

## CAERWYS

- The town as it is today

Caerwys is still a small settlement many would describe as a village rather than a town. The secondary streets are now built up with twentieth-century housing, but there are earlier buildings along the two main streets, mostly with eighteenth or nineteenth century façades. Some earlier buildings stand along High Street, and some of the plot boundaries are themselves very substantially built, particularly those that form the rear of properties along High Street and Water Street, which are visible particularly on South Street. In 2001 the population of Caerwys stood at around 1000.<sup>125</sup>
