

## Note on whereabouts of material

a. A 16th CENTURY GLASSHOUSE AT KNIGHTONS, ALFOLD.

Since the paper on this site was published in *SyAC*, 73, 1–48, discussions have taken place with the Forestry Commission (represented by Mr J E Leslie, Forest Officer, Godalming Office) on the disposal of the material excavated at Knightons, and described in the paper. The Commission have now generously donated the material to the Society, and it has been deposited at Guildford Museum under the normal arrangements. We are most grateful to the Commission for this gift, which will ensure adequate conservation and accessibility to the material. A small selection has been made for exhibition at the Forestry Commission's Information Centre at Alice Holt Forest, and a descriptive notice is also being placed at the site. The excavation archive has also been deposited at Castle Arch, to be in association with the excavated material.
