

Assessment of the Finds from evaluations carried out between Harefield and Southall, Greater London (HAS 3-4)

A small quantity of finds was recovered from archaeological evaluations carried out between Harefield and Southall, Greater London undertaken by Network Archaeology Ltd (Site Code HAS 3-4). The finds include fragments of medieval roof tile and early modern or later ceramic building material and pottery.

Description

Ceramic Building Material

Fragments of two pegtiles of medieval or early post-medieval date were recovered from context 1100. Both are unglazed and have an abundant rounded quartz sand with grains up to 0.3mm across.

A single fragment of a modern wall tile with a quarter-round moulding and light blue opaque glaze was recovered from context 1100.

Pottery

A single fragment of a miscellaneous refined whiteware cup of mid 19th century or later date was recovered from context 1300.

Assessment

The flat roof tiles were probably made in the 17th century or earlier but could have been still used up to the present day. The other finds are probably of later 19th century or, in the case of the wall tile, 20th century date.

Further Study

No further work is recommended.

Retention

Since the finds come from topsoil overlying natural deposits they are unstratified and little would be gained from their retention for future study.
