


- ADS archive over 3 million digital objects...

- 'Bespoke' systems stack not tied to any proprietary or open source preservation system



- "Curatorial And Technical Staff" or CATs.








### Preservation via migration

- Every file accessioned preserved as a standardised format e.g. all raster images as uncompressed TIFF, databases as delimited text...
- This is called "normalisation"
- Formats used based on a mixture of technical consideration (e.g. compression = data loss), but also judgements on longevity of format and ease of establishing future migrations.



# Operational workflow



- Increasingly, our work is focussed on understanding what we have, where it is, actively managing risks to that content
  - Checksums: is it the same?
  - Obsolescence: do we need to migrate
  - = understanding what we've done and what we need to do





- Ensuring the 'complexity' of objects and their metadata is retained
- Supporting ongoing repository management activities
- Retaining the history of digital object



### Internal + External Assessment

- DPC RAM
- CoreTrustSeal (CTS)
- Encourage reflection, and assessment of where we can improve
- Often feed into developing Policy and ensuring workflows are documented
