ACCOUNTS FOR THE 15 MONTHS ENDED 31 MARCH 1979 NOTES

- 1. The date to which the Society's accounts are drawn up has been altered from 31 December to 31 March. To accommodate the transition to the new date, the present accounts cover a period of 15 months.
- 2. The accounts are now presented on the basis of Income and Expenditure, and not Receipts and Expenditure as previously. This represents a more accurate view of the transactions and financial position of the Society, and it has been possible to make this change mainly because of improved controls on records of membership subscriptions.
- 3. The following Funds have been segregated from the General Fund accounts, and are shown separately:

 (i) Colt Fund
 (ii) Monograph VIII Fund
 (iii) Conference Fund
 A combined Balance Sheet is shown in addition.
 - It is intended that, commencing with the accounts for the year to 31 March 1980, the General Monograph Fund will also be shown separately from the General Fund.
- 4. The only material respect in which the transactions dealt with in the 15 month account differs from those dealt with in a normal 12 month period concerns the Society's annual conference, because both the 1978 (Bristol) and 1979 (Poitiers) conferences fall within the 15 month period. The accounts for both of these conferences therefore appear in the separate Conference Fund account, together with the comparative figures for the 1977 (Oban) conference. It was decided initially to establish the Conference Fund with the transfer of the surplus on the Bristol conference from the General Fund, and this is reflected in the General Fund account.
- 5. The 1977 comparative figures have been restated so that they are consistent with the changes in presentation described in Notes 2-4 above.
- 6. The additional subvention of £250 received in 1978/79 for Volume XXI was not anticipated in the 1977 accounts, and the net cost of Volume XXI was therefore:

7. The value of office equipment shown in the Balance Sheet is calculated as follows:
