Topsoil

GF456, Bone. PMS sherd. Nail type 5. In N1, topsoil.

Bottom of humus/topsoil on 'flinty layer', 'flint terrace', 'clay with flints', 'flint surface' or 'top of chalk' G1, G2, H1, H2, J1 & J2

GF216, Later medieval horseshoe fragment; mid-C14 to 16th. (TWA, 8). In G2, on clay with flints. 7" in depth.

GF217, Large nail type 29. In G2, in humus immediately on top of clay with flints. 7" in depth. c. 1180-1280 AD (TWA, 5).

GF218, Nail, type 28. In G2, on top of clay with flints. 7" in depth. c. 1180-1280 AD (TWA, 5).

GF219, Nail, type 28 In G2, on top of clay with flints. 7" in depth.

GF220, Bones. Iron heckle tooth (TWA, 4), Nail, type 11. In G2, on top of clay with flints, 7" in depth.

GF225, C13th sherd. Iron bar fragment. In G1, bottom of humus over clay with flints. 6"-8" in depth.

GF226, Nail. Rectangular iron staple, possibly used as a bolt keeper (TWA, 5) In H1, bottom of humus over clay with flints. 6"-8" in depth.

GF227, Iron nails, type 11. Nail shank. In G2, bottom of humus over clay with flints. To 8" in depth.

GF228, Iron bar fragment. In G2, clay with flints. Below 8".

GF229, Rowel spur, ?late C15th/ post-medieval (TWA, 9-10). C13th sherd [not in site notes]. In **H2**, on clay with flints. 6'10½" from H, 5'3" from I. Depth: 6".

GF230, Iron strap hinge fragment, possibly for supporting doors or windows (TWA, 6). Nail shank. Horseshoe nail type 3, later medieval/mid-C14th onwards. Bone. Sherd. In **H2**, bottom of humus, top of clay with flints. 6" in depth.

GF231, Iron buckle. In J2, bottom of turf, top of clay with flints. 8'11" from J, 15'7" from K. 8" in depth.

GF238, Teeth. Nail shank. Iron strip fragment. In H1, bottom of topsoil, above clay with flints. 6"-8" in depth.

GF239, 2 horseshoe nails type 3, 2 nails type 11, 4 nail shanks. Normandy French late C15th jar sherd. Nut shells. Shells. Charcoal. Bones. Whetstone. In **J2**, bottom of topsoil, above clay with flints. 6"-8" in depth.

GF242, Nails, type 24 & 11. C13th sherd. Tile fragments. In J1, bottom of topsoil, above clay with flints.

GF266, Bone. 3 nail shanks. In J1, bottom of topsoil, on flinty layer.

GF302, Sherds. 'Nails'. In G2, bottom of topsoil on flinty terrace. 6" in depth.

GF253, Group of PMS bowl sherds, C17/18th. In M/N2, bottom of topsoil and on top of clay with flints. 17'1" from M, 12'6" from N. 3" in depth.

GF255, Nails. Bones. C13th, mostly PMS sherds. Glass. Tile fragments. Iron knife blade fragment. 2 horseshoe nails, type 3, 1 stud type 13. In **M/N2**, bottom of topsoil and on top of clay with flints. 6" in depth. **Xfits 17 & 18**, both with **GF285**, **GF255** also with **GF358**. C17/18th.

GF277, PMED Sherds. Bones. Later medieval horseshoe fragment. 3 horseshoe nails type 3. Snail shells. In M/N3, topsoil around stones & on flint surface 6"-8"

GF279, C13th sherd, 1 RB. Bones. Horseshoe nail type 3, nail type 20. Tile fragments. Topsoil on top of flints of terrace. M/N3 N end.

GF285, Bones. Nail. C13th sherds, 1 MG; TDGR sherd late C15/16th; PMS sherds. An unidentified iron object. In **M/N3**, south end. Bottom of topsoil on flints of terrace.

GF297, Iron knife or shear blade, post-medieval (TWA, 5). In **M/N3**, south end. Bottom of topsoil on flints. 24'3" from M, 16'3" from N. 7" in depth.

GF307, EMOD & PMED sherds. Shell. 4 nail shanks. In O3, bottom of topsoil on chalk & flint surface over all cutting. 6"-8" in depth.

GF308, Nail type 18, nail type 19, 2 nail shanks. Bone. In 13, bottom of topsoil. 6" in depth.

