For each of the radiocarbon dates two distributions have been plotted, one in outline, which is the result of simple radiocarbon calibration, and a solid one, which is based on the chronological model used. A question mark (?) indicates that the result has been excluded from the model. The large square on the left, along with the OxCal keywords, define the model exactly
