Custumal of the king's manor of Silverstone, 1288

Henry le Hauvile holds 1 virgate of land and pays 2s. at Easter and at Martinmas 4*d.* for housebote and haybote, and he will have before Christmas timber in the king's wood, that is, half an oak, and he must weed for 1 day with 1 man and it is worth 1*d.*, and he must make hay for as long as it is to be made with 1 man and it is worth 2*d.*, and he must cart hay to the curia of the king in Silverstone for as long as it is to be carried and it is worth 2*d.*, and he must reap the corn of the king for 3 days with 1 man and it is worth 6*d.*, and he must carry the lord's corn for 1 day until noon and he will have breakfast and 1 sheaf at noon of the kind of corn that he carried, and if he must carry after noon then he will have his food at noon and 1 sheaf at night of the kind of corn that he carried and it is worth 2*d.*, and he must plough for 1 day at fallow-time and for another day at the time of the winter sowing and for another day at the time of the Lenten sowing and the ploughing is worth 2*d.* a day, and know that he must plough the lord's land after he has ploughed his own land, and he owes suit of court according to the custom of the manor, and he must provide 2 men at the great boon-work, and the aforesaid Henry must go before his reapers with a rod in his hand, and the aforesaid Henry and his wife and his reapers must come to the dinner with a cloth, dishes, cups, plates and pint-pots, and they must have bread of sufficiently pure wheat and good ale and pottage and 1 good course of ox-meat between two and 1 good course of mutton and a good slice of cheese, the remainder of which the wife of Henry will carry where she wishes in her cloth and her pint-pot. Moreover, he who has bound that day must have 1 sheaf of the kind of corn that he has bound, as much as he is able to bind in a standard-sized band.

Leticia Cnotte holds $\frac{1}{2}$ virgate of land and pays 12*d.* at Easter and at Martinmas 4*d.* for housebote and haybote, and she must have timber, the fourth part of an oak, and she must weed for 1 day and it is worth $\frac{1}{2}$ *d.*, and make hay with 1 man for as long as it is to be made, and stack when the holders of a virgate of land carry, and it is worth 2*d.*, and if she ploughed with her own plough she must plough the land of the king for 1 day at the time of the winter sowing and for 1 day at the time of the Lenten sowing, and if she ploughed at fallow-time then for 1 day at fallow-time, and she must reap the king's corn for 2 days with 1 man and it is worth 4*d.*, and at the great boon-work with 1 man, and they come to their dinner with a cloth, cup, plate and pint-pot just as the aforesaid Henry, to be served as him, and she will carry the remainder with her where she wishes, and she owes suit of court according to the custom of the manor.
