A Schedule of Wills proved in the Court of Faringdon Peculiar 1580-1636.

MONG some stray sheets in the Oxford Archdeaconry Papers desposited with Bodley is a schedule of wills proved in the Court of Faringdon Peculiar, between 1580 and 1636. For the most part these wills are not calendared in the volume of Berkshire wills published by the Oxford Historical Society. A few, however, may be, but probably are not duplicates, and where the possibility occurs these are marked with a star in the transcription that follows—

"These are to certify all those to whom these presents shall or may come that Thomas Hayes of the p'sh of Great ffaringdon in the county of Berks, Chiurgeon, hath been three years past in his Maties service agst the dutch in the late Warre as a Chiurgeon and that to the best of our judgment he is a p'son whose skill and judgment in Chirugery is and ought to be tollerated and . . . to make use of his skill & practice in the said . . . we having of late had and received sufficient knowledge of his late cures of & upon several p'sons. In testimony whereof we have hereby sett our hands this thirtieth day of July Ad Car. 2nd XXI."
