Assessment of the Clay Tobacco Pipes from Blakeney, Norfolk (37793 CLY)

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Thirty fragments of clay tobacco pipe were recovered from excavations at St John's Chapel, Blakeney, undertaken by Lindsey Archaeological Services.

Description

The pipe fragments mostly consist of plain stem fragments with a single bowl. The fragments have bores of two diameters, the majority being c.3.0mm diameter with four fragments having bore diameters c.2.0mm. The latter are typical of later 18th and 19th-century pipes whilst the former are typical of the 17th century. The bowl is a plain heeled pipe similar to Atkinson and Oswald's London type 25 but more forward leaning. Given its wide bore diameter, a date in the last quarter of the 17th century is likely and a similar date is likely for the stem fragments.

Assessment

All of the pipe fragments come from collapse deposits or the overlying topsoil and it is likely that they arrived on the site after the building's collapse. The lack of pipe fragments from earlier strata suggest that pipes were not used on the site during the occupation of the structures, which in turn suggests that this occupation ceased before the beginning of the 17th century.

The material requires no further work and only the pipe bowl should be retained for potential future study.
