Medieval Pottery from the King's Ditch, Hereford (AUB97)

Introduction

A small collection of medieval pottery from the King's Ditch in Hereford (site AUB97) was submitted for identification.

Aims and Objectives

To identify the finds, to establish their date range and their significance for the history of the site.

Description

A fragment of an unstratified fabric A7B ridge tile was found together with a single sherd of a fabric B1 cooking pot, found in context 1007. The cooking pot is of 12th- or 13th-century date and the ridge tile of mid 13th- to 15th-century date. Both of these types are typical of excavations in Hereford.

Recommendations

Both sherds should be retained for further study.
