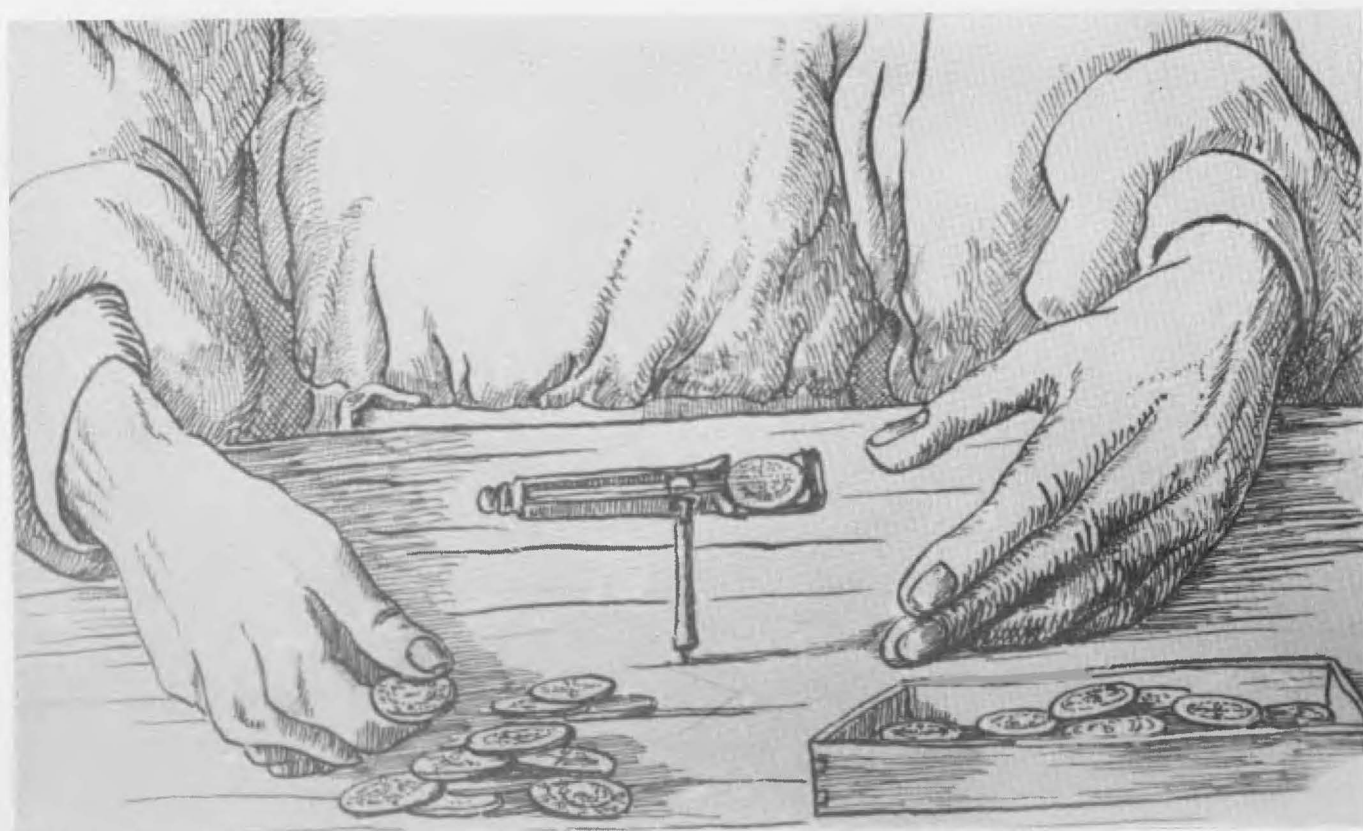

(b) Sketch, showing the scale.

