depth). Edge of black soil picked up c. 4' from W. edge of cutting. Caly with flint subsoil found at both ends of cutting, but in centre a large depression was visible in section into the chalk subsoil. Filling of depression was very clayey, but without the orange colour nor number of flints in subsoil proper. In addition, contains a large number of fragments of charcoal.
