

## **Medieval Pottery from the King's Ditch, Hereford (AUB97)**

### **Introduction**

A small collection of medieval pottery from the King's Ditch in Hereford (site AUB97) was submitted for identification.

### **Aims and Objectives**

To identify the finds, to establish their date range and their significance for the history of the site.

### **Description**

A fragment of an unstratified fabric A7B ridge tile was found together with a single sherd of a fabric B1 cooking pot, found in context 1007. The cooking pot is of 12<sup>th</sup>- or 13<sup>th</sup>-century date and the ridge tile of mid 13<sup>th</sup>- to 15<sup>th</sup>-century date. Both of these types are typical of excavations in Hereford.

### **Recommendations**

Both sherds should be retained for further study.
