

APPENDIX 1 - METALWORK

Assessment of Metalwork

A single iron nail was recovered from context 820, the upper fill of pit 819 which dates from the 13th-14th century (Table 4). The nail has been x-rayed and identified visually. It is poorly preserved. This single nail is insufficient to suggest the existence of any built structures on the site, and could be intrusive. If the x-rays are deposited with the site archive, the nail need not be retained. It has no potential to contribute to the CTRL research aims and no further work is required.
