examples of 19th century Perpendicular work. The modern addition seems to have been a good specimen of its time, and one cannot understand the motive which justified its destruction. The aisle was probably erected for the accommodation of the residents of the adjoining hamlet of Fernham, and as this has now got a small and uninteresting modern Church, the need for the aisle may have ceased, but it certainly seems a piece of wanton vandalism to have pulled it down on that account.
