Historic environment data raw ingredients





Research Frameworks are our recipe books

- Combining the ingredients to create a synthesis or “knowledge cake”
- Providing direction on what we want to do next (serving suggestions)

**CHOCOLATE
MAYONNAISE
CAKE**

2 cups unsifted flour
1/2 cup unsweetened cocoa
1 1/2 teaspoons baking soda
1/2 teaspoon baking powder
1 1/2 cups sugar
3 eggs
1 teaspoon vanilla
1 cup HELLMANN'S or BEST
FOODS Real Mayonnaise
1 1/2 cups water

Grease and flour bottoms of 2 (9 inch) round baking pans. In medium bowl mix together first 4 ingredients; set aside. In large bowl with mixer at high speed beat next 3 ingredients, occasionally scraping bowl, 3 minutes or until light and fluffy. Reduce speed to low; beat in Real Mayonnaise. Add flour mixture in 4 additions alternately with water, beginning and ending with flour. Pour into prepared pans. Bake in 350°F oven 20 to 25 minutes or until cake tester inserted in center comes out clean. Cool in pans 10 minutes. Remove; cool on wire racks. Frost as desired. Garnish with sliced almonds. Makes 2 (9-inch) layers.

- More accessible



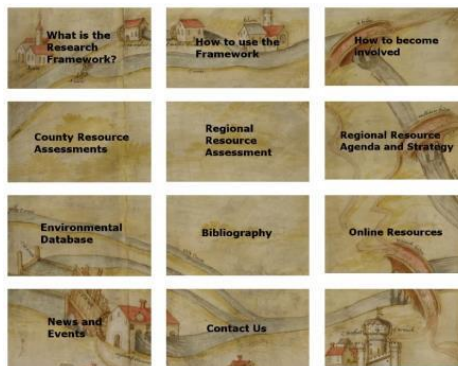
