

WC Cutting 12

11-14/08/62. 10' in length (WE) by 4' in width (NS) from centre of depression edged with sarsens up against the bank and ditch, E. of triangular Enclosure C and near the N. end of the bank and ditch which forms part of the enclosure of Wroughton Mead (see Fig. XXX Archive). Many bones and nail found after deturfing, as well as a sarsen on the inner (W.) edge of the bank. A profile drawing for Cutting 12 details 40' of ground surface (see Archive XXX). The cutting itself was from 15'-25' on this plan, with a sarsen at 15'-17' from point 0, (E.) in the topsoil. Under this layer was one of brown soil with many small flints (c. 12" in depth), over the natural clay with flints subsoil.

GF762, C13th sherd. Bones. Nail type 24. Topsoil.

GF761, Bones. Sherds. Amongst flints & below topsoil.
