THE IRON AGE AND ROMAN COINS FOUND AT SILCHESTER, AS RECORDED AND CATALOGUED BY GEORGE BOON, 1951–54

It was not my good fortune to have known the late George Boon; my acquaintance with him comes entirely through his work. Of that work, perhaps the most significant was the cataloguing and recording of the 13,400 Iron Age and Roman coins found in and around the Silchester area, which, according to notes on the museum accession documentation, Boon accomplished between 1951 and 1954. The majority of the coins originated from two great collections: that of the Duke of Wellington, which was subsequently accessioned to the Reading Museum and Art Gallery, and that held at Stratfield Saye House. The coins comprising the Duke of Wellington's Collection had been obtained either from excavations at the site over the better part of the preceding century, or had been found on or near the site. Those held at Stratfield Saye House had been found by Joyce and his successors prior to 1890 and had been catalogued by Boon in 1952–53. A number of minor collections and gifts to the museum also contributed towards the total.

The coins had been listed before: by Mill-Stephenson in *c.* 1910 in a series of notes which had been left with the museum and then later, in 1928, by Pearce who had published an abbreviated account in the *Numismatic Chronicle* 1929, p. 328ff. Boon refers to these lists as appropriate in the accession notes. Mill-Stephenson certainly would have been unable to provide Roman Imperial Coinage references for the coins, Pearce's account includes no more than total coin quantities next to specific emperors.

Boon's listing, however, was altogether more comprehensive. Evans references, where possible, were noted for the Iron Age material, while Sydenham and Cohen references were used for the Roman Republican coins. *RIC* references were included, again where possible, for all coins up until A.D. 296, while after that, a combination of Cohen and Maurice references were used for the Tetrarchic and Constantinian coinage. The then published *RIC* Vol. IX was used to catalogue the Valentinianic and Theodosian coinage.

No doubt as a result of his knowledge of then current developments in the study of numismatics and in particular the recording of Roman coins, Boon, prior to the publication of *RIC* Vols VI, VII and VIII and the two volumes of *Late Roman Bronze Coinage*, organised the late third- and fourth-century coins on a mint and date of issue basis and then manually transcribed the mintmark details onto the accession cards.

The principal aim of the current work has been to take that information as preserved by Boon and to translate it into the appropriate *RIC* and *LRBC* references. The coins themselves have also been re-organised into Reece's 21 periods. This, it is hoped, will make them both accessible and usable for future studies. It should be noted that the Iron Age and Pre-Flavian coins listed here also appear within George Boon's extended, synthetic catalogues of these types published in Fulford and Timby (2000) ('Schedule B: the British and Gaulish coins from Silchester' (163–70)

'and Schedule C, the Pre-Flavian coins from Silchester' (170–9)). These provide fuller details and a more up-to-date categorisation of the numerous irregular issues of the first century A.D.
