SKULL:

Teeth: 1 single tooth root fragment, 2 root fragments.

4 occipital fragments (1 fragment, occipital protuberance; Sex: Male??), 1 left mastoid fragment.

35 cranial vault fragments.

AXIAL SKELETON:

1 pedicle fragment.

UPPER LIMB:

Clavicle: 1 midshaft fragment.

Radius: 1 shaft fragment.

Hands: 1 hook of hamate, 2 distal phalanges.

LOWER LIMB:

Femur: 1 postero-proximal shaft fragment, 2 shaft fragments, 1 condyle fragment.

Tibia: 1 anterior border fragment.

AGE: Adult

SEX: Male??

PATHOLOGY SUMMARY: None

PYRE GOODS: None

CREMATION SUMMARY: 6 burnt flint fragments (<1 g). Bone fragments are white with some unidentified grey fragments as well as a few white with black core. Fragments from all fractions are eroded with the fragments from the 2 mm fraction being the most severely .

COMMENTS: The residue contained a very small amount of unidentifiable bone fragments from the 2 mm fraction.
