



## Laurentine Shore Archive: Guide to Spreadsheets Graphics

### Graphic ID

Each drawing sheet in the archive has an individual ID number.

### Master Site Code

CPV – Castelporziano Vicus Augustanus.

CPS – Castelporziano Survey. Used for sites other than the Vicus Augustanus.

### Year

Project year.

### Map Grid / Site No

‘Vicus’ refers to the Vicus Augustanus (CPV). For the CPS sites codes, the letter refers to the kilometre grid square (A-G) while the number refers to the individual sites within that square as defined during the 1991 field survey: for a detailed explanation see Guide to Site Codes. ### Grid Square Ref.

These numbers only relate to surface surveys SS1, SS2, SS3 and Building Z.

### Vicus Zone / Building

Refers to buildings or zones in the Vicus; different areas are designated by a letter code from A to Z.

### Room Number

Prefaced by a letter relating to the building code. For example, ‘A10’ indicates room number 10 in Building A. Room numbers only apply to CPV sites.

### Trench

New excavations at the Vicus are designated by a letter code, not generally the same as those used for buildings. ‘Saggio’ refers to small test excavations in zones C and F, which have their own numbering.

### Context Number

Refers to a specific excavated archaeological context in a trench.

### Plan / Section ID

Original site drawing numbers.

### Other

Drawings that form sets; e.g. 1:50 site plans and sections, 1:50 inked site plans and sections, plans, sections and reconstructions prepared for publication in Castelporziano III and Castelporziano IV.

**Description**

A description of the subject of the drawing including a building or a site code. The type of drawing is indicated as plan, section, elevation, or other type of graphic. For cross-sections the direction is given as North-South, East-West generally in abbreviated form. Directions are given according to the site compass, see Vicus Site Datum file. Contexts are indicated within brackets: e.g. contexts 2 and 3 of Trench YH in Building Y are given as follows: 'CPV Trench YH Plan, context (2) and (3)'.

Grid square numbers and room numbers are differentiated from context numbers by square brackets. Thus grid square 2 at CPS site B3C is indicated as follows: 'CPS Area B3C Grid Square [2] Plan'.

Date of original drawing.

**Drawn by**

Author(s) of original drawing, for the abbreviated initials given here, see the Year by Year Report.

**Scale**

Scale of original drawing.

**Size**

Document size given as A4, A3 or 'L' for documents larger than A3.

**SAO Inv**

This column is provided for an eventual concordance with the Soprintendenza Archeologica di Ostia inventory numbers.

**Metadata**