 $\textbf{GF315}, \textbf{C13} \textbf{th sherds}. \ \textbf{Bones}. \ \textbf{Nails}. \ \textbf{Oyster shell}. \ \textbf{Charcoal}. \ \textbf{In M/N3}, \ \textbf{south end}. \ \textbf{Bottom of topsoil down to flinty layer}. \ \textbf{6"-9" in depth}.$

GF330, Bone. Horseshoe fragment. Charcoal. Nail type 11, nail type 14. In O3, topsoil down to flint. 6"-8" in depth.

GF334, Sherd. In O3, north end. Flinty layer below topsoil. 6"-12" in depth.

GF358, C13th, 1 MG; latter C13th sherd & PMS sherds. Bones. Nail type 11, nail type 17. 2 Horseshoe fragments. In **O2**, bottom of topsoil down to flinty layer. 7"-9" in depth.

GF370, Nail, type 9. 10" deep. In MN/O3 baulk. Top of chalk silt. Layer at baulk 10" by 19".

GF379, Later medieval horsehoe fragment. Horseshoe nail type 3. PMED sherds. Bone. In O4, on flint at 6".

GF456, Bone and 23 post-medieval sherds. Topsoil N1.

GF490, Bones. Whittle tang knife with bolster, end C17th/ post-medieval. Sherds. Iron bar object. Horseshoe nail type 3, nail type 6. In **O5**, topsoil on flints.

GF512, C13th sherd. Bone. Charcoal. In O5, flinty soil ?over top of ditch. 16" in depth (would indicate bottom of ditch)

'Wall', 'wall foundation' & 'wall foundation trench'

GF249, Iron object. In M/N2, in brown humus & flints, between two stones of wall on clay with flints. 21'9" from M, 15'6" from N. 10" in denth

GF314, 16 MG sherds. Bones. Nail type 11, 2 nails type 20, nail shank. In M/N3, in wall foundation. 6"-9" in depth.

GF333, C13th sherd. Bones. In M/N3, in possible wall foundation trench. 9"-12" in depth.

Ditch

GF489, Bones. In N1, ditch filling.

GF539, Bones. In O5, ditch filling.

GF299, Norman horseshoe fragment. Skull. Iron spike. Pre-medieval, possibly prehistoric hazelnut (TWA, Table 27). Hazel charcoal. In **O3**, loamy filling of ditch running E-W through cutting. To 8".

GF330, Bone. Horseshoe fragment. Charcoal. Nail type 11, nail type 14. In O3, topsoil down to flint. 6"-8" in depth.

GF331, Sherd. Bone. Charcoal. In O3, filling of ditch. 8"-33" in depth.

GF334, Sherd. In O3, north end. Flinty layer below topsoil. 6"-12" in depth.

GF340, Bones. In O3, south of ditch. Flint, chalk & clay layer. 17" to bottom, not yet reached.

GF358, C13th, 1 MG; latter C13th sherd & PMS sherds. Bones. Nail type 11, nail type 17. 2 Horseshoe fragments. In O2, bottom of topsoil down to flinty layer. 7"-9" in depth.

GF370, Nail, type 9. 10" deep. In MN/O3 baulk. Top of chalk silt. Layer at baulk 10" by 19".

GF379, Later medieval horsehoe fragment. Horseshoe nail type 3. PMED sherds. Bone. In O4, on flint at 6".

GF399, Sherd. Bone. In O4, soil ditch filling. 7"-14".

GF402, Bones. In O4, ditch filling, chalk and clay. 14" in depth.

GF431, Nail shank. Bone. In O4, ditch filling of chalk & clay. 1'2"-1'11" in depth.

GF432, Sherd. Iron strip object, traces of cu alloy (TWA, 6). In **O4**, ditch filling of chalk & clay. 4' N f south end of cutting, 1'4" W of east side. 2'3" in depth.

GF435, Skeleton. In O4, top of pit/ditch? filling. Possibly a dog. Perforated strap frag.

GF437, C13th sherd. In O4, ditch filling. 2'10" in depth.

GF456, Bone and 23 post-medieval sherds. Topsoil N1.

GF490, Bones. Whittle tang knife with bolster, end C17th/ post-medieval. Sherds. Iron bar object. Horseshoe nail type 3, nail type 6. In **O5**, topsoil on flints.

GF512, C13th sherd. Bone. Charcoal. In O5, flinty soil over top of ditch. 16" in depth.

GF567, Whetstone/strike-a-light. In O3, see section.

W ext. to G1(across the bank)

GF262, Sherd. W. ext. to **G1**. 12'9" from west end of cutting. 2'2" in depth. Not in RT pottery report, site notes record it as late RB (or L.B.A.).
