The investigation of a depression edged with sarsens, up against the northern part of the older bank and ditch of Wroughton Mead, east of Enclosure C, cannot be readily explained. No evidence of a structure was obtained, nor any explanation of this feature. The large quantity of bones would point to it being used as a rubbish dump, possibly at the same time as the occupation phase(s) of the site, although why it was originally dug, assuming it is not natural, which it could well be, is unclear.
