

Animal bone from Cobham Golf Course, Cobham, Kent

A single bone (13g) was recovered from the excavation at Cobham golf course. The bone was an adult dog humerus from an undated pit. The bone was very slightly misshapen; this appears to have been a symptom of being placed in a waterlogged deposit, rather than pathological. No further information was recovered.
