Three sherds of pottery were recovered from three contexts at Site 11 on the Chalgrove to East Ilsley Natural Gas Pipeline watching brief carried out by Network Archaeology Ltd.

Post-medieval pottery

Three fragments of post-medieval glazed red earthenware (PMLOC) bowls were recovered, one of them very abraded. They can only be broadly dated to the late 16th to 18th centuries.

Discussion

The pottery is probably indicative of post-medieval and later ploughing.

Recommendations for Further Work

The finds require no further treatment.
