

## **Assessment of the Finds from Cemetery Road, Thirsk, North Yorkshire (OSA06 WB03)**

A small collection of finds was recovered from a watching brief at Cemetery Road, Thirsk, undertaken by On-Site Archaeology. The finds include a group of unabraded potsherds of late Roman date, indicating activity on the site in the late 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> centuries, together with medieval, post-medieval and early modern material.
