1 THE RADIOCARBON DATES FROM PARSONAGE FARM

The events considered for radiocarbon dating (i.e. brushwood platform contemporary with the pottery (50 BC – AD 50) and the start and cessation of peat formation) were either dated suitably by the artefactual assemblages, or contained no suitable material to obtain the resolution required, or were not considered of significant priority to warrant dating. No radiocarbon dates were obtained from this site.
