N. p. 108, Richard de Hanred holds 100s. of land by the serjeanty of serving beer in the King's Buttery. p. 125, Henry de Bacon holds one third of West Hendred of the King's bailiff of the land which belonged to Richard de Hendred held in serjeanty. West Hendred. T. N. p. 110, 121, Philip de St. Helena and John de Turbervill have in Abingdon, Hendred, Frilford and Lyford, three fees of the Abbot of Abingdon of his barony. West Hendred. T. N. p. 110, Robert de Turbervill has one fee of the Fee of the Earl of Ferrers.