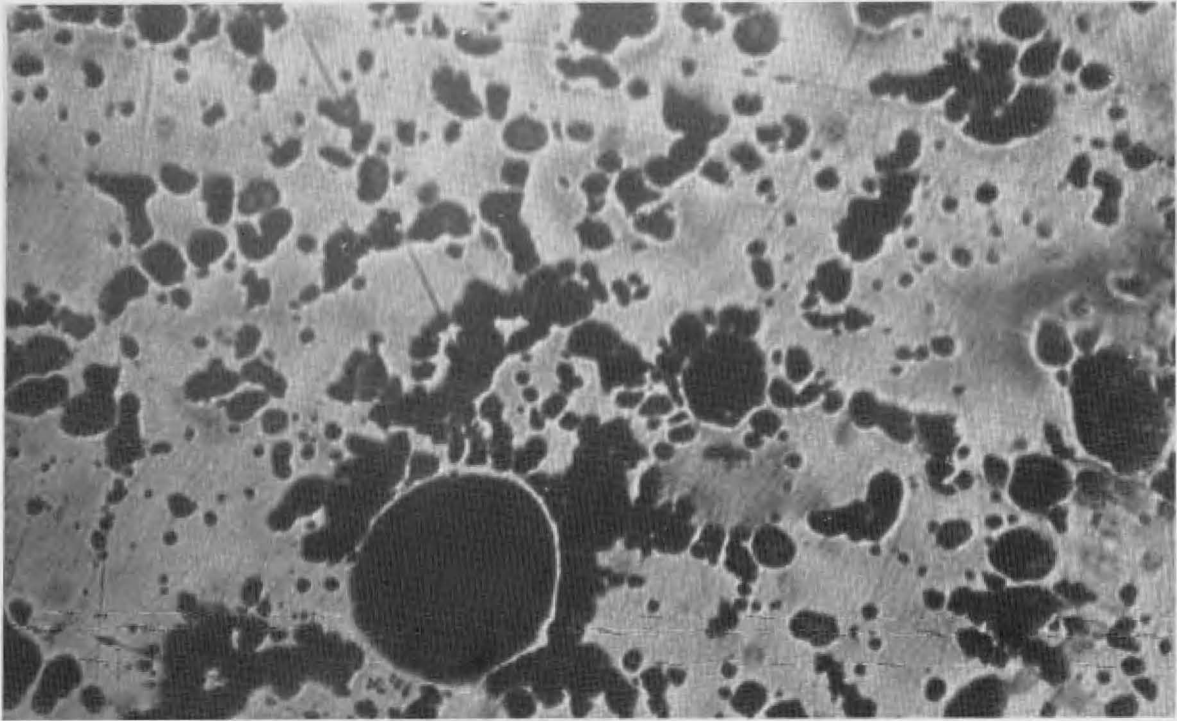


Plate XIV. Blister copper alloy. Mag. $\times 300$.

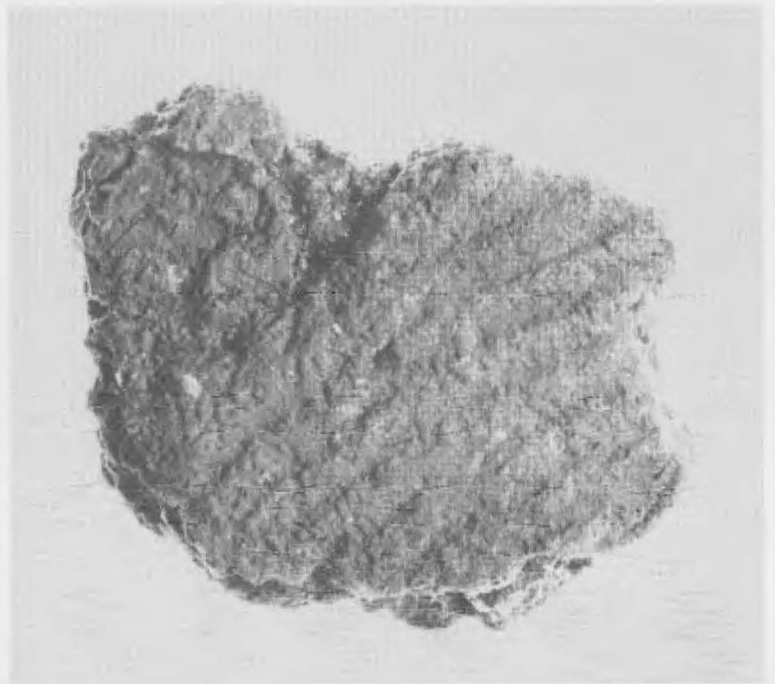


Plate XVI. Fragment of pink plaster with the impression of fabric. Scale: $\times 2$.
