

APPENDIX 1 - ANIMAL REMAINS

1.1 Assessment of the Animal Bone

- 1.1.1 One fragment of a tooth (3 g) in many pieces was retrieved by hand from the middle fill (178) of ring ditch 156, dated to the late Neolithic-early Bronze Age (Table 6.1). It is likely to be a fragment of a cattle tooth. However, it had suffered significantly from attritional damage and was not complete enough for a certain identification to be made. No further work is recommended on the bone from this site.
