

A Palaeolithic axe from Farnham

A Late Middle Acheulian ovate axe (type K e/vi)¹ was found in the garden of 15 Burnt Hill Road, Farnham, Surrey (SU 8346 4470). The axe is in light brown flint and has been slightly abraded. The length is 76mm, the width 76mm. The axe was found in 1983 and remains in the possession of the owners, Mr and Mrs T Ward.

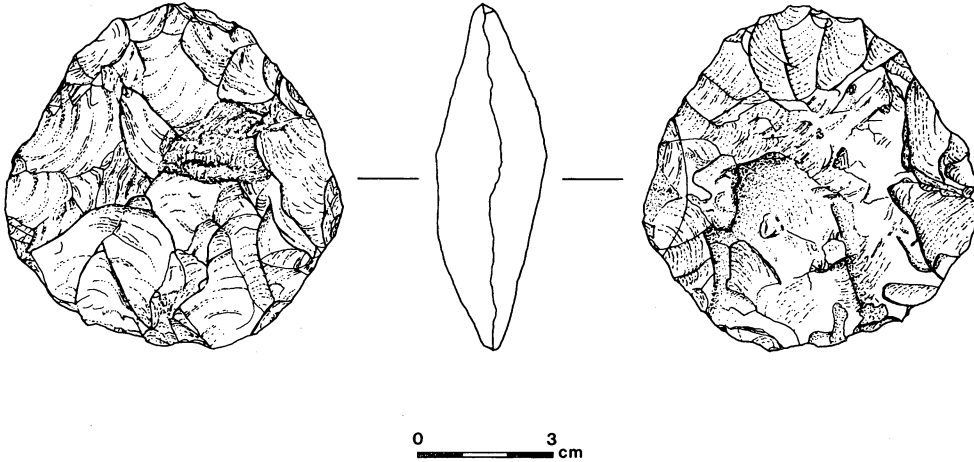


Fig 1. Late Middle Acheulian axe from Farnham (scale 1:2)
