Assessment of the pottery and clay tobacco pipes from Northgate, Pontefract, South Yorkshire (PNG'04)

A collection of medieval, post-medieval and early modern pottery and clay tobacco pipes from an archaeological evaluation at Northgate, Pontefract, (site code PNG'04) carried out by Field Archaeology Specialists Ltd was submitted for identification and assessment. The collection includes small assemblages of mid and late 17th-century finds associated with the construction and use of a brick kiln. The remaining material appears to have been dumped on the site in the early 19th century although one assemblage is clearly later. The dumped material includes a small quantity of medieval pottery, all of which is post-conquest but which could include late 11th or 12th-century sherds.

Description

Clay Tobacco Pipes and other Pipeclay

Forty-eight fragments of clay tobacco pipe and one wig curler were recovered from the evaluation. The majority of the fragments were unmarked stems which were dated by visual study of the diameter of the bore. The bowl fragments consist of an unmarked heeled bowl dating to c.1640-60 from context 1094, unmarked heeled bowls from contexts 1075 and 1091 and the spur from a pipe with a late 17th or 18th-century bore diameter. One stem, with a 19th-century bore diameter, was stamped "...OMARSH". The wig curler, from context 1029, is of the dumbbell form and probably dates to the late 17th or early 18th century.

Pottery

The pottery was identified and recorded using codes in use in Lincolnshire and North Yorkshire (Table 1). There will soon be a regional type series for medieval pottery in South Yorkshire but at present this is not available.

Medieval

Sixty-eight sherds of medieval pottery were recovered. Most are of types which can only be broadly dated but they include both Yorkshire Gritty (YG) and Hillam ware (HILLAM), both of which were current in the period immediately following the Norman Conquest. No preconquest material was present, however. Much of the medieval pottery was probably made locally (for example Coal Measures Whiteware – CMW, HILLAM, unprovenanced but probably local wares – MEDLOC, Northern Gritty ware - NG and YG) but there are also sherds of regional imports, such as Beverley glazed ware (BEVO2), a possible sherd of Brandsby-type ware (BRANDSBY?), Humberware (HUM) and possible Humberware (HUM?) and Scarborough ware (SCAR). The medieval pottery is present in four interventions (8, 9, 10 and 12) and there is very little difference in the date-range of the material from each intervention. All of the material is residual.

Post-medieval

One hundred and seven sherds of post-medieval pottery were recovered. They range in date from the 16th to the mid 18th century and are present in all four interventions with little difference in the date-range of material from each intervention. In intervention 12 the material is apparently stratified but in the remaining interventions it is residual. It is likely that much of the pottery was produced locally but there are also sherds which appear to be from West Yorkshire (Cistercian wares – CSTN - which are visually identical to Wrenthorpe products), the midlands (Midlands Purple ware – MP, possibly some Midlands Yellow ware – MY - although much of this could either be locally produced or made in West Yorkshire, and Nottingham stoneware - NOTS) and, in particular Staffordshire. Although pottery similar to that produced in the Potteries products. Only one imported vessel was present, a Martincamp flask (MART).

It is notable that there is very little mid 18th-century material (only two sherds of white saltglazed stoneware, SWSG, can definitely be dated to this period) and there is no tin-glazed ware and very little stoneware.

Early Modern

Sixty-five sherds of late 18th-century and 19th-century pottery was recovered. Most of this pottery came from intervention 8 but similar pottery was found in the other three interventions. Context 1045 produced mid 19th-century or later types but the remainder of the material could be of early 19th-century date, consisting of Creamware – CREA, Pearlware – PEAR and transfer-printed wares (TPW). The Creamware includes a plate stamped "Ferrybridge", indicating that it was produced at the Ferrybridge pottery at Pontefract. From 1796 this pottery was jointly run by Ralph Wedgewood and its products from this period have his mark. It is possible that the Ferrybridge stamp was used before Wedgwood's involvement with the pottery.

Context 1045 produced sherds of sprig-decorated porcelain (CONP), buffware (NCBW), English stoneware (ENGS) and miscellaneous whitewares (WHITE) all of which were current from the middle of the 19th century onwards.

Discussion

Trench 8

One hundred and sixty objects were recovered from Trench 8, from seven contexts. Two contexts produced only post-medieval finds: 1047 and 1061. Four of these contexts produced material of late 18th or early 19th-century date (contexts 1029, 1046, 1053 and 1048) whilst the material from context 1045 includes mid-19th-century or later pottery.

Trench 9

Fourteen fragmentswere recovered from Trench 9. Context 1051, The backfill of a stone drain, produced a sherd of medieval pottery, a Yorkshire Gritty ware jar, but this is unlikely to be contemporary. Context 1042, another drain backfill, produced three sherds, the latest of which date the backfill to the early 18th century or later.

Trench 10

Twenty-nine fragments were recovered from Trench 10. They come from three contexts, 1059, 1060 and 1075. The two subsoil layers (1060 and 1075) produced material of late 17th-century or later date (together with some residual medieval pottery) whilst the buried soil, 1059, produced sherds of late 18th or early 19th-century date.

Trench 12

Eighty-six fragments were recovered from Trench 12. A collection of medieval and postmedieval pottery came from context 1095, a layer of make up for Feature 25, the brick kiln. The latest sherds present are a brown-glazed earthenware and a slipped bowl. The technique of coating the inside of redware bowls with white slip was present in the Low Countries in the 16th century and was copied in eastern England in the late 16th and early 17th centuries. The absence of clay pipe fragments in this group might suggest that it dates to this late 16th or early17th-century period.

A group of four sherds came from context 1096, associated with the use of the kiln. Two of these were definitely residual medieval sherds. The other two are a sherd of Midlands Yellow ware bowl and a sherd of a slipped redware bowl of Staffordshire type. The latter is a type first produced in Staffordshire in the mid 17th century (i.e. associated with pipes dating to c.1640-60).

The backfill of the brick clamp, contexts 1091 and 1094, produced clay pipes and pottery of the mid-late 17th century, the latest of which is a pipe bowl dated c.1660-80.

Context 1092 produced a small assemblage of similar character, of which the latest find present is a late 17th to 18th-century clay pipe stem.

The remaining contexts, 1088 and 1087, produced a mixture of post-medieval and early modern finds, the latest being of late 18th or early 19th-century date.

Assessment

The finds indicate that there is medieval activity nearby, possibly dating back to the late 11th or 12th centuries, some of these sherds were definitely present on the site by the early 17th century and are therefore not present through modern dumping. There is, however, no stratified material of this date, with the unlikely possibility of a stone-lined drain in Trench 9.

The brick kiln found in Trench 12 was probably in operation some time after c.1640 and was probably out of use before the end of the 17th century.

There is little sign of 18th-century activity on the site and what material there is of this date is likely to have been dumped on the site in the late 18th or early 19th century. Dumping and soil horizons of this date were found in all four trenches. Finally, there is a single deposit, containing later pottery, from Trench 8.
